Dear Sir/Madam:

Itron hereby requests a Class 2 Permissive Change for an Automatic Meter Reading device for reading of utility meters, FCC ID:E09CCU100TB. The change is to allow for transmitting slightly longer messages from the original certification increasing the Time of Occupancy (ToO). With this increase in message length ToO will remain in compliance. The change has two parts.

The first change is to allow for transmitting slightly longer messages from the original certification increasing the Time of Occupancy (ToO) and decreasing the Duty Cycle Correction. With this increase in message length ToO and all radiated spurious remain in compliance.

The second change is to shift the highest channel for the device up to 926.90 MHz. The upper band edge compliance has been measured and is demonstrated to remain in compliance.

These changes are firmware only, no hardware has changed, and all other parameters and the RF performance remains the same as before.
