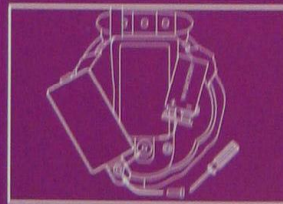

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

REPLACEMENT OF BATTERIES MUST BE DONE BY ADULT.



Each walkie talkie requires 2 x "9V" batteries (not included). To replace batteries, unscrew cover using a Phillips screwdriver. Note polarity of batteries, remove and replace with new batteries. Do not dispose of batteries in fire, batteries may explode or leak.

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

Please keep this packaging since it contains important information.

Functions:

★ TO SPEAK:

In (ON) position, press and hold the (PUSH TO TALK) button. Then speak into Walkie Talkie to transmit voice.

★ MORSE CODE:

In (ON) position, press and hold (PUSH TO TALK) button. Then press (MORSE CODE) button to transmit message.

★ ON/OFF:

Turn counter clockwise for (ON) position.
Turn clockwise to turn (OFF).

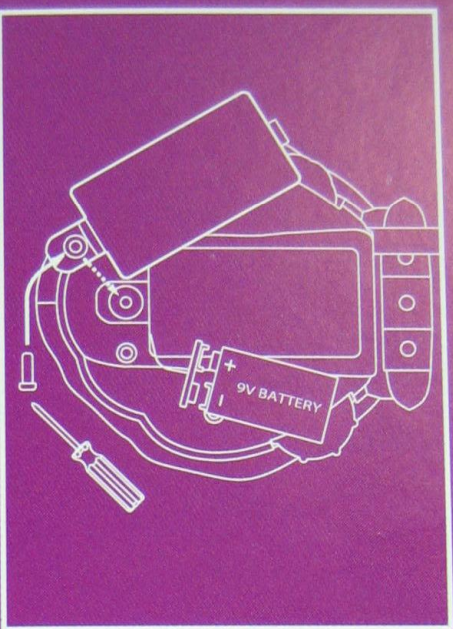
★ FOR BEST PERFORMANCE:

Use within 50 feet - 100 feet of each other.

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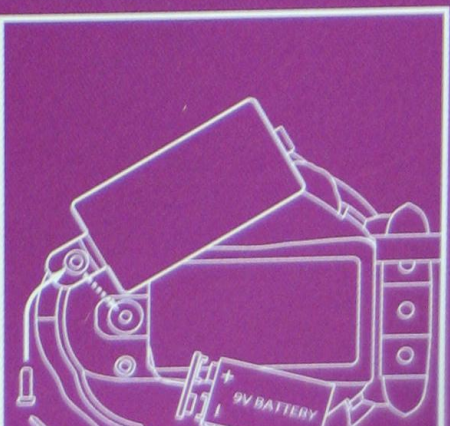
