The Spacelabs monitor is continuously collecting and transmitting patient physiological information and alarm status messages through a Wireless Access Point to the nurse's central station monitor.

In the event of a radio path interruption or out of range condition, the 802.11 b/g radio falls back to an active search mode on designated channels, periodically announcing its presence and continually listening for an authorized access point to resume data transmission.

While operating as an 802.11a radio, the portable monitor shuts down the radio transmit function and passively listens for an authorized access point with which it can reestablish communications.
