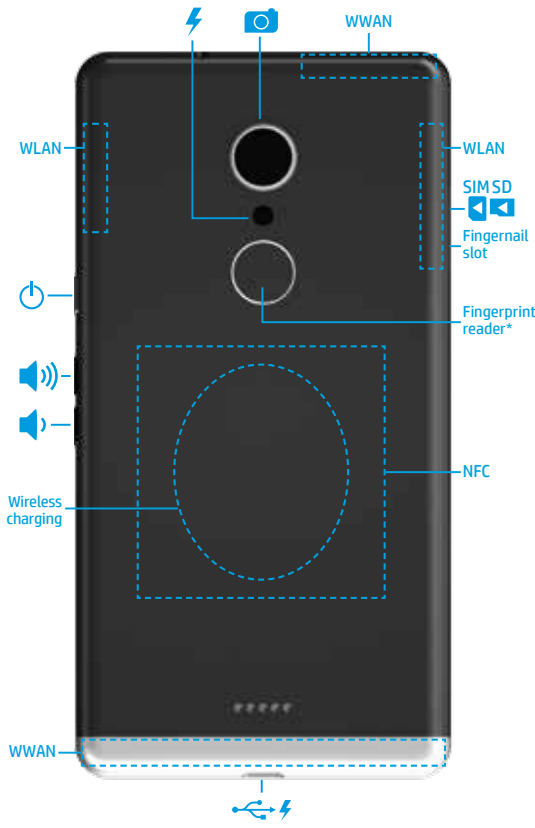
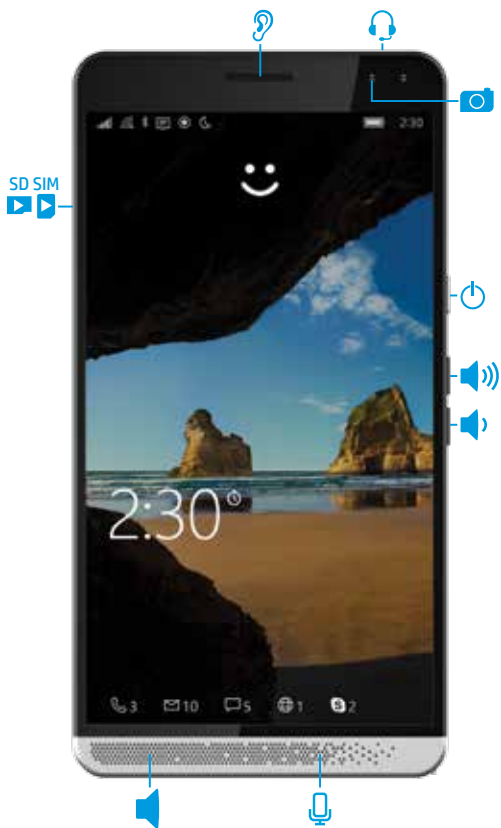

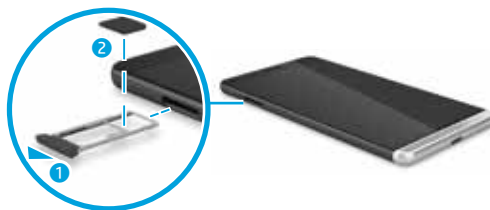

Setup

- 1 Place your fingernail in the fingernail slot and pull the tray out to remove it. Then insert a nano SIM card (purchased separately) into the tray.

NOTE: Your device supports two nano SIM cards or one nano SIM card and one microSD card.



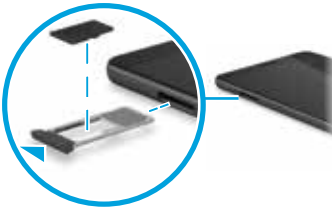
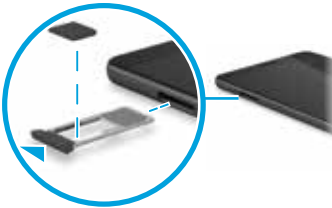
- 2 To insert a second nano SIM card (purchased separately), place the card in the tray's second slot.

Replace the tray.

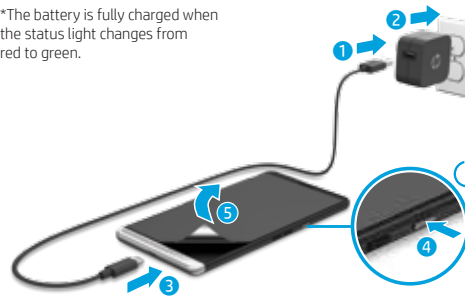
- To insert a microSD card (purchased separately), place the card in the tray's second slot.

Replace the tray.



- 3 After charging the battery,* press the power button for about 5 seconds until you feel the device vibrate.

*The battery is fully charged when the status light changes from red to green.



- 4 Follow the on-screen instructions to select a language, a wireless network, a Microsoft® account,* storage options, and other settings.

If the screen switches off, press the power button, and then slide up from the bottom of the screen.

*If you do not have a Microsoft account, you can create one now.

LOCK SCREEN SIGN-IN

You can set up a sign-in lock screen to make sure no one else can unlock your device using a sign-in PIN, iris scan, or fingerprint reader.

To set a sign-in PIN, slide down from the top of the screen, tap **Settings**, tap **Personalization**, tap **Lock screen**, tap **Sign-in options**, and then follow the on-screen instructions.

Power off

Press and hold the power button, and then slide down on the screen when prompted.

NOTE: If your device becomes unresponsive, press and hold the power button until the device turns off.

Basic tasks

UNLOCK THE SCREEN

Press the power button, and then slide up from the bottom of the screen.

DISPLAY THE START SCREEN

Tap **Start**.

ACCESS SETTINGS AND NOTIFICATIONS

Slide down **Notifications** from the top of the screen.

DISPLAY THE NAVIGATION BAR

Slide up **Navigation bar** from the bottom of the screen.

SEARCH

Tap **Search**, tap the search box at the bottom of the screen, and then begin typing the name of an app, setting, file, or Internet topic.

—or—

Tap **Search**, tap the search box at the bottom of the screen, tap **Search**, and then speak the name of an app, setting, file, or Internet topic.

DISPLAY THE PREVIOUS SCREEN

Tap **Back**.

LIST YOUR APPS

Slide left **Apps** on the screen.

ADD APPS

Tap **Start**, tap **Store**, tap **Search** at the top of the screen, type your search term, tap **Search**, and then follow the on-screen instructions.



NOTE: The appearance of the screen may vary.

CREATE NEW CONTACTS

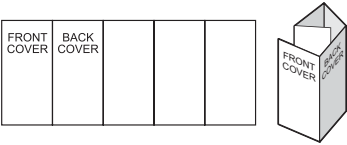
Tap **Start**, slide left on the screen to display all apps, tap **People**, tap **+**, and then follow the on-screen instructions.

SET UP EMAIL AND SOCIAL NETWORK ACCOUNTS

Slide down from the top of the screen, tap **Settings**, tap **Accounts**, tap **Your email and accounts**, and then follow the on-screen instructions.

SEND EMAIL

Tap **Start**, tap **Outlook Mail**, select your account, and then follow the on-screen instructions.



Calls and texts*

MAKE A CALL

Tap , tap , tap  to enter the phone number, and then tap .

ANSWER A CALL

Tap . If the device is locked, slide up from the bottom of the screen, and then tap .

IGNORE A CALL

Tap .

END A CALL

Tap .

*A nano SIM card is required.

RETURN A RECENT CALL

Tap , tap , and then tap a recent call.

IGNORE A CALL WITH A TEXT MESSAGE

Tap , and then text a response.

CHECK VOICEMAIL

Tap , and then tap .

TEXT

Tap , tap , and then tap + to start a new text message.

Accessories

DESK DOCK

Using the desk dock (purchased separately), you can connect your device to a keyboard, display, and a mouse. Place your device in the dock, and then follow the Continuum app instructions to continue. For more information, tap , slide left on the screen to display all apps, and then tap [Continuum](#).

For more information about the desk dock, refer to the documentation provided with it.

WIRELESS CHARGING PAD

Using the wireless charging pad (purchased separately), you can charge your device by placing the charging area of your device on the pad.

Camera

USE THE CAMERA

Slide down from the top of the screen, and then tap the  app.

Security and backup

SECURITY

There are several options for securely signing in to your device. After a sign-in PIN is set, you can also set up the iris scanner or the fingerprint reader* to unlock your device.

To set up the fingerprint reader or iris scanner, tap , slide left, tap [Windows Hello](#), tap [Set up](#), and then follow the on-screen instructions. See the user guide for more information.

BACKUP

HP strongly encourages you to periodically back up the personal data on your device.

To store and even share your files using OneDrive,* tap , slide left on the screen to display all apps, tap [OneDrive](#), and then follow the on-screen instructions.

To store files, pictures, or apps on a microSD card, tap , slide left, and then tap [Storage](#).

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

This product is a lightweight device and features a thin-panel display, processor, RAM, integrated battery pack, and an external AC adapter. This printed Quick Start guide identifies the hardware components of your product. The AC adapter has a rating of 100–240 V ac, 50/60 Hz, 0.3–1.0 A. You can access the latest user guide from the [HP Device Hub](#) app.

SPECIFICATION

The device operates on DC power, which can be supplied by an AC or a DC power source. The AC power source must be rated at 100–240 V, 50/60 Hz.

NOTE: The HP adapter included with your product is recommended for charging the product.

Relative humidity (noncondensing) operating: 10% to 90%
