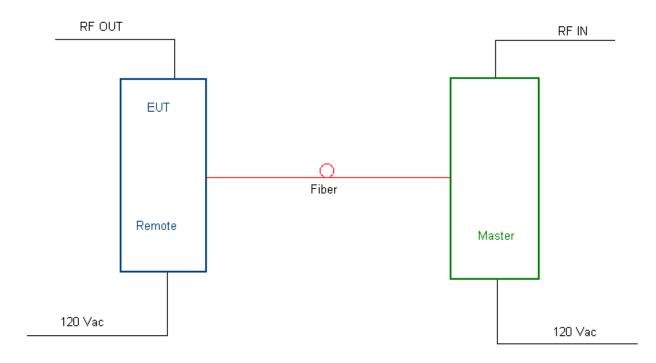

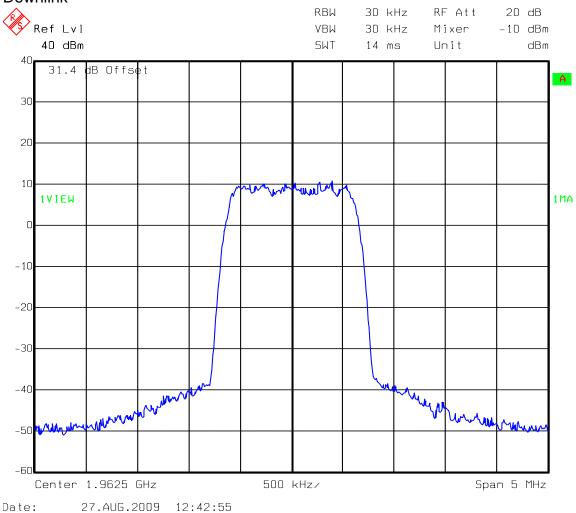

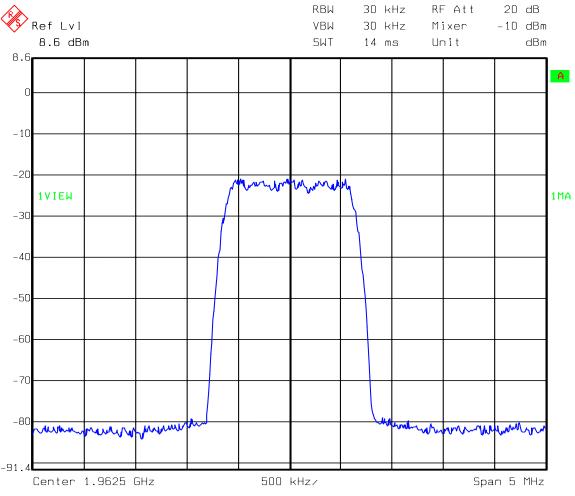

CDMA - Input Downlink



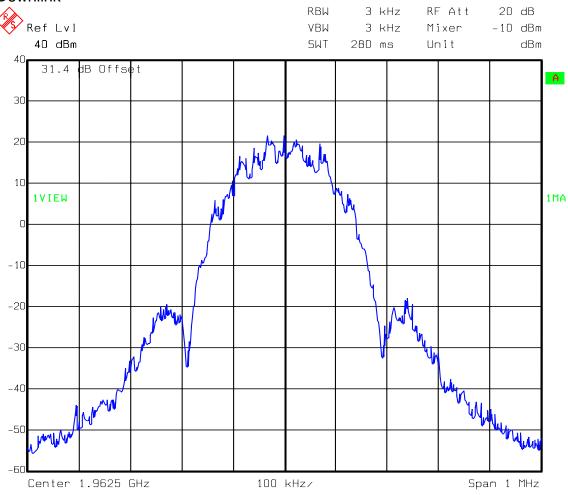

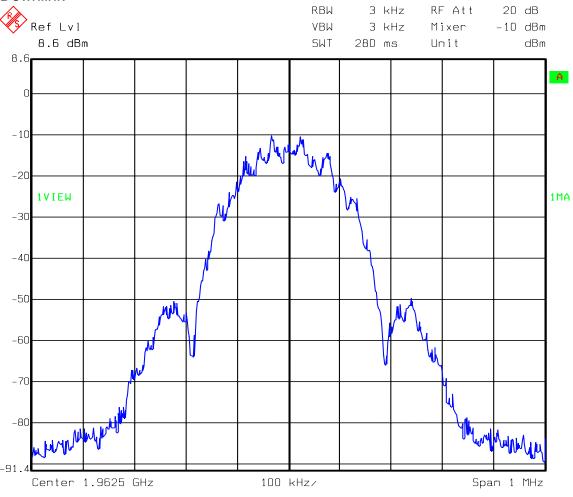

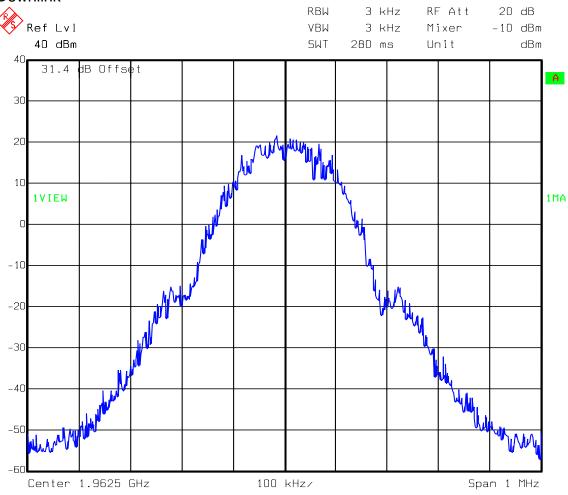

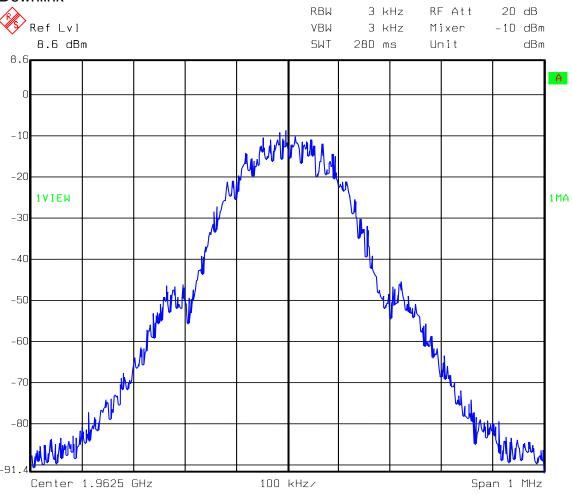

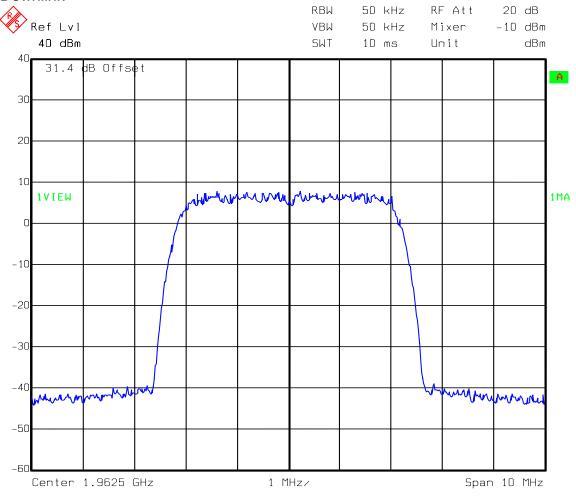

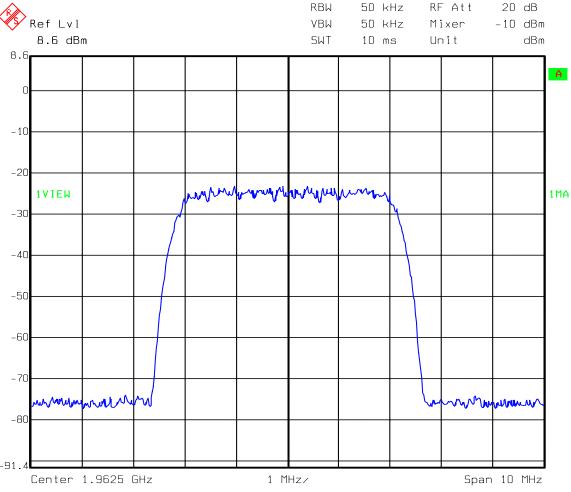

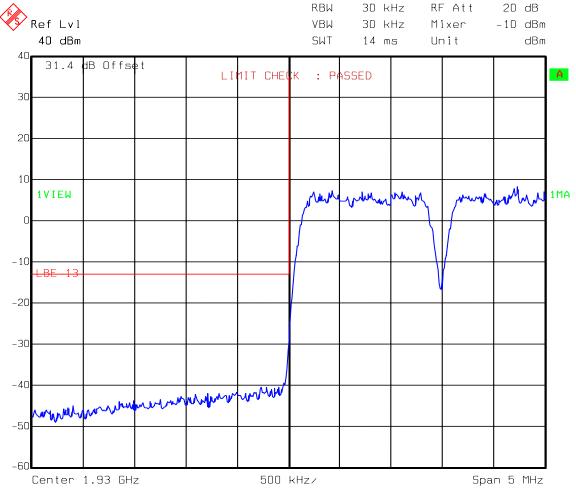

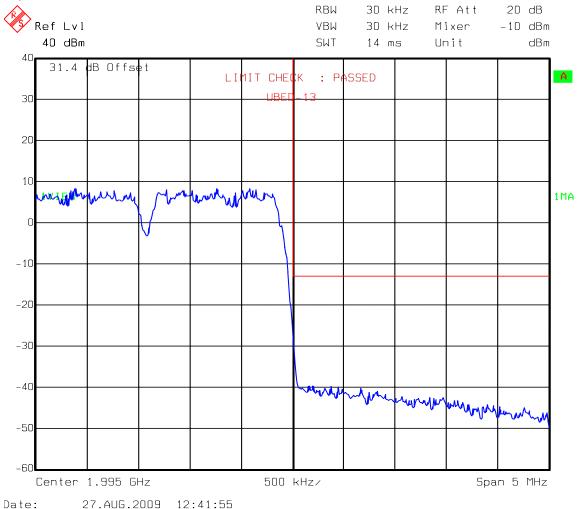
Lower Bandedge Intermodulation CDMA Downlink

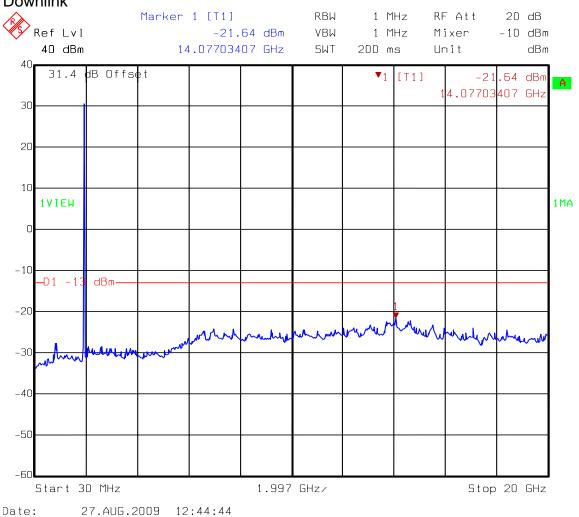
Upper Bandedge Intermodulation CDMA

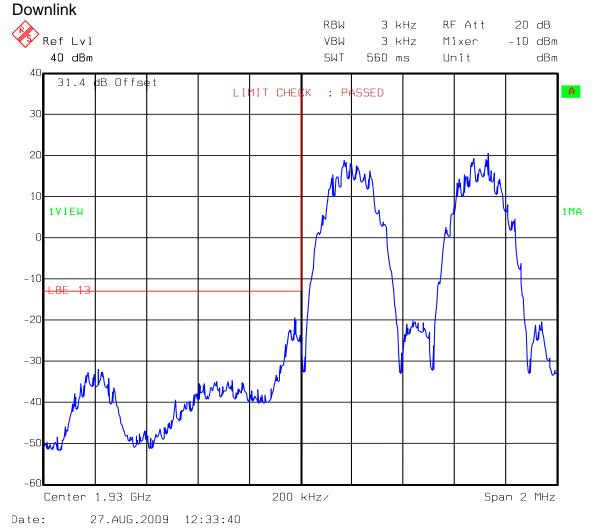

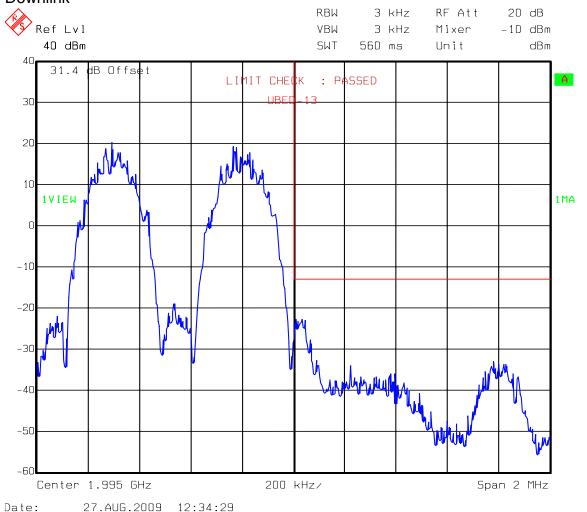
Lower Bandedge Intermodulation EDGE

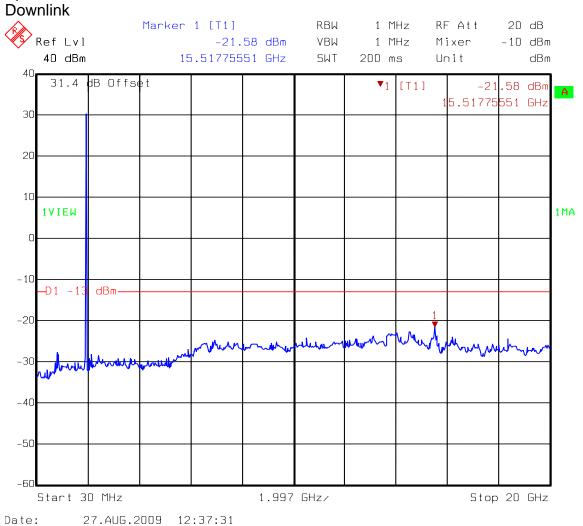
Upper Bandedge Intermodulation EDGE

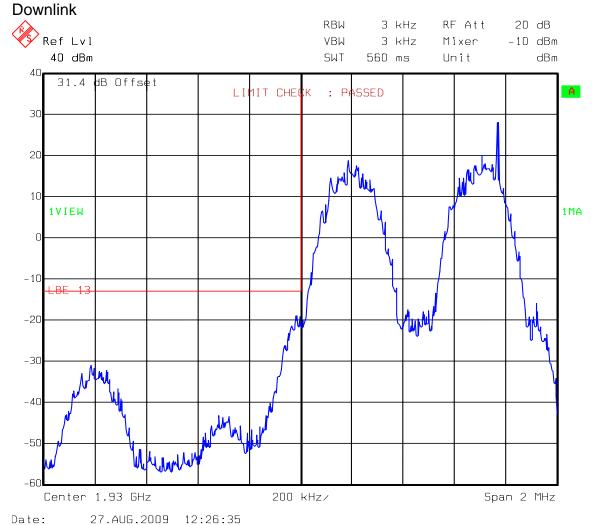

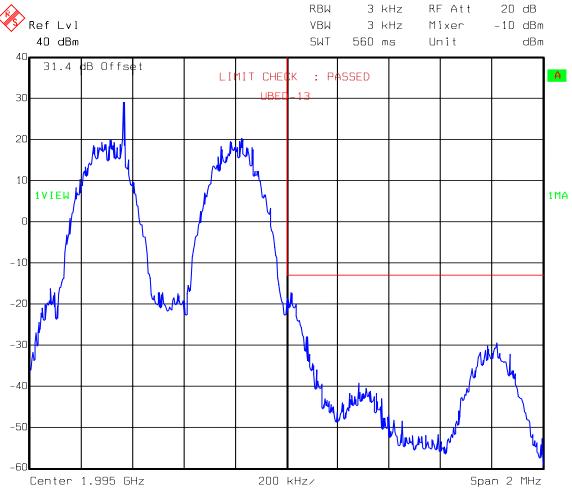
Lower Bandedge Intermodulation GSM

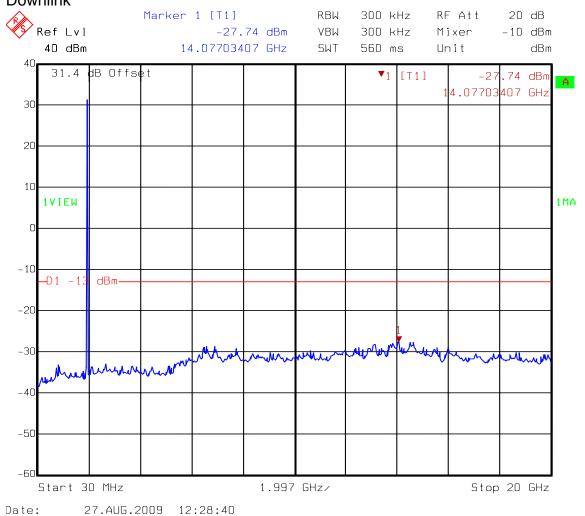
Upper Bandedge Intermodulation GSM

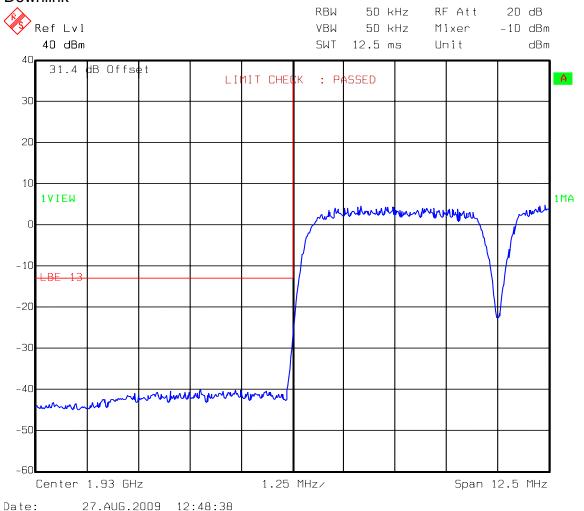

Spurs – GSM Downlink



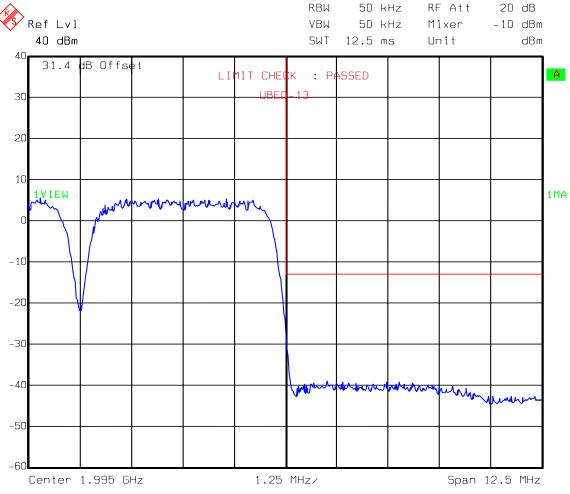

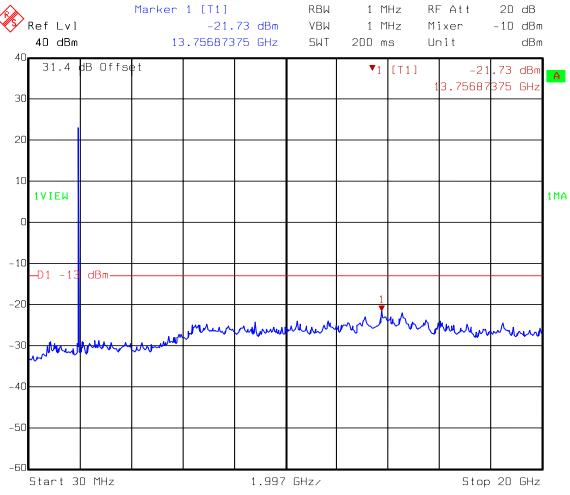
Upper Bandedge Intermodulation W-CDMA Downlink

Frequency Stability With Voltage Variation

The E.U.T. is placed in an environmental chamber and allowed to stabilize at +20 degrees Celsius for at least 15 minutes. The frequency counter and signal generator are phase locked with the same 10 MHz reference frequency by connecting the 10 MHz ref. out of the counter to the 10 MHz ref, in of the signal generator. With the voltage input to the E.U.T. set to 85% S.T.V., the frequency is measured in 30 second intervals for a period of 5 minutes. This procedure is repeated at 100% S.T.V. and 115% S.T.V.

Frequency Stability With Temperature Variation

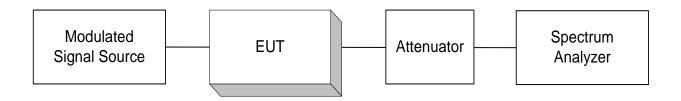
The input voltage to the E.U.T. is set to S.T.V. and the temperature of the environmental chamber is varied in 10 degree steps from -30 degrees C to +50 degrees C. The E.U.T. is allowed to stabilize at each temperature and the frequency is measured in 30 second intervals for a period of 5 minutes.

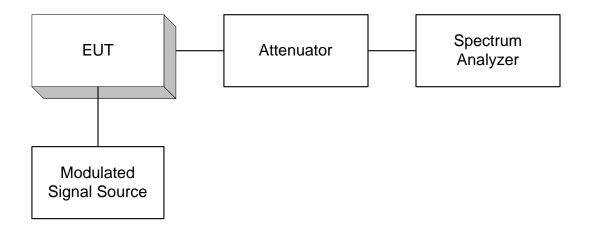

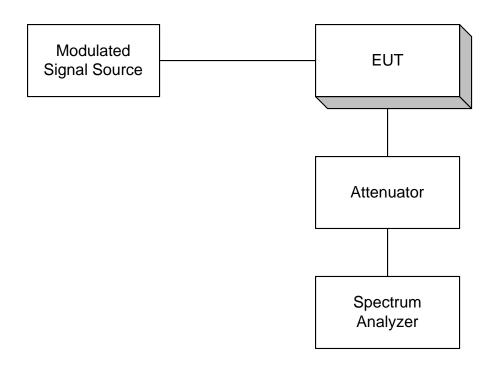
Para. No. 2.985 - R.F. Power Output

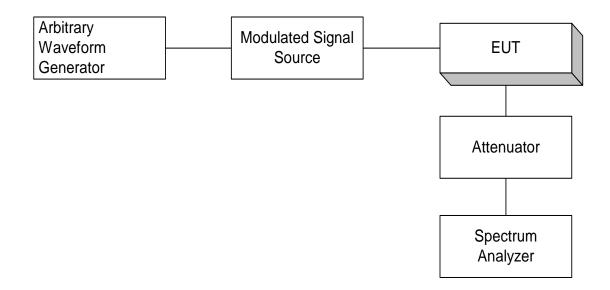


Para. No. 2.989 - Occupied Bandwidth

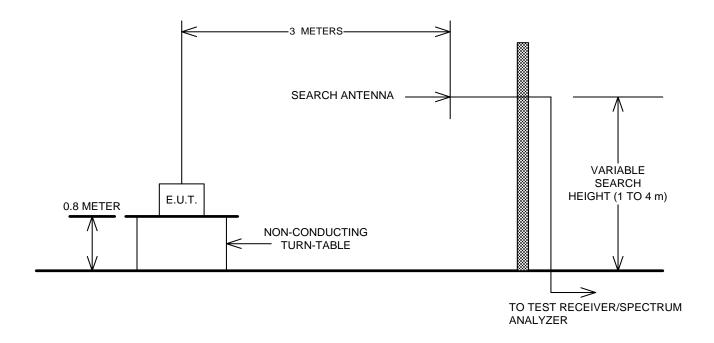


Para. No. 2.991 Spurious Emissions at Antenna Terminals
