

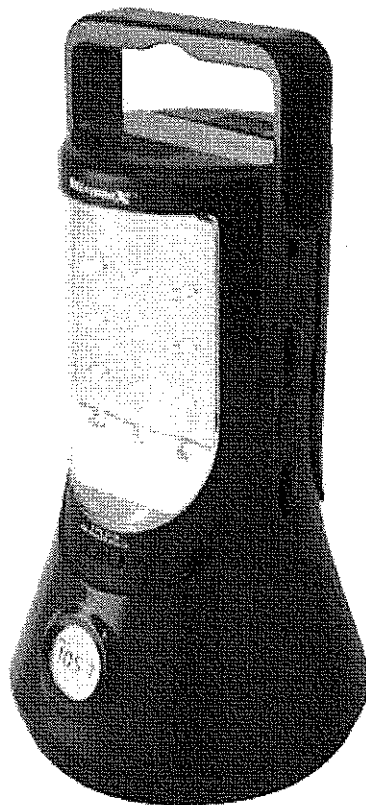

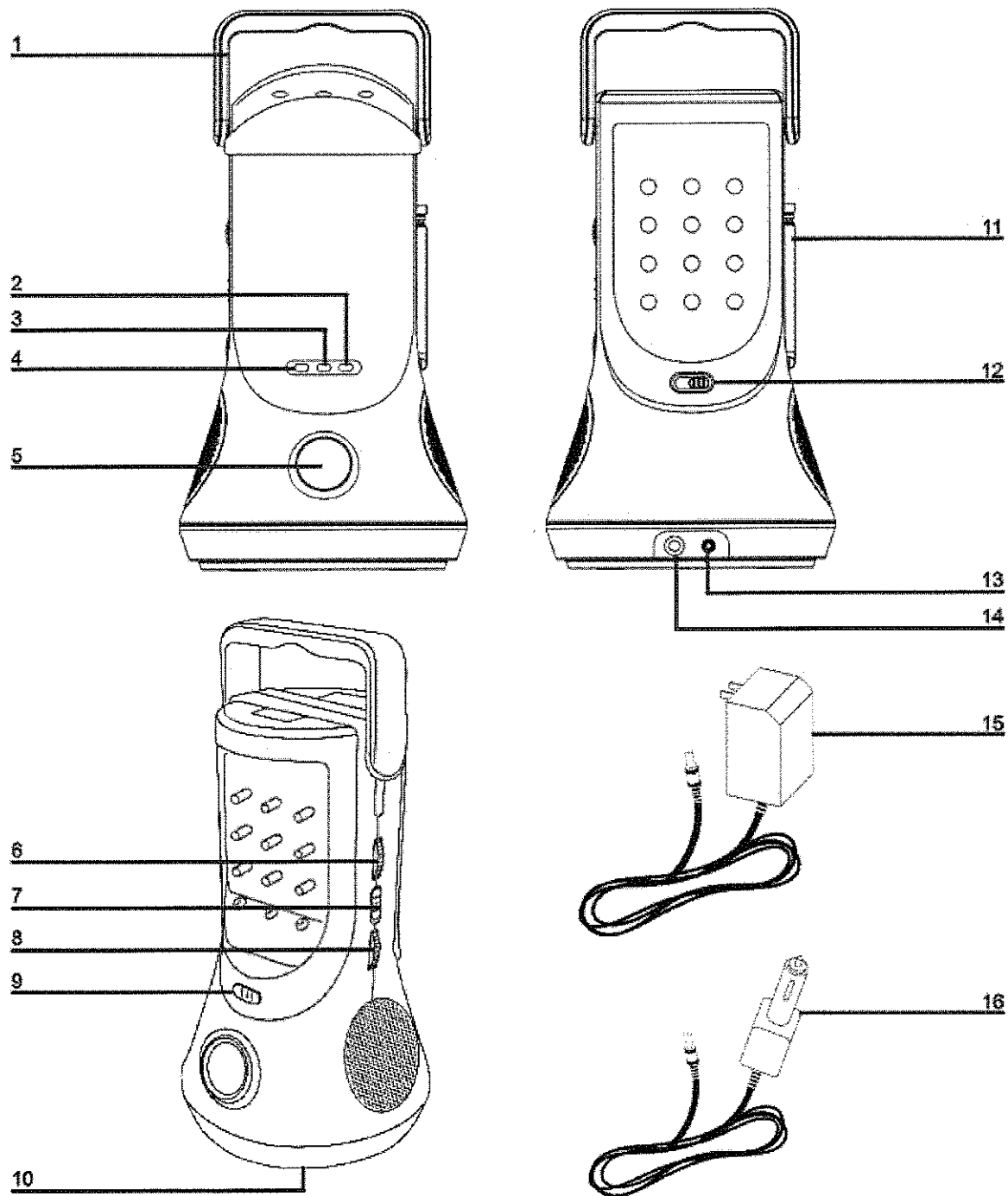
To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove cover (or back). There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Please refer any servicing to qualified service personnel.

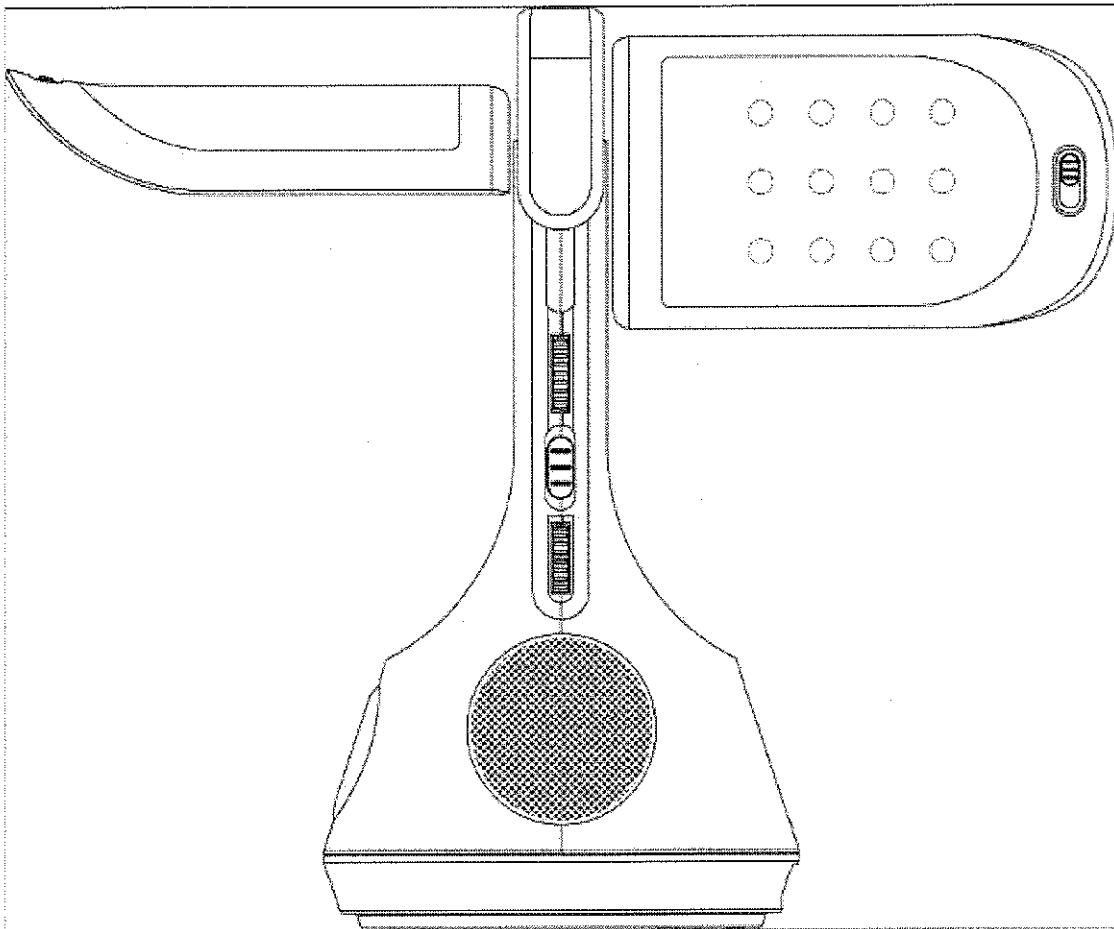
Features



Features Defined

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- 1 Carry Handle** Use the Carry Handle for transporting the player.
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- 2 MIN** While holding the CLK ADJ button, press the MIN button to adjust the minute.
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- 3 HR** While holding the CLK ADJ button, press the HR button to adjust the hour.
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- 4 CLK ADJ** Press and hold the CLK ADJ, then press the HR and MIN buttons to adjust the clock.
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- 5 LCD Display** View the Time, AM Indicator, PM Indicator, and Radio Frequency through this Liquid Crystal Display.
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- 6 VOLUME/Power** Turn the VOLUME dial to power on the lantern radio, or to adjust the volume.
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- 7 Line In/WB/AM/FM** Toggle between Line In, Weatherband Radio, AM, and FM stereo modes.
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- 8 TUNING** Turn the TUNING dial to adjust the AM, FM, and Weatherband radio frequency.
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- 9 OFF/4/8/12** Use this toggle switch to switch between 4, 8, or 12 LEDs.
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- 10 Battery Compartment (6 - C Batteries)** The Battery Compartment allows the player to run off of DC Power (Batteries Not Included).
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- 11 FM Antenna** The FM extendable antenna provides flexibility and range when adjusting the FM reception. An AM Antenna is built into the player.
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- 12 OFF/4/8/12** Use this toggle switch to switch between 4, 8, or 12 LEDs.

- 13 DC In** Use the DC In to connect the player to a car lighter, or other DC power sources.
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- 14 Line-In** Use the line-in jack to connect a digital audio device to the lantern radio.
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- 15 AC Adapter (120V / 60 Hz)** The detachable AC Adapter provides power to the lantern radio.
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- 16 Car Adapter** The detachable Car Adapter provides power to the lantern radio through a automobile's lighter port.
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Special Features



Both of the LED Light Sets extend out from the Lantern Radio and rotate 270° independently. Do not force the light sets to turn if they give resistance. Instead, make sure it is being turned in the proper direction.
