Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's rules (47 CFR §§ 0.457, 0.459), we are requesting the Commission to withhold the following attachments as confidential document from public disclosure indefinitely.

The above mentioned documents contain detailed system and equipment descriptions and are considered as proprietary information in operation of the equipment. The public disclosure of above documents might be harmful to our company and would give competitors an unfair advantage in the market. We would like to keep the internal photos and user manual confidential, because our product is installed on or around critical infrastructure as part of the security system and is not accessible to the general public. Radars are placed at the top of large poles and behind fences. The radar is only sold to companies that are under a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) that restricts the disclosure of this information. Operation of the device is done by trained security personnel who SpotterRF or a license system integrator has trained through the user's manual, training videos, or in-person demonstrations and installations on how to optimize the setup and installation of the device for best use. Security personnel never have internal access to the radar and are required to accept the End User License Agreement (EULA) in order to operate the radar. The general public therefore does not have access to an internal view of our product and the user's manual. A copy of the NDA that is used and the EULA have been submitted with this document.
