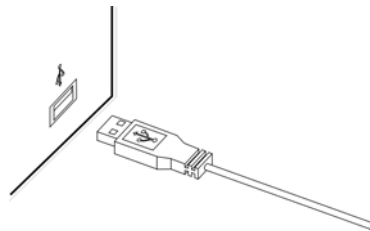

**System Requirements:**

1. IBM or Compatible PC System
2. Win95/98/ME/NT/2000/XP
3. All Versions of MS-Office
4. USB port

**Hardware Installation:**

- Step1: Plug the receiver's connector into USB port of your PC.
- Step2: Install 2AA batteries in the mouse and 2AA in the keyboard.
- Step3: Turn on your PC.
- Step4: System will automatically detect the USB Device.

Note: If you are running Win 98, it may be prompted to insert the Win 98 CD-ROM. Please insert Win 98 CD-ROM to your CD-ROM Drive. Then follow the steps completed the setup.

**Software Installation:**

All buttons of mouse are NOT required driver. However, the Magic-Pop-Up function (Scroll Wheel Button software) offers a convenient way to configure and select up to 12 shortcuts for various applications and files. - Step1: Go to "Support" section and choose the item "3D mouse driver" (Magic-Pop-Up).

- Step2: Choose the version that suits with your language requirement.
- Step3: Double-click the icon or execute the .exe file to install the software.
- Step4: Select the interface.
- Step5: Follow the steps to complete the installation.

- Step1: Go to “Download – Driver / Manuals”
- Step2: Download the version that suits with your operating system
- Step3: Extract the .zip-file.
- Step4: Navigate to the Folder to which you extracted the zip-file and double-click the icon or execute the .exe file to install the software.
- Step5: Select the interface.
- Step6: Follow the steps to complete the installation.

### **ID Setup:**

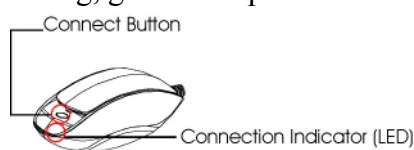
The product has been pre-set. Mouse, keyboard and receiver are already paired. It is not necessary to do the ID setting when you use the mouse and keyboard for the first time. However, the connection may be lost due to RF interference of environment. Hence, it may be necessary to re-set the connection-ID. Please follow the process below for the ID setting.

### **Mouse:**

- Step 1: Push the connect button on the back of the wireless Mouse.



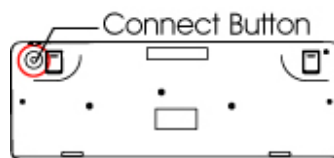
- Step 2: Press the connect button located on the RF Receiver. This step must be completed less than 8 seconds after Step 1. Once the Connection indicator (left side) stops blinking, goes to Step 3.



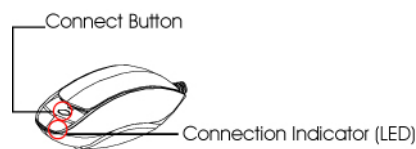
Step 3: When you move the wireless mouse, the Connection indicator will blink. It means the wireless mouse is connected successfully. If the wireless mouse does not work properly, please go back to Step 1. (In case, the ID is occupied by another device, please repeat Step 1 and Step 2 until mouse works properly)

### **Keyboard:**

Step 4: Press the Connect button located on the back of the wireless keyboard (You may need a pencil tip or other small tip to press the connect button.)



Step 5: Press the connect button located on the RF Receiver. This step must be completed less than 8 seconds after Step 4. Once the Connection indicator (left side) stops blinking, goes to Step 6.

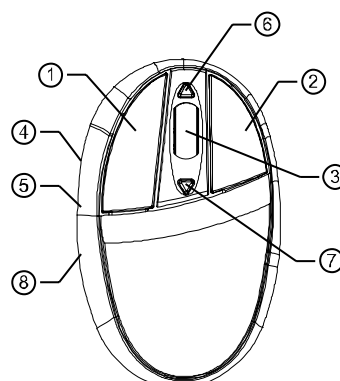


Step 6: When you press any key of wireless keyboard, the LED of the receiver will blink. It means the Receiver and the wireless keyboard are connected. If the wireless keyboard does not work properly, please go back to Step 4. (In case, the ID is occupied by other devices, please repeat Step 4 and Step 5 until keyboard works properly.)

### Office Application Key Block

Help	Open the Help file
New	Create a blank file based on the default template
Open	Open a file
Save	Save the current file
Replace	Open “Search& Replace” dialog box for replacing
Spell	Automatic check spelling and grammar
Undo	Undo the last command <sup>L</sup>
Redo	Redo the previously undo action
Reply	Reply to only the sender. (For MS Outlook or Outlook Express)
Reply All	Reply to the sender and the recipients on the list. (For MS Outlook or Outlook Express)

### **“Word, Excel, Power Point” Hotkey Setup Function:**

**(Note: The above hotkeys will not be working, if you do not follow the instructions below to set up the “Word, Excel, Power Point” hotkey functions)**

1. Click the **“Start”** button, and point to **“Program”** to search **“target application icon”** that you want to setup.
2. Use the right mouse button to click the **“target application shortcut Icon”** to which you want to assign a shortcut key, and then click **“Properties”** on the menu that appears.
3. Click the **Shortcut** tab.
4. Press the **“target application key”** shown on your keyboard. You will see **“Ctrl+Alt+P (for PowerPoint) or Ctrl+Alt+D(for Word) or Ctrl+Alt+E”(for Excel)** appear in the menu depending on the application key you press.
5. Click **OK to complete the setup process.**

So, from now on, you can launch target application by pressing the “Word, Excel, PowerPoint” keys of the keyboard to launch the application you pressed.

**Note :** Following the method above, you can assign any hotkey to any application you prefer. You also can remove the above hotkey setup manually by assigning it to nothing and making it blank under the above step 4.

## **Power Switch**

### **Mouse**

You can turn off the mouse manually.

To turn off the power, please press the Power switch/Connect button for 5seconds.

To turn on the power, just press the Power switch/Connect button.

**Note:** This wireless mouse is designed for power saving mode.

The mouse will "sleep" automatically if you don't use it over 8 minutes.

To wake up from sleeping mode, just press left button or right button.

## **Battery Charging**



1. The rechargeable batteries can be charged whenever your desktop PC is turned on or turned off. Laptop PC only can charge with power on.
2. Install the batteries with the correct polarity. Please refer to the diagram on the battery compartment.
3. Safety timer protection prevents over charging. Once battery charging has been done, Battery Charger will be shut off automatically.
4. Battery charging indicator (Right side)  
LED is on: The battery charging is in progress.  
LED is off: The battery charging has been done.

**DO NOT PUT REGULAR BATTERIES INSIDE THE CHARGER. IT COULD CAUSE BATTERY EXPLOSURE IF YOU DO SO.**

## **VI. Troubleshooting:**

- A. The keyboard cannot work

Re-plug the PS/2 or USB connect and restart the computer.

B. "€" Euro sign key cannot work

Euro sign only appears under the "Office lock" is on. Please press "office lock", then press Euro key (same as number lock) to trigger Euro sign.

C. The Num lock key cannot work

"Num Lock" works only under "Office Lock" is off. Please make sure the "Office Lock" is off.

D. The "Sleep" hotkey cannot work

Sleep mode is available only if your system supports the power management "ACPI" and your mainboard and all the components of your PC are compatible with power management.

E. Some short-cut keys cannot be accessed

The program of Smart Office Keyboard will take over some system resources for the short-cut keys. The following 5 combination keys cannot be used again.

"Ctrl + Alt + E" (Euro sign), "Ctrl + Alt + P" (Full page mode), "Ctrl + Alt + O" (Outline mode), "Ctrl + Alt + D" (Remark), "Ctrl + Alt + C" (trademark sign)
