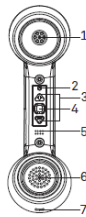

### OVERVIEW :

1. Earpiece
2. Status Indicator
3. Volume[+]/[-]Key
4. Multi-function Button [MFB]
5. Ringer
6. Microphone
7. Micro-USB Charging Port

### A. CHARGING THE BLUETOOTH HANDSET:

- 1.Plug the Micro-USB jack of the charging cable into the charging port of the Bluetooth handset.
- 2.Plug the USB end of charging cable into the computer USB port
- 3.The red LED will turn on when the battery is under charging
- 4.Once charging completed, the red LED will turn off.

### B. PAIRING YOUR HANDSET WITH A BLUETOOTH MOBILE PHONE:

(Please place your mobile phone close to the Bluetooth handset when starting the registration process.)

- 1.If handset is OFF, press and hold the [MFB] for 6 seconds until the status indicator flashes blue and red alternately. If handset is ON, press and hold the Volume [+] key for 4 seconds until the status indicator flashes blue and red alternately.
- 2.Activate your mobile phone's Bluetooth, search Bluetooth devices, select "Retro Bluetooth", and if required, enter the passcode "0000". When the pairing is completed, the handset blue status indicator will flash twice to confirm.

### C. MAIN FUNCTIONS OF THE BLUETOOTH HANDSET:

FUNCTION	BUTTON	*SOUND AND **STATUS INDICATOR
Power On	Press and hold the [MFB] for 3 seconds	*Short beep at earpiece **Blue LED will flash every 1 seconds if it's not paired or connected to any mobile phone **Blue LED will flash every 3 seconds if it's connected to a mobile phone.
Power Off	Press and hold the MFB for 4 seconds	**Red LED will flash 5 times to confirm
Low battery alert		**Red LED will flash every 3 seconds
Answer/End a call	Press the [MFB] once	
Earpiece volume	Press Volume [+] / [-] key during conversation	
Ringer Volume	Press Volume [+] / [-] key during standby mode	
Voice dialing	Press the [MFB] once while in standby mode	
Last number redial	Press the [MFB] twice while in standby mode	
Reject call	Press and hold [MFB] for 2 seconds during incoming call	
Mute	-Press and hold the Volume [-] key for 2 seconds during conversation to mute. -Press the Volume [-] key twice to release the mute	*2 short beeps at earpiece **Red LED will turn on during mute
