The public disclosure of above documents might be harmful to our company and would give competitors an unfair advantage in the market. Additionally, we would like to keep the internal photos and user manual confidential, because our product is installed on or around critical infrastructure as part of the security system and is not accessible to the general public. Operation of the device is done by trained security personnel who SpotterRF or a license system integrator has trained through the user's manual, training videos, or in-person demonstrations and installations on how to optimize the setup and installation of the device for best use. The general public therefore does not have access to an internal view of our product and the user's manual.

It is our understanding that all measurement test reports, FCC ID label format and correspondent during certification review process cannot be granted as confidential documents and that information will be available for public review once the grant of equipment authorization is issued.
