Motorola Inc., 8000 West Sunrise Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33322, herein submits its response to the 3rd December 2001 request for information in Correspondence Number 21413.

Q1) Updated confidentiality letter. Your 3 December update letter was received corrupted. Please include the Quantar RSS Users Manual, per your request. Also, please clarify if the schematics in the user manual need to be held confidential by the FCC. Confidentiality for the users manual was not originally requested.

R1) Updated confidentiality Letter submitted on 2nd December 2001.

Q2) Limiting plots showing deviation vs audio level for 300 and 3000 Hz to correspond to the plot in exhibit 6B-4 at 1000 Hz.

R2). See attached Exhibit 6, Addendum 2.

Q3) Statement indicating agreement with authorization under only rule part 90. In reference to question 11 on your 11/28/01 correspondence, section 74.21 refers to operation of a station that is already licensed in one of the Radio Services provided under Subparts A thru L. Section 74.21 is not a blanket authorization to use any frequency. Section 74.21 states, in part, such operation shall be conducted only on the frequency or frequencies for which the station is licensed. It therefore appears that Part 74 Certification is not appropriate for this unit.

R4). Motorola concurs with the FCC's recommendation to delete Rule Part 22 and 74. This application will now be approved under Rule Part 90.
