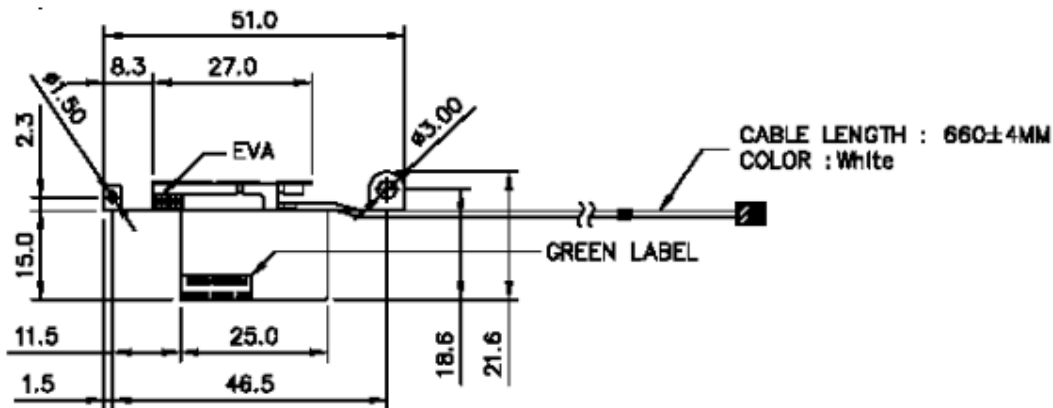

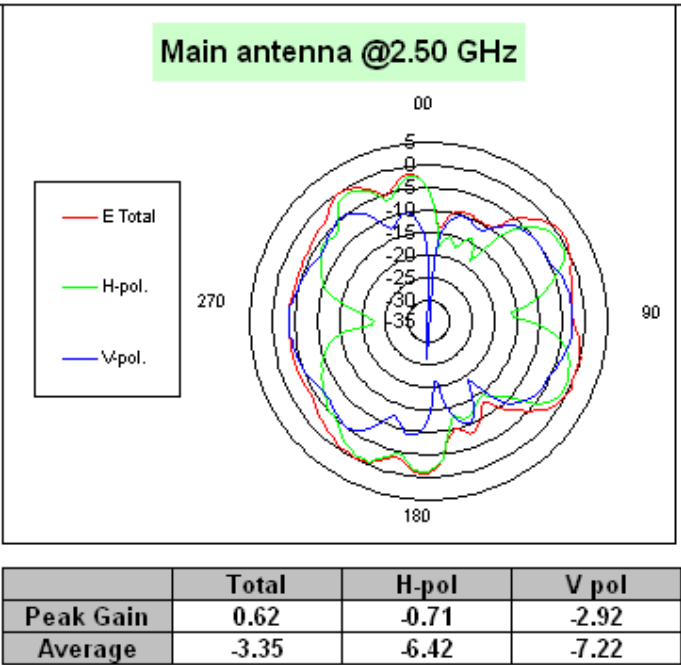

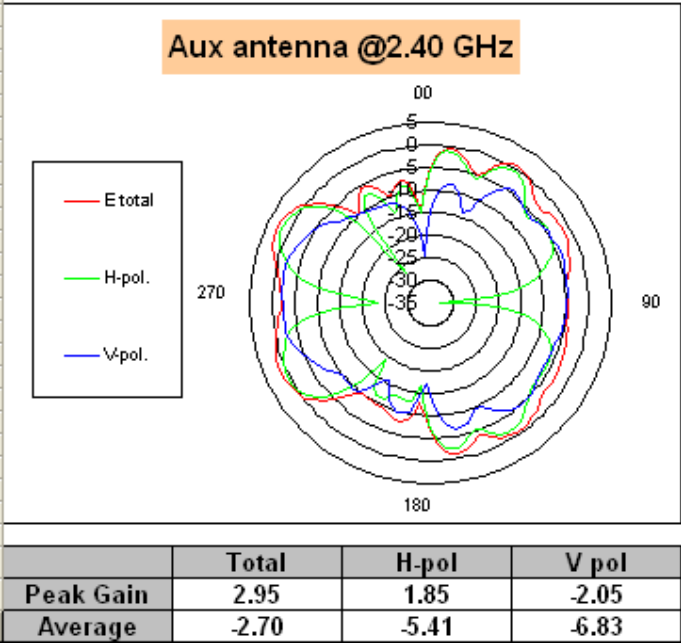
Main antenna: 2450 MHz



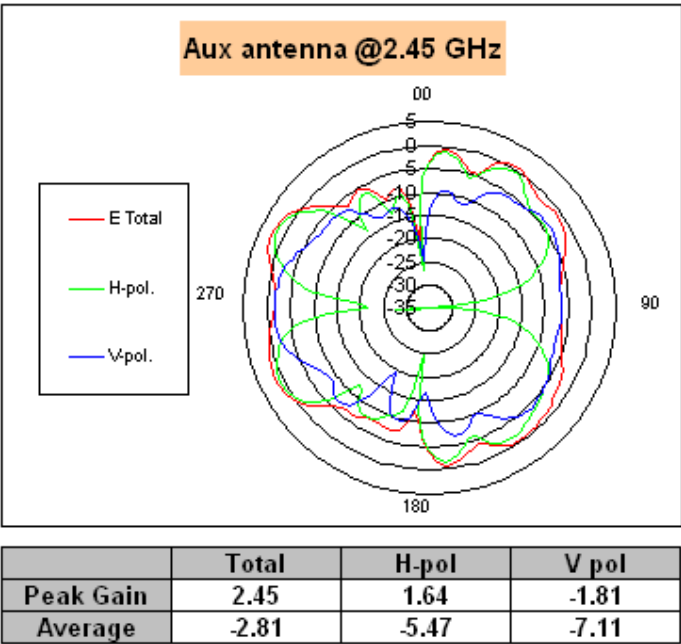
Main antenna: 2500 MHz



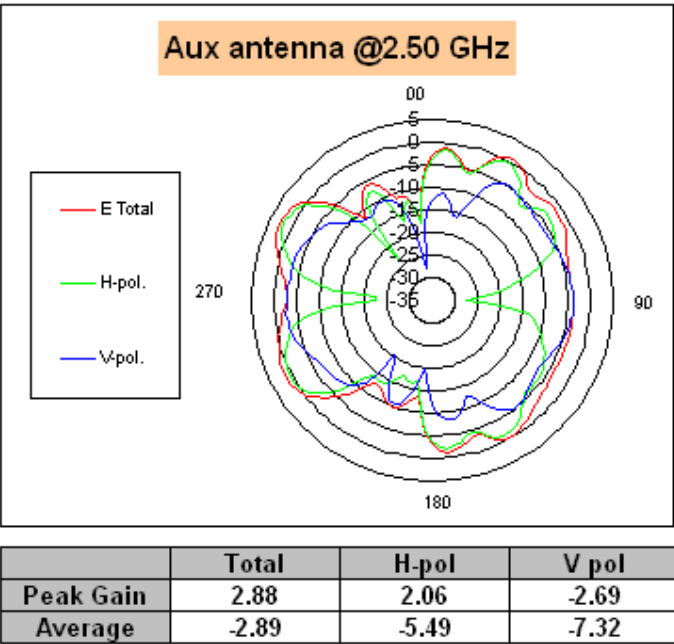
Auxiliary antenna: 2400 MHz

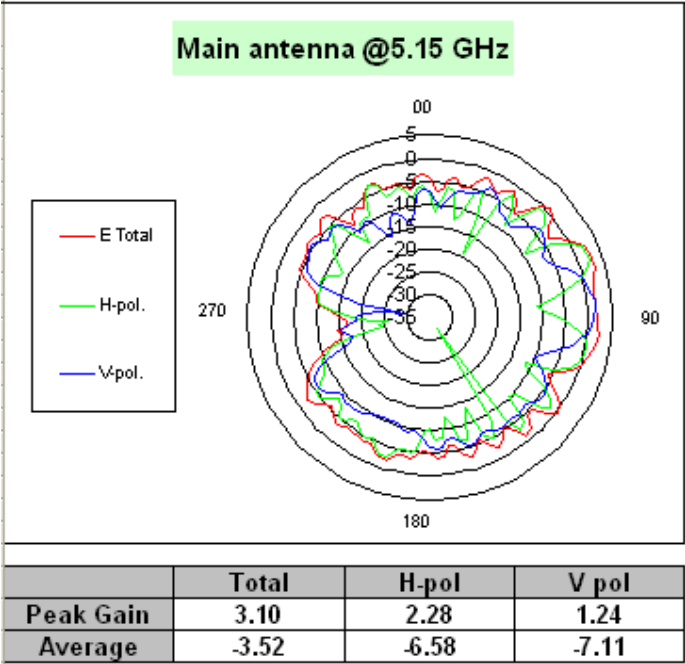


Auxiliary antenna: 2500 MHz

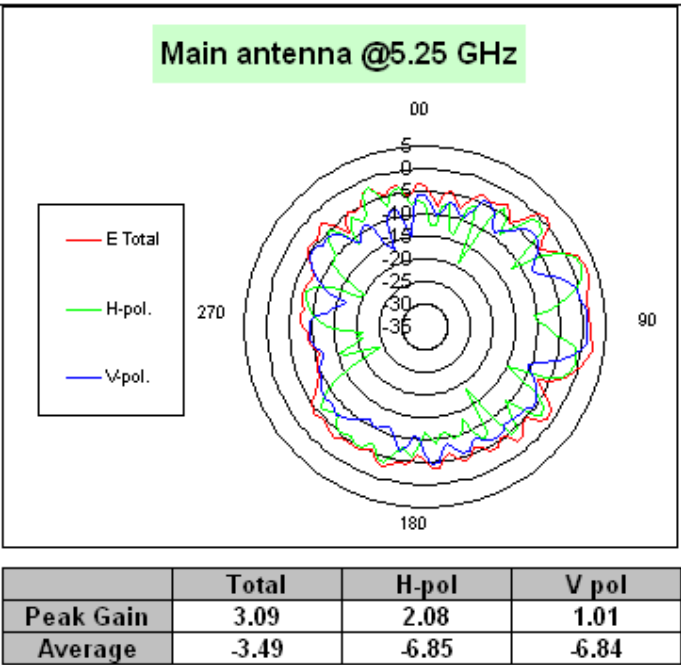


5150-5350 MHz radiation characteristic

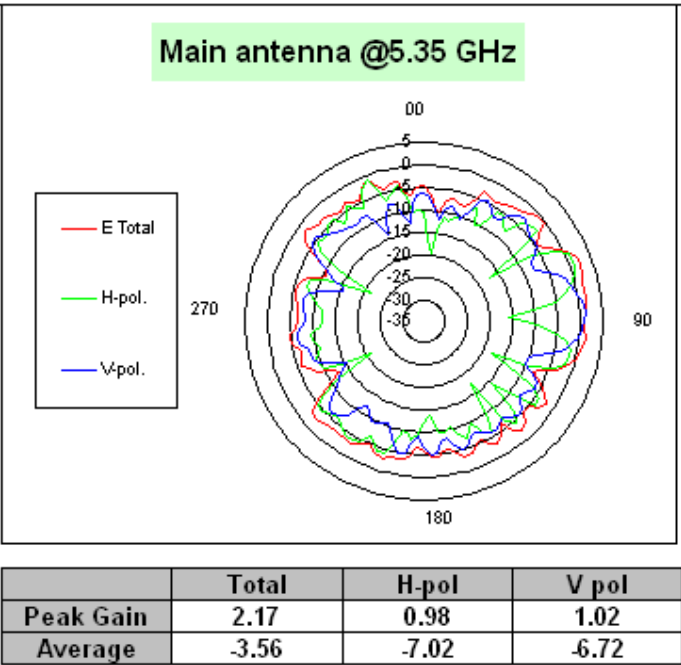

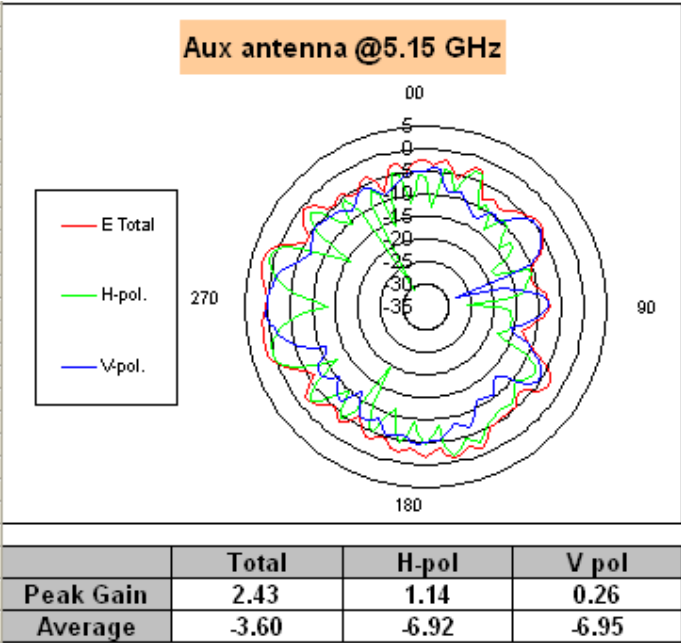
Main antenna: 5250 MHz



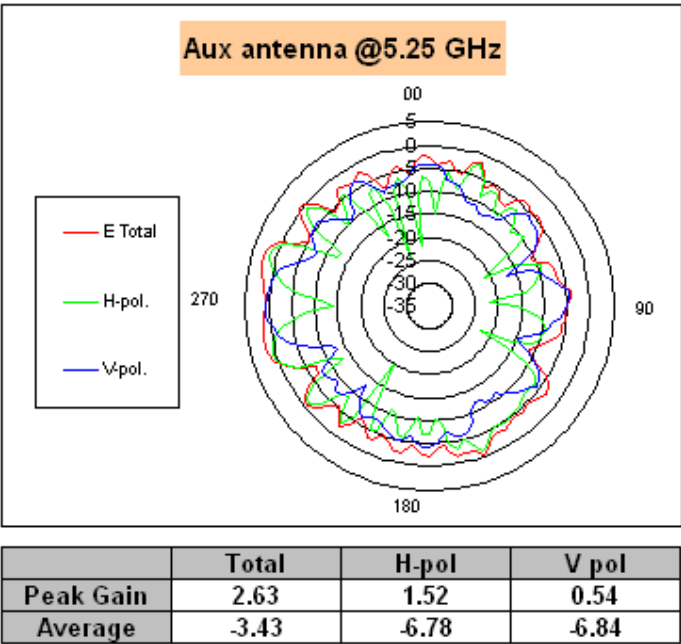
Main antenna: 5350 MHz



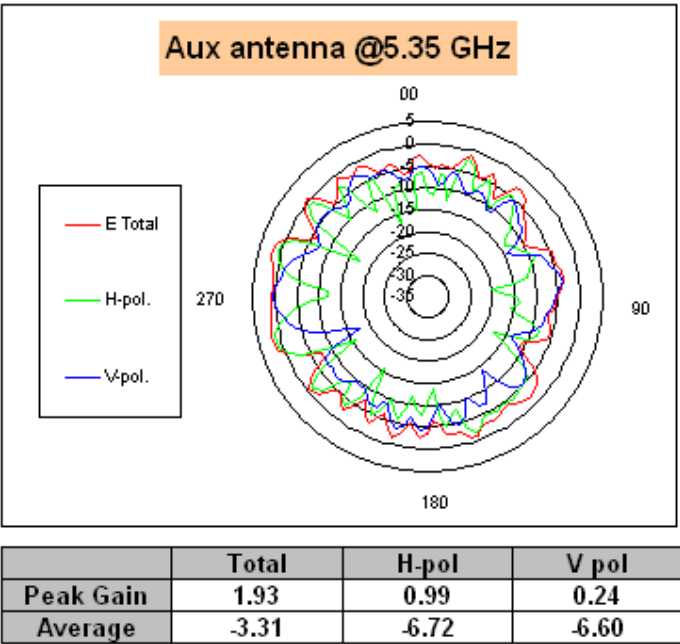

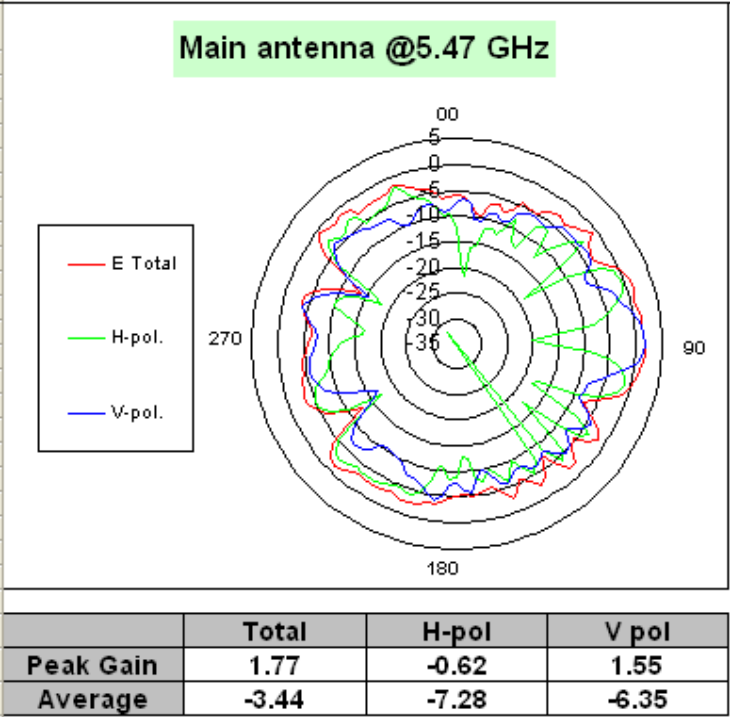

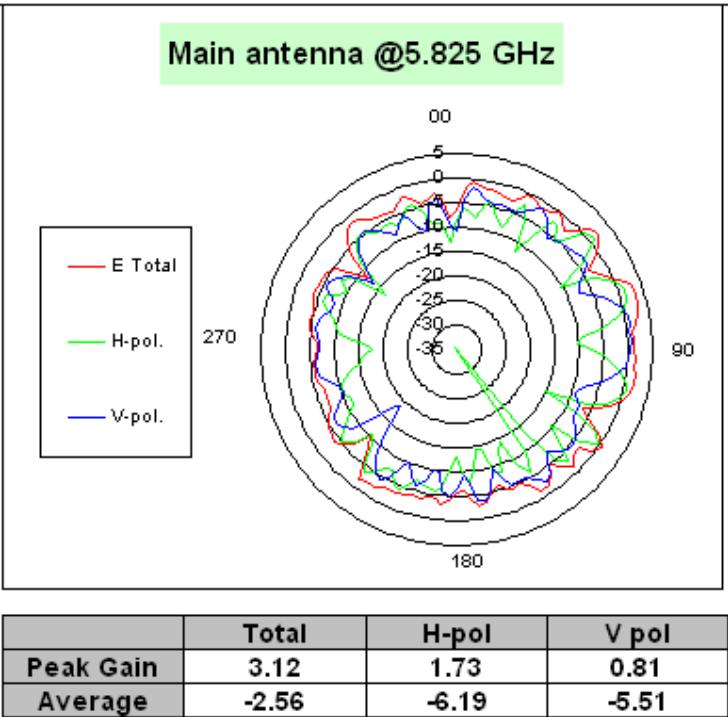
5470-5725MHz radiation characteristic

Main antenna: 5470 MHz

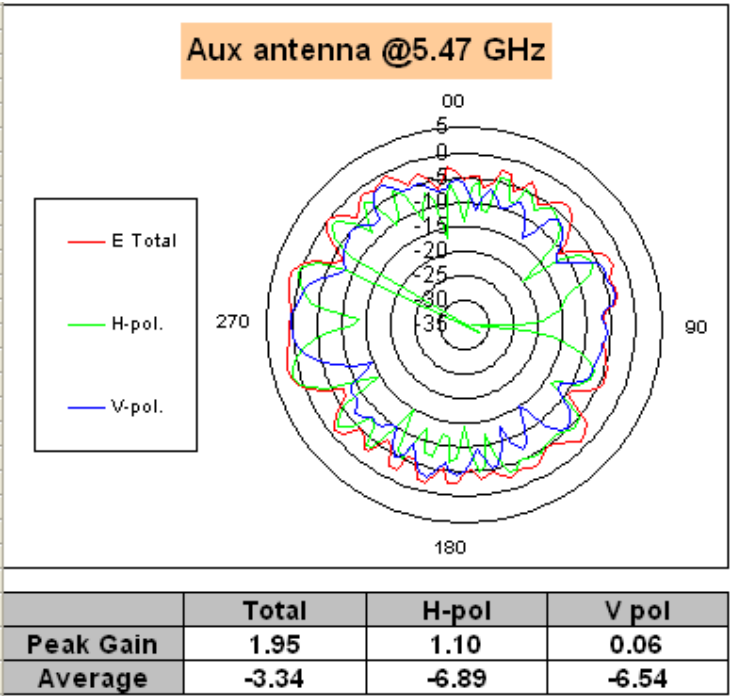




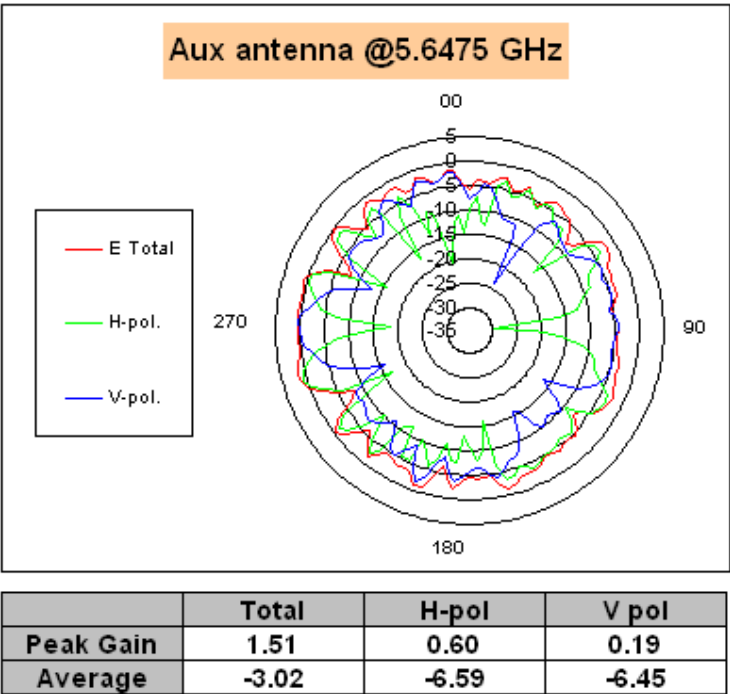
Main antenna: 5825 MHz



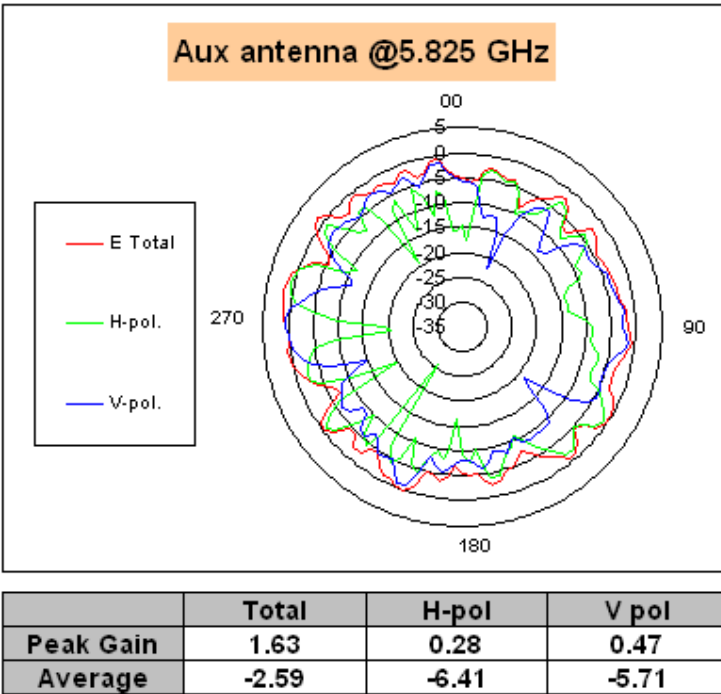
Auxiliary antenna: 5470 MHz

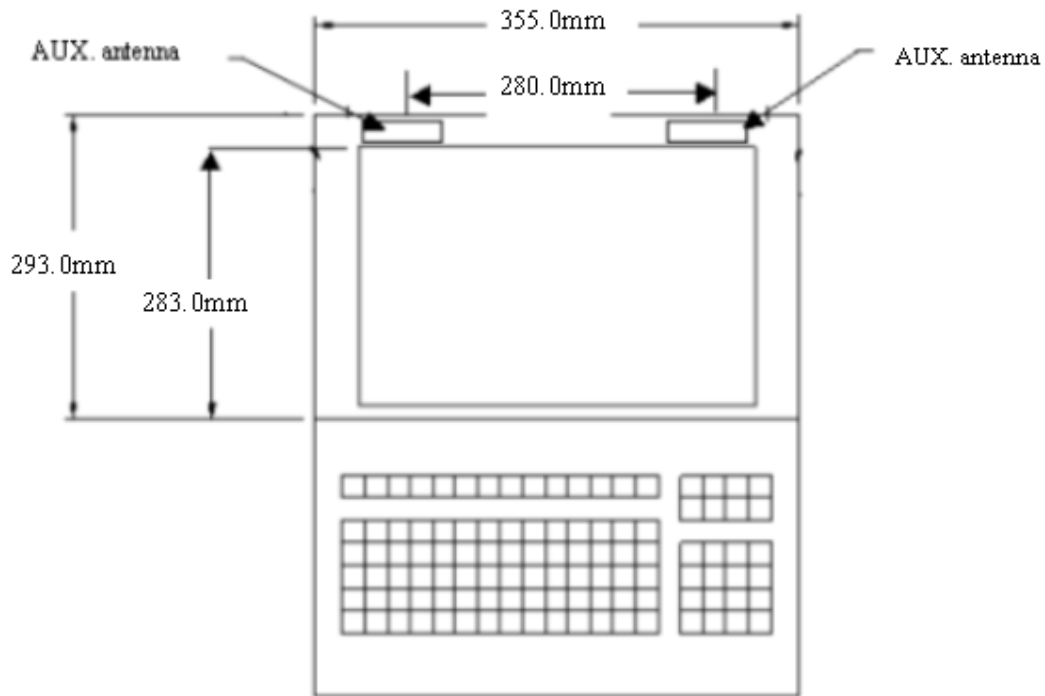

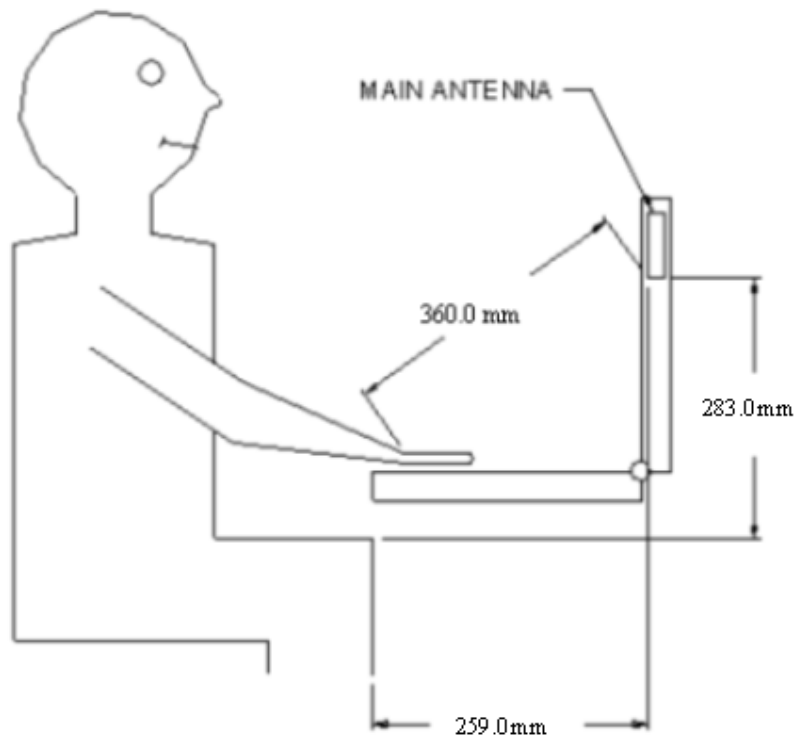
