# Bluetooth Keyboard Cover

## Introduction\*

The Bluetooth Keyboard Cover touchpad can be used to control a tablet, and the special function keys on the keyboard can be used to adjust the screen and volume, and control media (for details, see special function keys). The keyboard and the tablet can be combined for easy carrying.



## Charging the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover

It takes approximately three hours to fully charge the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover for the first time, or after the battery has been fully depleted. To charge the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover, connect the USB end of the charging cable to the USB port on a computer or on the charger, open the keyboard's charging port protective cover, and correctly attach the other end of the charging cable to the charging port. When the status indicator glows constant red, this indicates that the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover is charging. Use the dedicated USB charging cable or else the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover might become damaged.

## Status indicator

Flashing red	The battery capacity is insufficient.
Constant red	The Bluetooth Keyboard Cover is charging. When charging is complete, the indicator turns off.
Flashing blue slowly	Attempting to connect to last connected device. If it connects successfully, the indicator turns off after flashing for three seconds.
Flashing blue quickly	The keyboard is in the pairing state and can be discovered by other devices. If the pairing is successful, the indicator turns off after flashing for three seconds.

## Combining with a tablet

To pack it up, carefully place the tablet screen down onto the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover and gently push the edge of the tablet until it slides into the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover. When using the tablet, pull it out in the opposite direction.



# Connecting to a tablet


Before using the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover for the first time, connect it to the tablet.

**Step 1:** Turn the keyboard's power switch on, and the status indicator will flash for two seconds and stop. Press **Fn** the and **•** keys on the keyboard at the same time. The status indicator on the keyboard will flash quickly, and the keyboard can be discovered by other devices.

**Step 2:** On the tablet, choose **Settings** > **Bluetooth** and set Bluetooth to **ON**.

**Step 3:** A prompt indicating that the keyboard is **SEARCHING** is displayed in the upper right corner of the tablet screen. If no prompt is displayed, select **SEARCH FOR DEVICE** in the upper right corner of the tablet screen.

**Step 4:** Select **BKC600\_US\*** from the list of available devices on the tablet screen. When the prompt indicating that the **BKC600\_US\*** has been connected is displayed, it means that the keyboard has successfully connected to the tablet.



If the Bluetooth Keyboard Cover has successfully connected to the tablet in the past, it will automatically connect to the tablet via Bluetooth after turned on. If the connection fails, check the tablet to see if Bluetooth is set to ON and then reconnect using the previous four steps.
