



















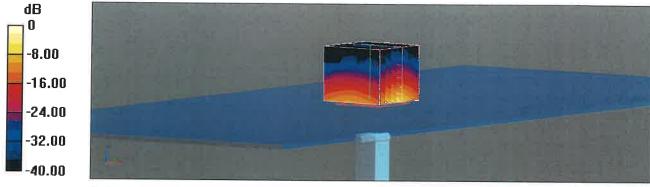

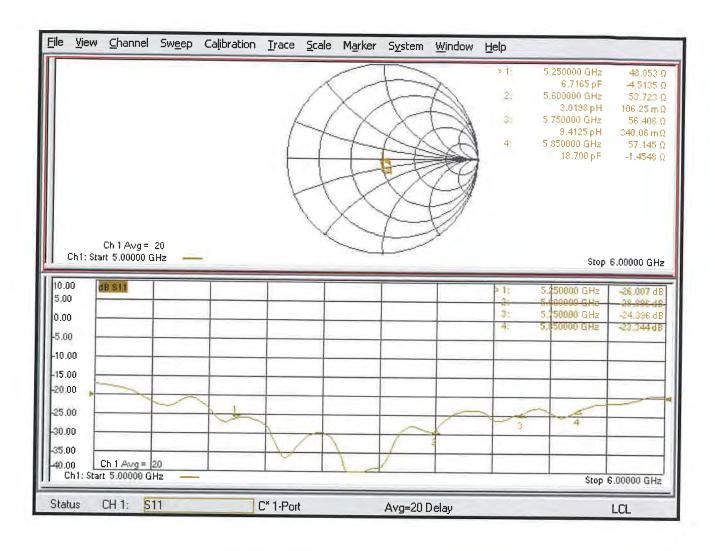

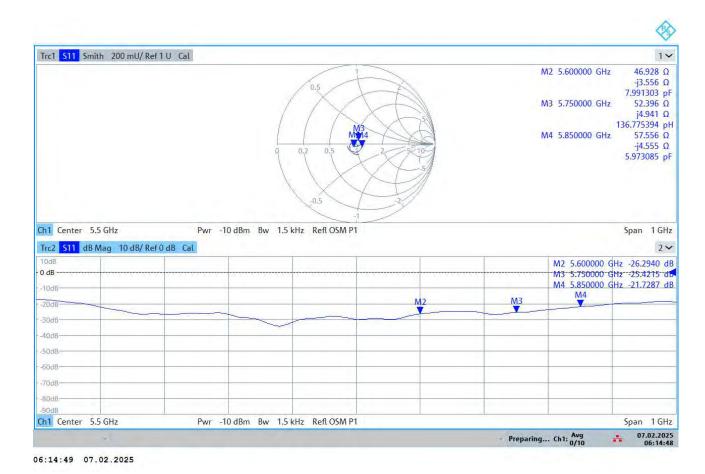

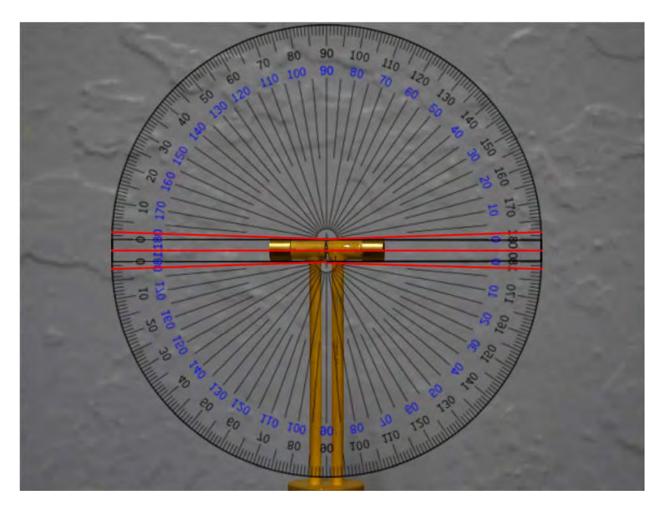




### 3) Dipole Arms

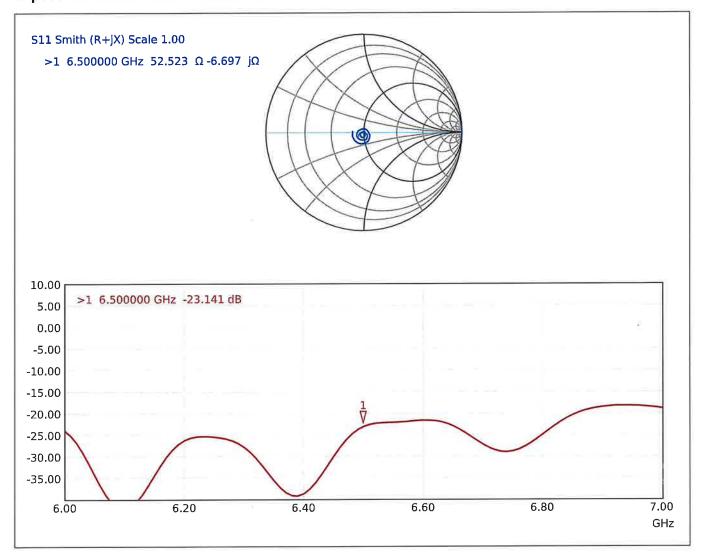














