Dear Mr. Czumak,

Here is the response to each of the four questions in your correspondence:

1. *The user's manual did not come through the system. Please resubmit it (electronically). Re-submitted as Exhibit 9.*
2. *Under precisely which sections of Parts 22, 74, and 90 is authorization sought?*

For Rule Part 22 we are requesting operation under subparts G - Public Land Mobile Radio Service using frequencies allocated in paragraph 22.501, and under subpart F - Rural Radiotelephone Service, using frequencies allocated in paragraph 22.601.

For Rule Part 74 we are requesting operation under subpart D - Remote Pickup Broadcast Stations using frequencies within the UHF bands as listed in paragraph 74.402.

For Rule part 90, we are requesting operation under all of part 90 and 90.210.

3. *Please indicate the exact Rule Part and section in which the emission masks used are located (i.e., please accurately identify them).*

Emission Mask B: Part 90.210 (B)(1), (2), and (3) – 25 kHz channel bandwidth.

Emission mask D: Part 90.210 (D)(1), (2), and (3)-12.5 kHz channel bandwidth.

4. We agree with your observation that this unit (mobile) is categorically excluded from routine environmental evaluation and a statement of compliance is not required. Therefore, we are withdrawing Exhibit 12 (RF Exposure) of the original application.
