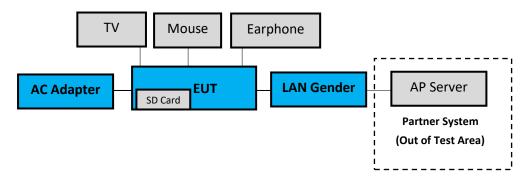

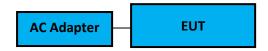

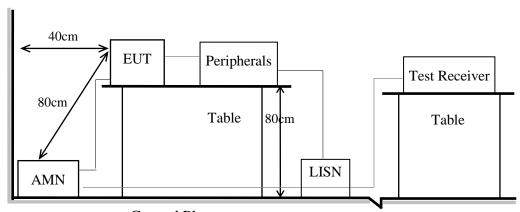

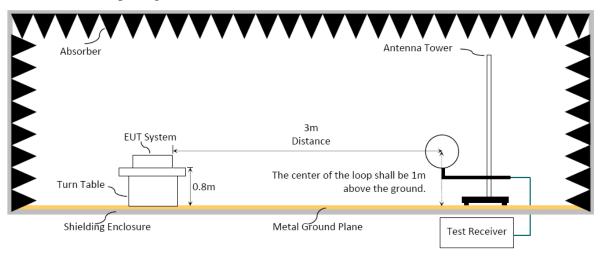

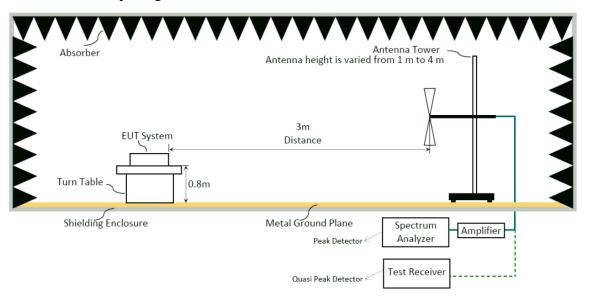

6.1.2. Setup Diagram for 9kHz-30MHz



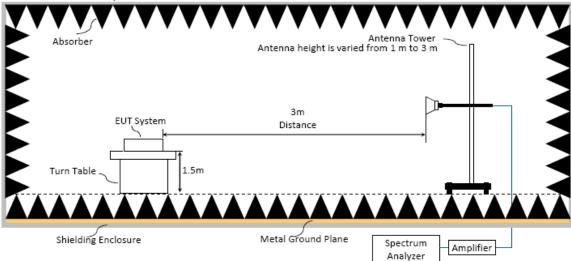

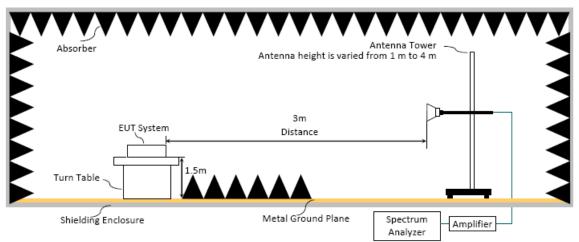

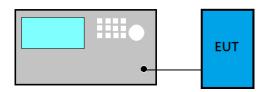

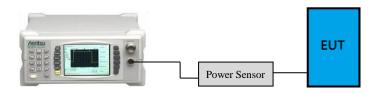

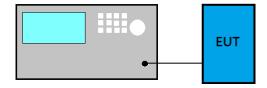

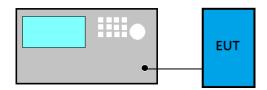

If the transmitter complies with the conducted power limits based on the use of RMS averaging over a time interval, that the required attenuation shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB.

Attenuation below the general limits specified in Section 15.209(a)/RSS-Gen Section 8.9 table 4is not required. 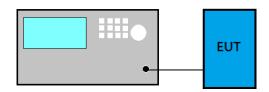
