Motorola Inc., 8000 West Sunrise Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33322, herein submits its response to your 3rd August 2001 request for information on FCC ID: AZ489FT5803, EA100397 via correspondence number 20131.

To adequately respond to all the questions in the above correspondence, Motorola has re-issued the SAR report.

Also, there are some differences in the accessory part numbers in the SAR report and the product user guide which should be explained. The part numbers used in the SAR report represent those internal Motorola part numbers that are used for the specific item being tested. In many cases, when this item is packed for sale and distribution, a prefix or suffix is added to the part number so that what is ordered by the customer is the packaged part. This is the case for accessories which begin with the prefix "AA" in the user guide which means audio accessories that have been packaged and labeled for distribution. It is also the case for the suffix R that is added to the battery part number which means a battery that has been placed in a box for distribution of that battery. The packaged numbers are put in the user's guide as that is what the customer is offered for sale, a packaged part.
