Dear Federal Communications Commission,

Pursuant to 47CFR Section 2.1043, Honeywell International Incorporated requests a Class II permissive change for our DR4220 proximity reader, FCC ID: C4PDR4220. The original FCC grant date for the DR4220 is June 29, 2001.

Changes were made to improve the reliability of the DR4420.
These changes are:

- Grounding changes to the output transistors for the transmit antennae
- Firmware changes to how the output transistors are driven
- Addition of an inductor filter to the DR4220 input power

Units with these changes were verified by CKC Laboratories to still comply with FCC Rule Part 15 Subpart C Sections 15.207 and 15.209 - Low Power Transmitter Below 1705 KHz. Please refer to the CKC Laboratories test report FC06-013 issued March 10, 2006 for the supporting data.
