Dear Sirs:

We declare the device with FCC ID: B94HNAR01 has disabled the ad-hoc peer-to-peer, hotspot function, and the software and associated drivers will not initiate any transmission in the following frequency bands:

5150MHz - 5250MHz
5250MHz – 5350MHz
5470MHz – 5725MHz

In DFS frequency bands, the device acts as a client device which does not support radar detection capability. In addition, 5600MHz -5650MHz capability is notched in this device when marketed in US and Canada.

For 802.11 b/g/n function of this device, hotspot capabilities and Ad Hoc functionality is not supported in non-US frequencies. For all 802.11a 5GHz bands, country code selection is also disabled.
