Request for Modular Approval

Quatech, Inc. would like to have your authorization as a modular approval specific to 802.1 1 b/g radio module model 930-8090-01C-G, FCC ID: F4AWLNG551.

The requirements of Public Notice DA 00-1407 have been met and shown on the following statements.

- 1. "The modular transmitter must have its own RF shielding." The radio portion of the module is contained in its own RF shielding. The shielding is installed at the factory. Please see the Internal Photos exhibit.
- 2. "The modular transmitter must have buffered modulation/data inputs." The EUT has buffered data inputs to insure compliance with Part 15 requirements under conditions of excessive data rates or overmodulation. Please see the Schematics exhibit.
- 3. "The modular transmitter must have its own power supply regulation." The EUT has its own power supply regulation to insure compliance with Part 15 requirements regardless of the quality or level of external DC supplying the module from the host unit. Please see Schematics exhibit.
- 4. "The modular transmitter must comply with the antenna requirements of Section 15.203 and 15.204(c)." The EUT meets the FCC antenna requirements. Please see Antenna information exhibit and internal photos exhibit.
- 5. "The modular transmitter must be tested in a stand-alone configuration." The EUT was tested in a stand-alone configuration. Please see test setup photos exhibit and technical report exhibit.
- 6. "The modular transmitter must be labeled with its own FCC ID number." The EUT is labeled with its own FCC ID number. Please see FCC ID label & location exhibit.
- 7. "The modular transmitter must comply with any specific rule or operating requirements applicable to the transmitter and the manufacturer must provide adequate instructions along with the module to explain any such requirements." The EUT is compliant with all applicable FCC rules. Detail instructions for maintaining compliance are given in the User Manual.
- 8. "The modular transmitter must comply with any applicable RF exposure requirements." The EUT is compliant with all applicable RF exposure requirements. Please see RF Exposure Exhibit.
