We, Casio Computer Co., Ltd., hereby declare that the model IT-800A-35U, FCC ID: BBQIT800A has the following frequency scanning plan:

Active scan on 2412-2462MHz, 5150-5250MHz
Passive scan on 2462-2472MHz, 5250-5350, 5500-5700MHz

The model IT-800A-35U will not allow the user to select any non-US frequency. This device maintains a list of DFS channels/frequencies and doesn't allow "Ad-Hoc" on non-US frequencies or DFS frequencies, unless under the control of a master device. "Ad-Hoc" is usable on legal US frequencies, in which there are no DFS requirements.
