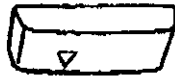

INTRODUCTION:

Your safety as well as the safety of others is important to Telko. In this manual are important safety and installation instructions. PLEASE READ AND SAVE THIS MANUAL.

Congratulations on your purchase of the best wireless door chime accessory available. The audio signal is transmitted to the receiver using state of the art technology up to 150 unobstructed feet.

W001, W002 and W004 transmitters are designed to work with both Telko receiver models. With two types of receivers and three different types of transmitters you can use Door Chime Accessories to customize your installation. 256 codes prevent signal interference for virtually flawless transmission and receiving.

NOTE: You may notice interference when using your microwave oven or other microwave device. This interference is unavoidable, you may also notice a similar situation with other radio products.

APPLICATIONS:

Telko door chime transmitters can be used for front or back doors in the home, small businesses or shops, in mobile and motor homes.

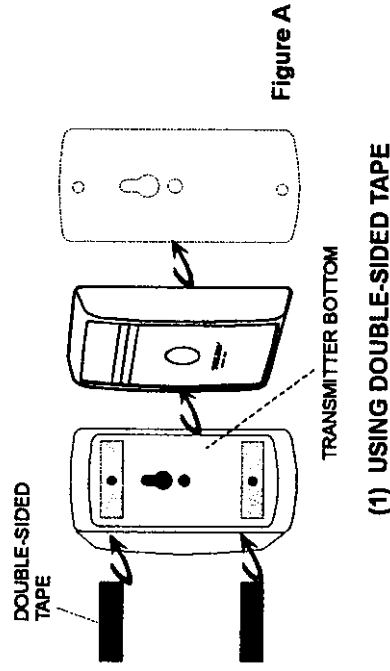

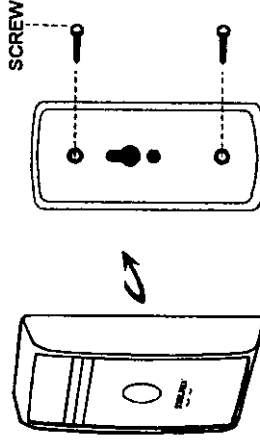

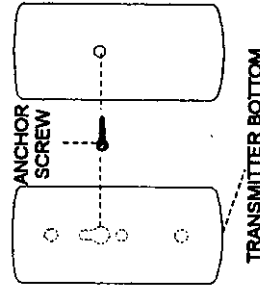

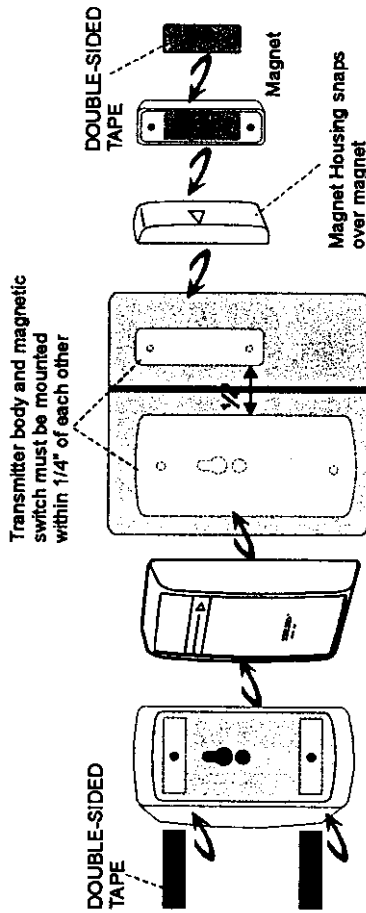

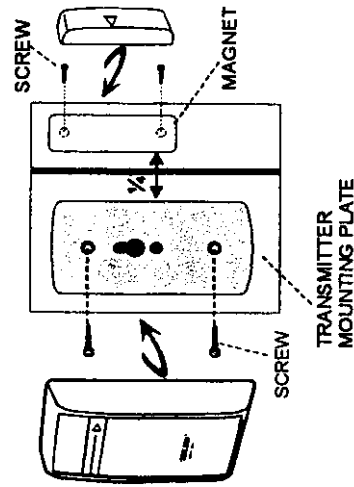

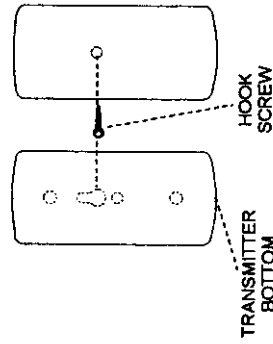

(1) USING DOUBLE SIDED TAPE

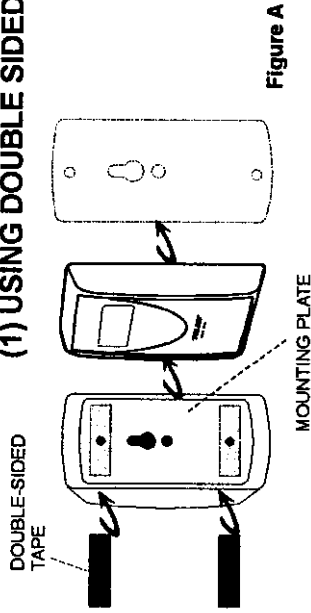

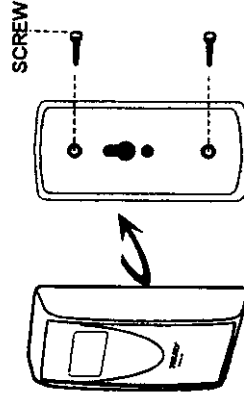

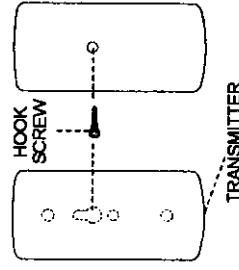

Selecting the chime tone

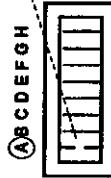
1. Turn transmitter over and locate red chime setting panel. There are 3 small white dip switches, #1 is the two note chime, #2 is the bell tone chime, #3 is the westminster chime. Using a pencil or similar non metal device select the # of the chime tone you want by moving the dip switch to the on position, leaving the other two in the down or off position.
2. Be sure you set your transmitter to the same chime option as your receiver.

Setting or Changing the Code

CHANGING THE CODE ON A CUSTOM INSTALLATION :

If you encounter transmission interference you can change the code used for transmitting and receiving. Turn both the transmitter and receiver units over and locate the code boxes. Snip the same wire position(s) (A,B,C,D,E,F,G,H) on the transmitter, and on the receiver. If you continue to have interference problems then you may want to snip an additional wire position(s) until optimum performance is achieved. It is not recommended that you snip all wire positions.

SETTING THE CODE WHEN REPLACING THE TRANSMITTER:

If you are replacing a Telko transmitter and have already set your receiver to a code other than the factory set code. (FACTORY CODE : no wire positions snipped) You will need to turn the receiver unit over and locate the code box. Snip the same wire position(s) (A,B,C,D,E,F,G,H) on the transmitter that you have already snipped on the receiver.

NOTE ON ALL INSTALLATIONS :

You must snip the **SAME** wire position(s) on **BOTH** the **TRANSMITTER** and **RECEIVER** units, if you accidentally snip two different wire positions, example : Transmitter wire position A is snipped - Receiver wire position B is snipped, then **THE DOOR CHIME WILL NOT OPERATE.**

Installing the transmitter (all models)

Replacing an existing door chime button or installing in a new location (battery installation):

CAUTION : Turn off power to door bell before removing any hardware.

THESE MOUNTING METHODS APPLY TO ALL TRANSMITTER MODELS

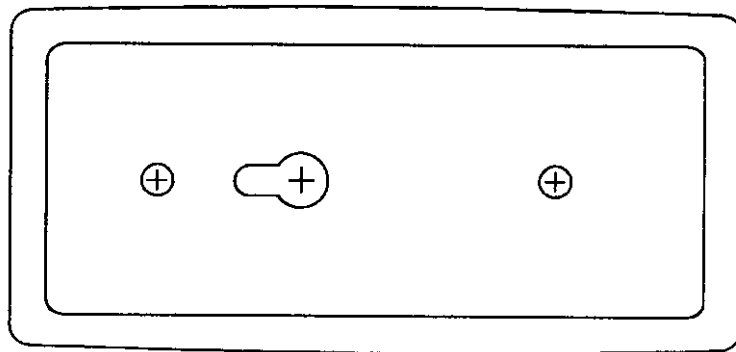
1. Remove the old door chime hardware, if this unit is hard wired place a wire nut over the end of each wire. When installing in a new location skip to number 3.
2. If the removal of the old door bell leaves a gap around the new transmitter, you will need to fill in that area to ensure that it will not allow moisture to enter.
3. Your new transmitter comes with mounting hardware and double sided tape. Before you mount the unit be sure to install the 6V battery. Cut tape in half lengthwise, place the double sided tape on the back of the transmitter under the screw holes and position it on the clean dry surface you have selected. Press firmly in place. (Fig.A) If you choose to use the anchor screw mounting method (Fig.B), then use the provided template to locate the correct hole position. Be sure not screw all the way in, then slide the transmitter body over the screws until it is secure. You can also install the transmitter using the double screw mounting method. Place mounting plate against surface and screw both screws in until the plate is secure, then snap the transmitter body down over the plate.(Fig.C)

Replacing an existing door chime button (hard wire installation):

CAUTION : Turn off power to door bell before removing any hardware.

THESE HARD WIRE INSTRUCTIONS ARE FOR ALL TRANSMITTER MODELS

1. Remove the old door bell hardware.
2. If the removal of the old door bell leaves a gap around the new transmitter, you will need to fill in that area to ensure that it will not allow moisture to enter.
3. Turn the transmitter over and remove back plate. Using a small screw driver, loosen the two screw terminals and wrap the wires leading from the installation location around the terminals and gently screw the terminals down until both sets of wires are secure. (Fig.D)
4. Your new transmitter comes with mounting hardware. After wiring the unit, secure the transmitter as described above using the above mounting methods.
5. After installation is complete it is recommended that you seal the unit with a water resistant caulk to ensure a tight seal as most mounting surfaces are not completely flat.
