Motorola Inc., 8000 West Sunrise Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33322, herein submits its Class II Permissive Change Request to add Telecoil Hearing Aid Compatibility (HAC) to FCC Certified transmitter with FCC ID: AZ489FT5853. The RF Interference potential component of HAC for this transceiver was previously filed and approved with the FCC as a Class II Permissive Change.

A sample of the iDEN i880 transmitter was taken from stock and measured in accordance with industry standard procedures. A report of the measurement data is attached. The measurement results were compared in the report with the signal quality criteria defined in the ANSI PC63.19-2006 standard.
