We would like to know the FCC"s answer to the following labeling issue. Thank You. ---- TCB Comment to applicant #1: The label would appear to require the statement of 15.19(a)(3). Please update or justify why is it not present. ---- Response from applicant to TCB #1: There is not enough space on the label to add the warning statement, so it appears in the manual. --- ---- TCB Comment to applicant #2: Normally the FCC only allows placement of the label information in the manual if the device is smaller than 8 x 10 cm. The device appears to be of such size that it can be fit elsewhere on the device. Placement other than on the device will require an interpretation from the FCC that finds it ok for this instance. If the applicant still desires to pursue labeling in the manual instead of on the device, please let us know and we will take a few days to ask the FCC to review this issue and provide a response (normally takes 3 – 5 days). Alternatively, please update the current label or provide information regarding a 2nd label for the device. ---- Response from applicant to TCB #2: Please notice that the side where the lable is pressed to the wall and there is a special recess for the label size we are using, so a larger label is not possible. Please apply to the FCC to review this issue. --- Please review provided photographs as well. THANK YOU.

Response:

The label must be consistent with the dimensions of the device. However, the type size for the labelling text per 15.19(a)(3) is not required to be larger than eight-point, virtually the same as the FCC Identifier (whenever applicable). Reference Section 2.925(g). The sample labels and FCC logos can be found at our website at: http://oets6.fcc.gov/oet/ea/labels.html.

Furthermore, Section 15.19(a)(5) states that whenever a device is so small that it is not practical to place the statement on the device, it may be placed in your users manual.
