






Location of controls



- 1. [<<] button: Skip to previous song
- 2. [C ||] button: Play/pause; answer call/end call
- 3. [>>] button: Skip to next song
- 4. [+] button: Increase volume
- 5. [-] button: Decrease volume
- 6. LED indicator light



Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device


1. Slide the power switch on the back of the speaker to the ON position.
2. A tone will be heard and the LED indicator light will flash BLUE.
3. Keep the speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
4. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.




If there are no paired devices in range when the speaker is turned on, it will go into pairing mode automatically. If a paired device is in range, the speaker will connect to it automatically.

On an iPhone

- Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



Make sure you charge the speaker for at least 5 hours before using it for the first time.

Using your Bluetooth Speaker

Powering ON/OFF

Slide the power switch on the back of the speaker to the ON or OFF position.

Adjusting the volume

- Quickpress the [+] button to gradually increase the volume; press and HOLD it to continually increase the volume to maximum level.
- Quickpress the [-] button to gradually decrease the volume; press and HOLD it to continually decrease the volume to minimum level.

You can also adjust the volume from your connected device's volume control.

Answering/Ending a call

- To answer a call, quickpress the [C ||] button.
- To end a call, quickpress the [C ||] button.

To make a call

Dial the number and press the send button on your mobile phone. The call will automatically be transferred to the speaker.

To reject a call


Press and HOLD the [C ||] button for 3 seconds.




On a BlackBerry
• Go to SETTINGS/OPTIONS > BLUETOOTH
• Enable BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On an Android Phone
• Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH > MENU > Search for devices (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On other Cell Phones/Devices
• Review the instruction manual that came with your phone/device.





Using as a wired speaker

1. Turn on the speaker.
2. Connect one end of the 3.5mm AUX Cable to the AUX IN jack on the back of the speaker, and the other end of the cable to an external device's headphone jack (smartphone, tablet, MP3 player).
3. Use the controls on your connected device to control music playback and volume.



Powering ON/OFF
Slide the power switch on the back of the speaker to the ON or OFF position.

Troubleshooting tips

Playing Music



I can pair the Bluetooth Speaker with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music.

1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device or the speaker.
3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your device.

I cannot get the Bluetooth Speaker into pairing mode.

1. Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. The speaker will emit a tone and the LED indicator light will flash BLUE.
3. The speaker is now in pairing mode.

My Bluetooth device is not able to pair with the Bluetooth Speaker.

1. Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. Keep your Bluetooth Speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
3. The speaker will emit a tone and the LED indicator light will flash BLUE.

Skipping songs

- Quickpress the [<<] button to skip to the previous song.
- Quickpress the [>>] button to skip to the next song.

Adjusting the volume

- Quickpress the [+] button to gradually increase the volume; press and HOLD it to continually increase the volume to maximum level.
- Quickpress the [-] button to gradually decrease the volume; press and HOLD it to continually decrease the volume to minimum level.



You can also adjust the volume from your connected device's volume control.
