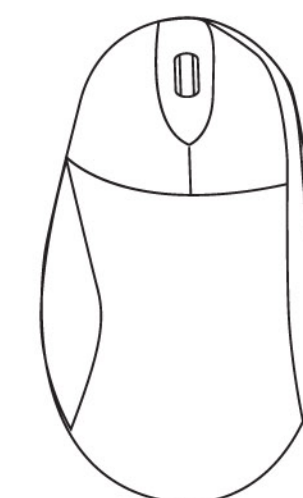
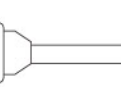
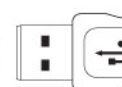

### Connecting to a computer

1. Insert the USB cable of the cradle/receiver into an available USB port on your computer. The device driver will install itself at this point. Wait for the "Device is ready to use" message in the taskbar.
2. Place the mouse into the charging cradle/receiver to charge the batteries.
3. The connection indicator (middle of cradle) will turn solid blue when connected to a computer.
4. The charging indicator (left side of cradle) will turn solid red when the batteries are charging and will turn OFF when the batteries are fully charged.
5. When the mouse is fully charged, the fully charged indicator (right side of cradle) will turn solid green.
6. The mouse will shut itself off after 30 minutes of inactivity to conserve battery power. If it is not responding, press any button or the scroll wheel to "wake up" the mouse.



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### FCC information

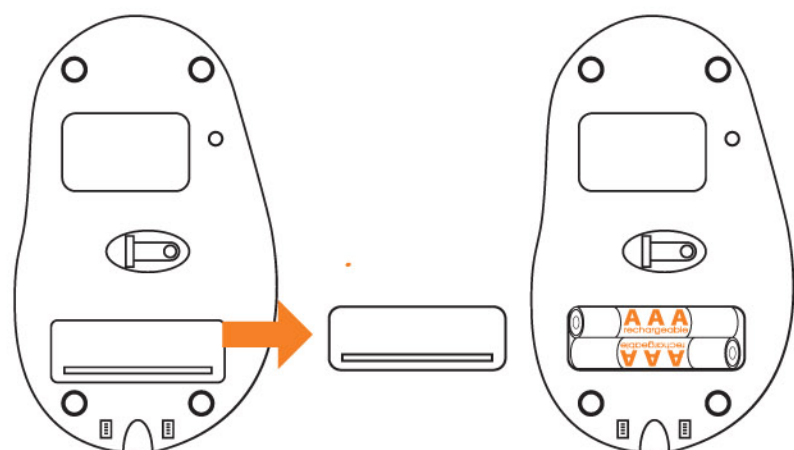

### Installing the batteries

#### WARNING:

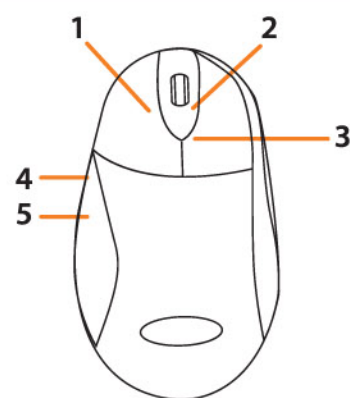
Use only rechargeable batteries with this mouse. Never use conventional disposable batteries with this product as they may explode if charged and/or you will damage the mouse and charging cradle/receiver.

1. Open the battery cover.
2. Insert the 2 "AAA" Ni-MH rechargeable batteries (included) into the battery compartment. Make sure that the (+) and (-) poles are correctly aligned.
3. Close the battery cover.



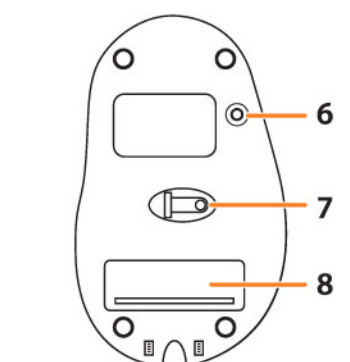
**Note:** When charging batteries for the first time, be sure to charge them for 12 hours without interruption. Make sure the computer's power saving function is turned off during this initial charging phase.

### Location of controls



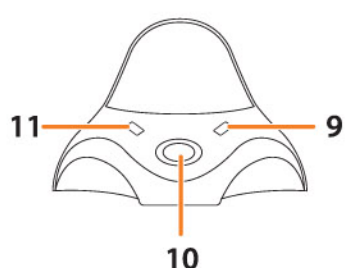
#### Mouse (front):

1. Left-click button
2. Right-click button
3. Scroll wheel / third button
4. Forward button / fourth button
5. Backward button / fifth button



#### Mouse (back):

6. Connect button - mouse
7. Optical sensor
8. Battery compartment



#### Cradle/Receiver:

9. Fully charged indicator (shows fully charged status)
10. Connection indicator (shows connection status)
11. Charging indicator (shows charging status)
