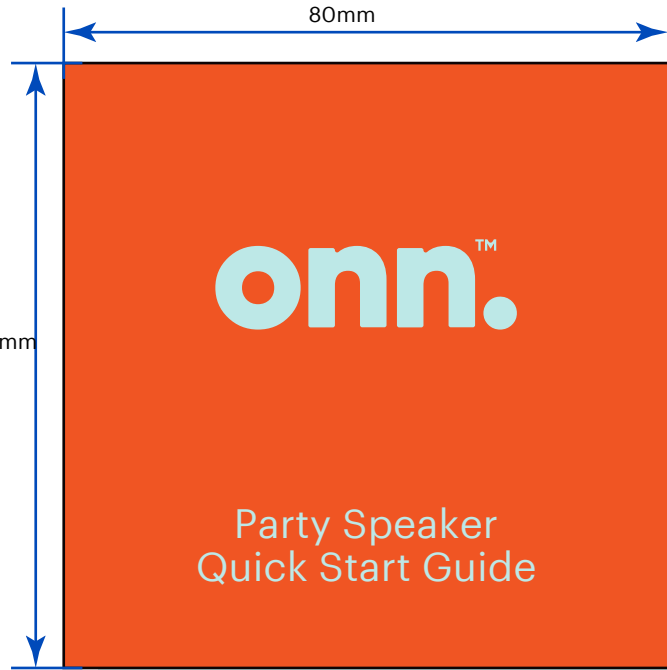

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read these instructions.
2. Keep these instructions.
3. Heed all warnings.
4. Follow all instructions.
5. Do not use this apparatus near water.
6. Clean only with dry cloth.
7. Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
8. Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong is provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
10. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the pointwhere they exit from the apparatus.
11. Only use attachment/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
12. Use only the cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table specified by the manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, use caution when moving the cart/apparatus combination to avoid injury from tip-over.

SERVICE INSTRUCTIONS

- Disconnect power cord before servicing.

- For AC line powered units - Before returning repaired unit to user, use an ohmmeter to measure from both AC plug blades to all exposed metal parts. The resistance should be more than 2,000,000 ohms.

7. No bloquee las aberturas de ventilación. Instale el equipo de acuerdo con las instrucciones del fabricante.
8. No instale el equipo cerca de fuentes de calor tales como radiadores, aberturas de entrada de calefacción, calefactores u otros aparatos (incluidos amplificadores) que generen calor.
9. No anule la función de seguridad del enchufe tipo polarizado o con conexión a tierra. Un enchufe polarizado tiene dos patillas, una más ancha que la otra. Un enchufe de tipo de conexión a tierra tiene dos patillas y una clavija de puesta a tierra. La patilla ancha o la tercera clavija son para su seguridad. Si el enchufe provisto no entra en su tomacorriente, consulte a un electricista y solicite el reemplazo del tomacorriente obsoleto.
10. Proteja el cable de alimentación de modo que no lo pisen ni quede estrangulado, particularmente en los enchufes, tomacorrientes y el punto donde sale del equipo.
11. Use sólo agregados y accesorios especificados por el fabricante. debe conectarse a un tomacorriente del suministro eléctrico con una conexión a tierra de protección.

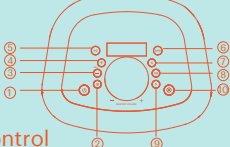
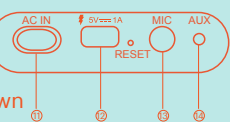

Charging

- Insert the included power cable to charge the unit.
- Notes: The unit can be used with the power cable while it simultaneously charges the battery. When four charging indicators light up, indicates that the battery is fully charged.
- Charge fully before storing a battery which has not been in use for a long period. Store the speaker in a cool, dry place.
- You must charge the battery once a month to maintain battery performance. If the battery is stored for a long period without being charged, its battery life may be shortened.

Bluetooth pairing

-
1. Hold to power on the product.
 2. The Bluetooth icon in the display will start blinking rapidly.
 3. Active the Bluetooth function on your device and search Bluetooth devices, and select "onn. Party SPK MD" to start connecting.
 4. Once paired, you will hear "Bluetooth Connected".
- During music play:
- Turn the right Master volume knob to adjust volume.
 - Press to pause or resume music play.
 - Press to skip to the previous/next song.

Wireless Stereo Pairing

-
1. Short press " " of either speaker to enter True Wireless Stereo Pairing mode, the LINK icon on the display will start blinking rapidly.
 2. When the two speakers connected, LINK icon will turn on steadily.
 3. Long press " " to disconnect True Wireless Stereo mode.

Aux Connection

- Notes:
1. Use a 3.5mm cable (not included) to connect the speaker to another audio source.
 2. In AUX mode, can't be controlled.

FM

-
1. Press to the FM mode.
 2. A. Press repeatedly to tune to a station step by step.
 - B. Hold to tune to a station automatically.
 3. Use the Master volume knob to adjust volume.

Connecting Microphone

-
1. Connect your Microphone(not included) or Guitar(not included) to the MIC/Guitar socket.
 2. Play Guitar through the speaker.
 3. Sing along with the Microphone when music played on Bluetooth/Aux/FM mode.

USB Charging/Control the light

-
1. Connect your device's charging cable through the 5V 1A charging socket to charge it. USB charging only functions when the unit's power is turned on.
 - Notes: To charge smartphones and tablets faster, put the device's screen to sleep.
1. Hold to turn on / turn off the light mode.
 2. Short press repeatedly to select 5 available display modes.
