Precautions for Safety

WARNING:

- Do not disassemble, assemble, or modify the RSE System. Such acts may result in accidents, fire, or electric shock.
- Do not spill water or insert foreign objects into the device. Such acts could lead to smoke, fire, or product malfunction.
- This device is a stationary equipment that requires at least 7.8 in (20cm) of space from the human body for installation and operation.
- Please refrain from use if the screen is blank or no sound can be heard as these symptoms indicate potential product malfunctions. Continued use in such conditions may lead to accidents (fires, electric shock) or product malfunctions.

Precautions for Safety

- The cigarette lighter/electrical socket and other electric accessories will operate only when the ignition is on. Improper use of the cigarette lighter/electric socket and other electric accessories can lead to severe injuries or fires. Never leave children unattended with car keys.
- Reclining the seat excessively may result in product damage.



Precautions for Safety

CAUTION:

- Turn on the car ignition before using this device. Do not operate the RSE System for long periods of time with the ignition turned off as such operations may lead to battery discharge.
- Adjust the volume level so that the driver is able to hear sounds coming from outside of the vehicle. Driving while unable to hear outside noise and warning alarms may be the cause of traffic accidents.
- Pay attention to the volume level when turning the device on. A sudden output of loud noise could lead to hearing impairment. (Adjust the volume to an appropriate level before turning off the device.)
- Do not subject the device to severe shock or impact. Direct pressure onto the front side of the monitor may cause damage to the LCD or touch screen.

Precautions for Safety

- When cleaning the device, turn off the device first and clean using a dry and smooth cloth. Never use tough materials, chemical cloths, or solvents(alcohol, benzene, thinners, etc.) as such materials may damage the device panel or cause color and quality deterioration.
- When experiencing product malfunctions, have the product inspected by an authorized Kia dealer.



Display Monitor - Front



Name	Description
1 Power Key	Press to turn the unit ON/OFF.
2 Power Indicator LED	Displays the power on/off state.
3 LCD Touch Screen	Easy control of product features using touchscreen.

Name	Description
4 RESET	Used to reset system.
5 USB Port	Connect a USB device to play music, video and images.
6 Headphone Jack	Headphone connection jack.
7 AV IN	AUX input port - AV cable
8 HDMI	HDMI input jack - HDMI cable

Using the System for the First Time

Turning the System On/Off

Turning the System ON

Press the engine start button then press the power button at the upper left side.



Note

- If the system is set to “Turn power on automatically,” the system will start automatically upon vehicle ignition. For more information, refer to “Power Setting”.

Turning the System Off

Press the engine start button again or press the power key on the RSE system to turn off the system.


Display ON/OFF

Press the Display  button on the screen. Sound will operate even when the display is off. Touch anywhere on the touchscreen to turn the display back on.

Using the System for the First Time

Adjusting the Display Mode

Press the Brightness  button on the screen. Select the desired mode.




Name	Description
Day Mode	Brightness level suited for day time.
Night Mode	Brightness level suited better for night time.

Using the System for the First Time

Adjusting the Brightness

Press the Brightness  button on the screen.


Adjust the brightness to the desired level.



Using the System for the First Time

Adjusting the Volume

Press the Volume  button on the screen. Adjust the volume to the desired level. Press and hold the volume button to mute.



Using the System for the First Time

Resetting the System

This feature is used to reset the system in the occurrence of an unforeseen error or problem.



To reset the system, use a clip or a pin to press into the RESET button.

Using the System for the First Time

Setting the Speaker Mode

Press the speaker icon. Each time the button is pressed, the mode will change between the headphones and vehicle speaker.



Icon	Mode
Earjack Headphones	Earjack Headphones
Bluetooth Headphones	Bluetooth Headphones
Bluetooth Audio Sync - Syncs the audio and video upon Bluetooth connection.	Bluetooth Audio Sync - Syncs the audio and video upon Bluetooth connection.

Note

- The vehicle speakers can be selected for use from one monitor. When in use, the vehicle speakers cannot be connected to the other monitor.
- For more information on connecting Bluetooth headphones, refer to “Bluetooth”.
- This device does not include the sound speaker function.
- For sound output, a Bluetooth (automobile/speaker/headset) connection or headphone jack connection is required.

Using the System for the First Time

Controlling RSE using a smartphone

1. Connect RSE to your smartphone on a common network and start the RSE Remote App on your smartphone.
2. To connect, select Left or Right on the RSE screen according to the seat position. (Seat selection is required only once.)



Note

- To use rear seat entertainment, you must first install the RSE Remote App on your smartphone.
- For Android phones, search for  RSE Remote at the Google Play store.
- For iPhones, search for  RSE Remote at the App Store.

Touchscreen Controls


Learn how to use the touchscreen to operate the system.

Select

Lightly tap the menu or item on the screen to select.

Drag & Drop

Select a menu or item and drag & drop in the desired location.




Drag or touch the slider along the play bar in the music screens to jump to the point that you want to play from.
