Dear Katie:

Here is the response from the test firm, Cetecom, regarding your question about the AC power adapter.

“We did not run line conducted data because the unit shown is for 220 volts. Theimeg is not providing a wall adapter recharger with the unit when the equipment is shipped to the United States. The importer will supply a commercially available 110 V AC wall adapter meeting any applicable FCC requirements.”

“As shown in the photo, the 110 V AC wall adapter recharger plugs directly into a separate battery holder for charging purposes. There are no additional electronics in the battery holder. The 110 V AC charger does not plug into the transmitter as no provision has been made in the transmitter for this type of operation.”
