## Quick Start Guide

### 4- Turn Device ON/OFF/STANDBY Mode

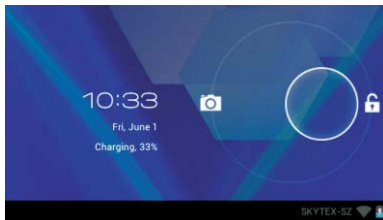


**STANDBY:** To enter standby mode, simply tap and release the power button OR press and hold the power button, then choose the "standby" option. To wake up from standby, tap and release the power button.

**NOTE:** Leaving the device in standby mode when not in use will result in minimal battery drain. Switch the tablet completely off to conserve power between charges.

**ON:** Press and hold the Power button until the Pocket loading screen appears. Once the lock screen appears, unlock the tablet by swiping your finger from the lower "unlock" icon up to the top of the screen (illustrated below). Should the display "timeout" (or go black) before you are able to unlock the device, press the Power button for one second to bring up the display again.

**OFF:** Press and hold the power button until the device options appear and tap "Power Off" to shut down the device.



### 1-Introduction

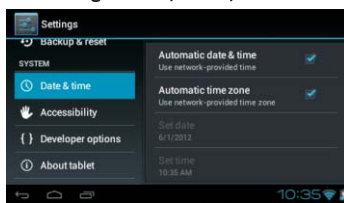

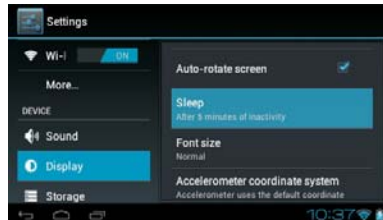

### 5- Settings: Date, Time, & Screen Timeout

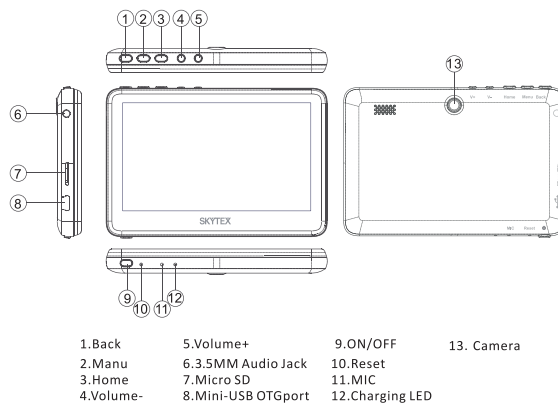


Auto Date & Time  
A. Tap Menu > Settings > Scroll down to and tap "Date & Time" > Tap "Select Time Zone" then tap the desired location.  
B. By default your Tablet is set to "Automatic" for the current date and time  
Manual Date Setting  
A. Tap "Automatic" to unchecked > Tap "Set Date."  
B. To set the month, date, and year tap "+" or "-" to adjust then tap "Set."  
Manual Time Setting  
A. Tap "Set Time" > Set the hour and minute by tapping "+" or "-" to adjust then tap "Set."

Screen Timeout  
A. Tap Menu > Settings > Display > Screen Timeout.  
B. A dialogue box will pop-up with several options to choose from. Tap the length of time (in seconds or minutes) the tablet idles before the screen times out.

### 6-Connecting to a Wireless Network

**NOTE:** To connect your Pocket to the Internet, you must have an Internet connection and a wireless network.  
A. Tap Menu > Settings > Wireless & Networks > tap to check the Wi-Fi box. Do so will turn on Wi-Fi capabilities.  
B. Tap "Wi-Fi Settings" to display a list of available Wi-Fi networks.  
C. Select your network and enter your password/network key.  
D. Tap "Done" then "Connect" to complete the connection.

**TIP:** Check the box "Show Password" to verify password was entered correctly.

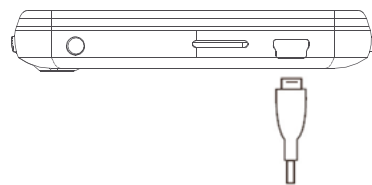


### 3- Charging Your Device

Connect the larger end of the USB Cable to the AC Adapter. Connect the smaller end of the USB Cable to the SKYPAD Pocket via the mini-USB port on the left side of the device (illustrated below). The SKYPAD Pocket can also be charged by connecting your device to a PC with the USB cable.

It is recommended that the tablet is fully charged before the first use. A full charge and discharge (15% or below) cycle is recommended to maximize the battery's life and capacity.

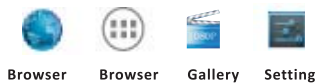
If the battery becomes completely drained please allow 10-15 minutes for the Tablet to charge prior to turning it on.



### 7- Home Screen, Application Shortcuts

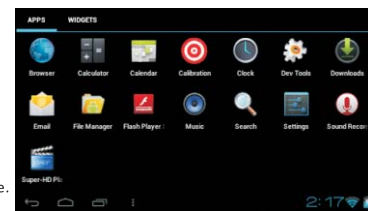


**Home Screen**  
This is your starting point. The home screen features a Status/Notifications Bar, Quick Search Bar, and Shortcut Icons:directo:

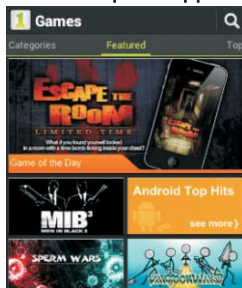


### Add Favorite Apps from App Tray

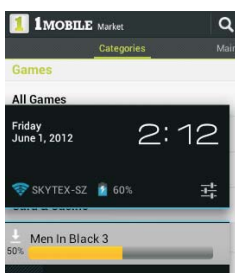
A. To open your App Tray, tap the icon to display all of the applications that have been pre-installed or downloaded to your device  
B. Tap and hold your Favorite app. Release the icon onto your home screen in the desired location.  
C. To remove, tap and hold the icon until it enlarges, then drag to the Trash Can and release.



### 8-Install Popular Applications from 1Mobile Market



To download apps  
A. Tap App Tray > 1Mobile Market > Search or browse for apps > Tap the desired app > Tap download.  
B. When the download is complete, tap "Install"  
C. To monitor the progress of your download, scroll to the top of the app page in the 1Mobile Market OR you can pull down the notification bar to view the download.  
D. Once your download has completed, you will be prompted to install the app. Tap install and once completed your app will appear in your app tray.

### 12-Online Video Streaming

The SKYPAD Pocket is capable of streaming videos directly off the Internet or via 3rd party streaming applications. Adobe Flash Player and YouTube have been pre-installed for your convenience. There are many popular video streaming applications available through the 1Mobile Market. Prior to streaming films, download the application of your choice.



### 9- Browse the Web



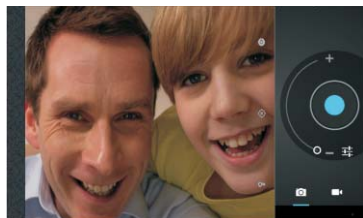
The SKYPAD Pocket is equipped with a full HTML Web Browser that enables you to view webpages.

A. To access the Web Browser, select the icon from the Desktop.  
B. To enter a URL, tap the URL field at the top of the browser and enter the desired link using the QWERTY keyboard.  
C. Tap "Go" to load your desired page



Bookmark a Favorite Page  
A. While at desired page, tap the menu key  
B. Tap "More" > Tap "Add Bookmark" > Tap "OK"

### 13- Webcam and Video Chat



**Camera Use**  
A. Open the Camera application by tapping the Webcam icon.  
B. Capture images shown on the display by tapping the Aperture button.  
C. Tap the thumbnail of an image that appears to view or edit the photo.

**Camera Functions**  
Tap the Trash Can icon to delete.  
Tap Menu > "Set picture as" to set the photo as the Tablet's background.

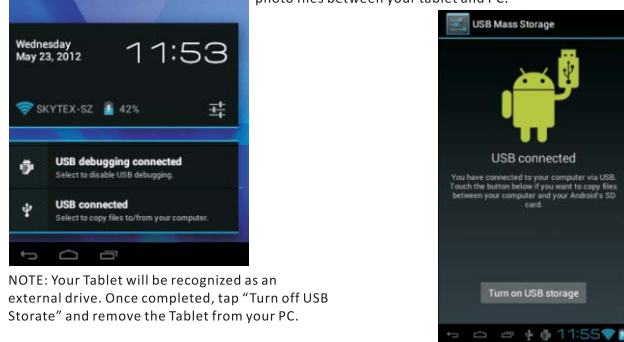
**Video Chat**  
Download and install your favorite video chat app from the 1Mobile Market. The webcam is set as the default camera for video chat.



### 10- Transfer Your Music/Photos/Videos

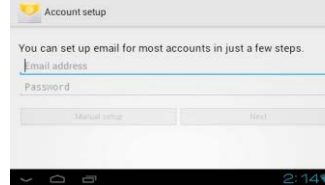
A. Connect your Tablet to your PC via the USB cable.  
B. A USB symbol will appear in the notifications bar  
C. Drag the symbol downward to open your notifications  
D. Tap "USB Connected" > "Turn on USB Storage"

You will now be able to drag-and-drop your music, video, and photo files between your tablet and PC.



**NOTE:** Your Tablet will be recognized as an external drive. Once completed, tap "Turn off USB Storage" and remove the Tablet from your PC.

### 14- Setting Up Your Email



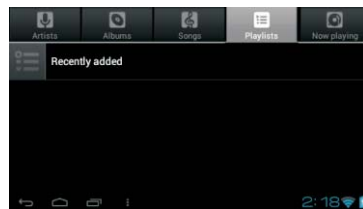
A. From your App Tray tap the "Email" icon to enter the e-mail client.  
B. You will be prompted to enter an email address and a password  
C. After you have entered your information press "Next" to move to the next step.

Some email providers will require you to enter more details about the type of account you are using. You will have three choices: POP3, IMAP, and Exchange. If you are unsure of your account type, please contact your email provider for more information.

D. After hitting "Next" the email app will test the incoming and outgoing mail servers. Once that has completed you will be prompted to enter an account name and your name.  
E. The account name is the name you can use to identify the name of the account on the tablet.  
F. Your name is the name that will be displayed on all outgoing messages sent from the email app on your Tablet.



### 11-Playing Your Music/Photos/Videos



**Play Music**  
A. Go to the App Tray then tap the "Music" app.  
B. Select the desired song and adjust volume settings to your liking.  
C. To exit out of the app, tap the "Home" or "Back" buttons.  
D. To stop music playback, go back to the Music app and tap Pause

**Watch Video**

A. Go to the App Tray on the Desktop then tap the "Super-HD Player" app.  
B. Select the movie folder/file to view.  
C. Once the video begins, you may select playback controls that appear on the display  
View Photos  
A. Go to the App Tray on the Desktop then tap the "Super-HD Player" app  
B. Tap "Camera"  
C. Tap on a photo to view it.



### 15- FAQ' s

**Why do I get a parsing error when I attempt to download apps from the 1Mobile Market?**

We recommend force closing the application and clearing the cache data. To do this go to Settings > Manage Applications > All > 1Mobile > Force Stop > Clear Data

If you continue to receive the parsing error, try downloading the application from the 1Mobile Market's website at [www.1mobile.com](http://www.1mobile.com).

**Why is my SKYPAD Pocket not turning on? How can I reset my SKYPAD Pocket?**

To reset the device first make sure the power source is unplugged. Press and hold the power button for 10 seconds and plug the power source back in. Press the power button for another 3 seconds to power on the tablet.

**Why am I unable to connect to my Wi-Fi Network?**

Make sure that the correct password is entered when connecting to your wireless network. To ensure a correct password is being entered enable the "Show Password" option and double check for a case sensitive password. If you are still having problems you may need to contact your Wireless provider.

**Where can I get Android Apps from?**

The 1 Mobile Market has been pre-installed and gives you immediate access to over 200,00 of the best Android apps available. All for free! Google's Android Market/Google Play is not officially supported at this time.
