Dear Mr. Johnson, Please find below the answers to your questions.

1) FCC requires ACCUMULATED 2 seconds which can consist of many smaller transmissions, and if you look in our reply to ATCB dated March 29, 2007 (responses 4, 5) the battery replacing plus the supervsion does not exceed 2 seconds. For the "Tamper mode" shown in Plot 7.1.2 Visonic's answer is always the same, they are sending several messages (in the picture you see 3 messages which is consistent with our reply dated March 29, 2007), the total sum of each of these message is less than 2 seconds !!!
