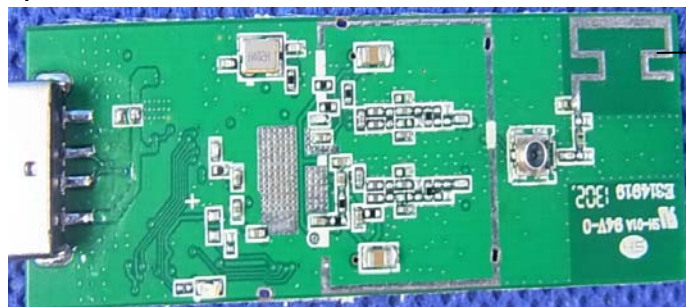

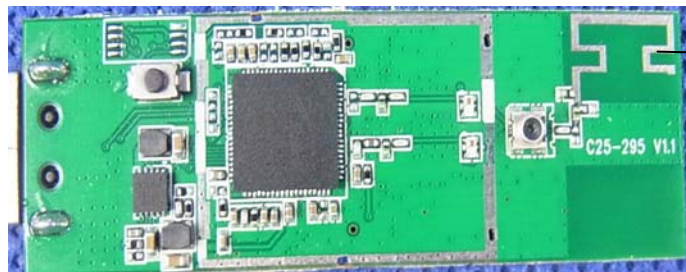

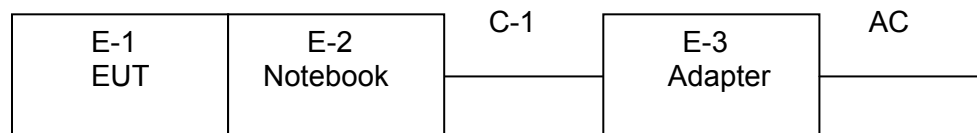

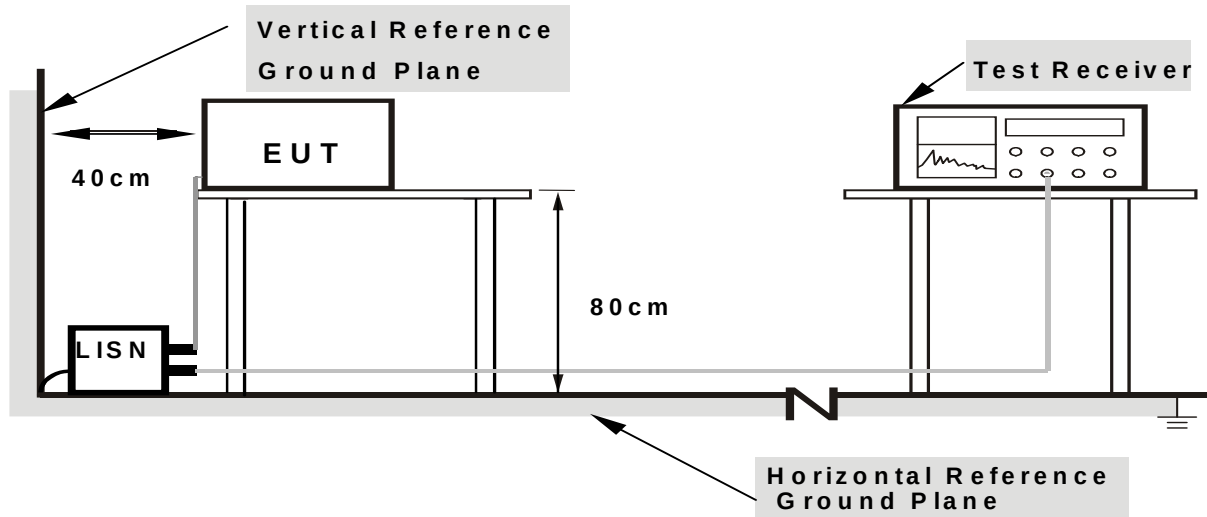
3.1.2 TEST PROCEDURE

- The EUT was placed 0.4 meters from the horizontal ground plane with EUT being connected to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN). All other support equipments powered from additional LISN(s). The LISN provide 50 Ohm/ 50uH of coupling impedance for the measuring instrument.
- Interconnecting cables that hang closer than 40 cm to the ground plane shall be folded back and forth in the center forming a bundle 30 to 40 cm long.
- I/O cables that are not connected to a peripheral shall be bundled in the center. The end of the cable may be terminated, if required, using the correct terminating impedance. The overall length shall not exceed 1 m.
- LISN at least 80 cm from nearest part of EUT chassis.

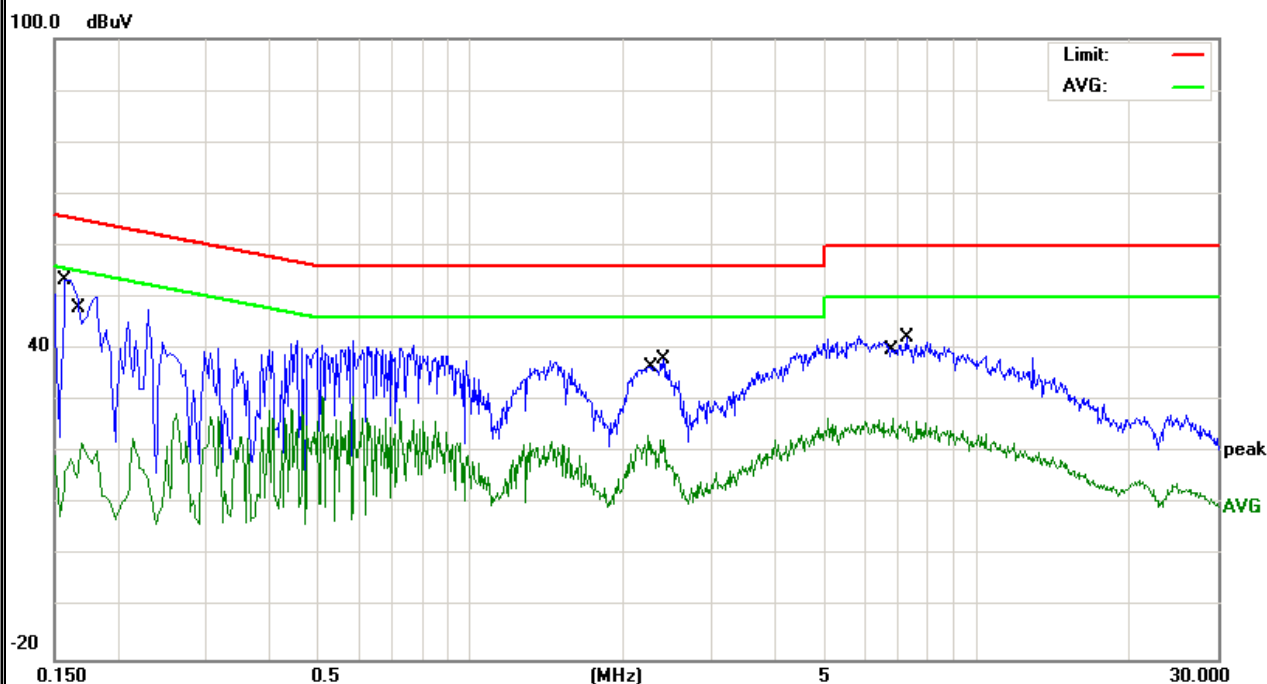

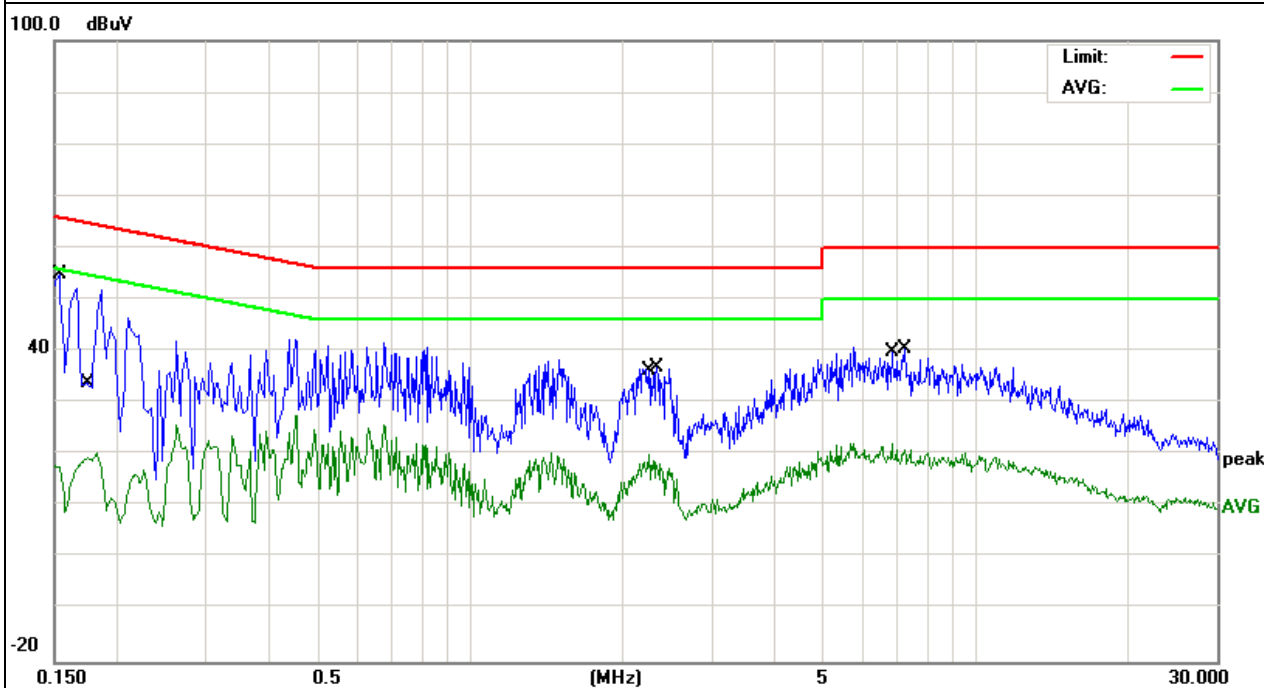

3.2.2 TEST PROCEDURE

- a. The measuring distance of at 3 m shall be used for measurements at frequency up to 1GHz. For frequencies above 1GHz, any suitable measuring distance may be used.
- b. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 meters above the ground at a 3 meter open area test site. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- c. The height of the equipment or of the substitution antenna shall be 0.8 m; the height of the test antenna shall vary between 1 m to 4 m. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. The initial step in collecting conducted emission data is a spectrum analyzer peak detector mode pre-scanning the measurement frequency range. Significant peaks are then marked and then Quasi Peak detector mode re-measured.
- e. If the Peak Mode measured value compliance with and lower than Quasi Peak Mode Limit, the EUT shall be deemed to meet QP Limits and then no additional QP Mode measurement performed.
- f. For the actual test configuration, please refer to the related Item –EUT Test Photos.

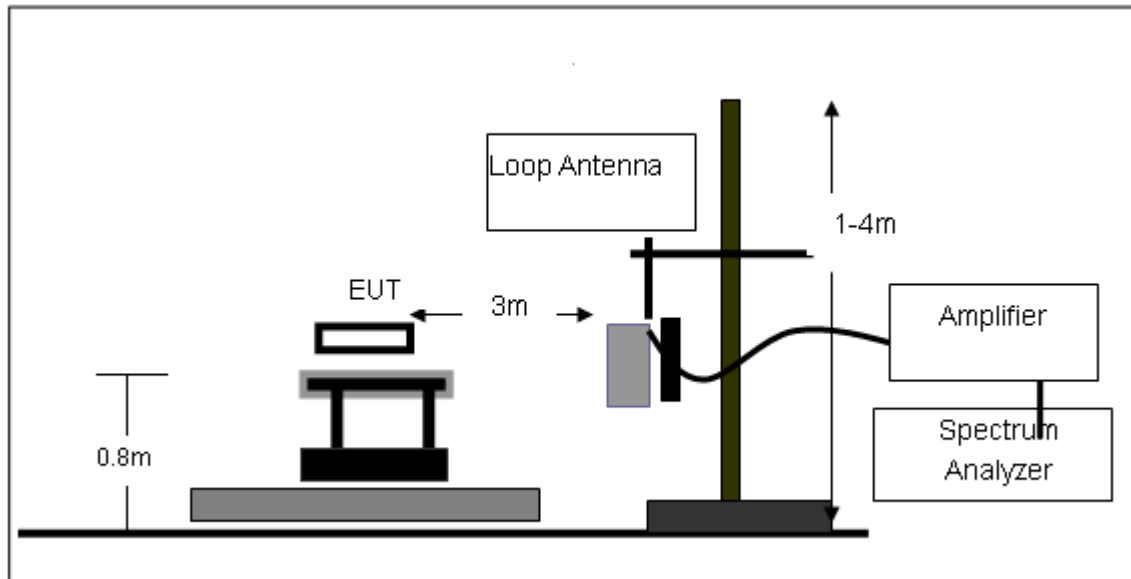

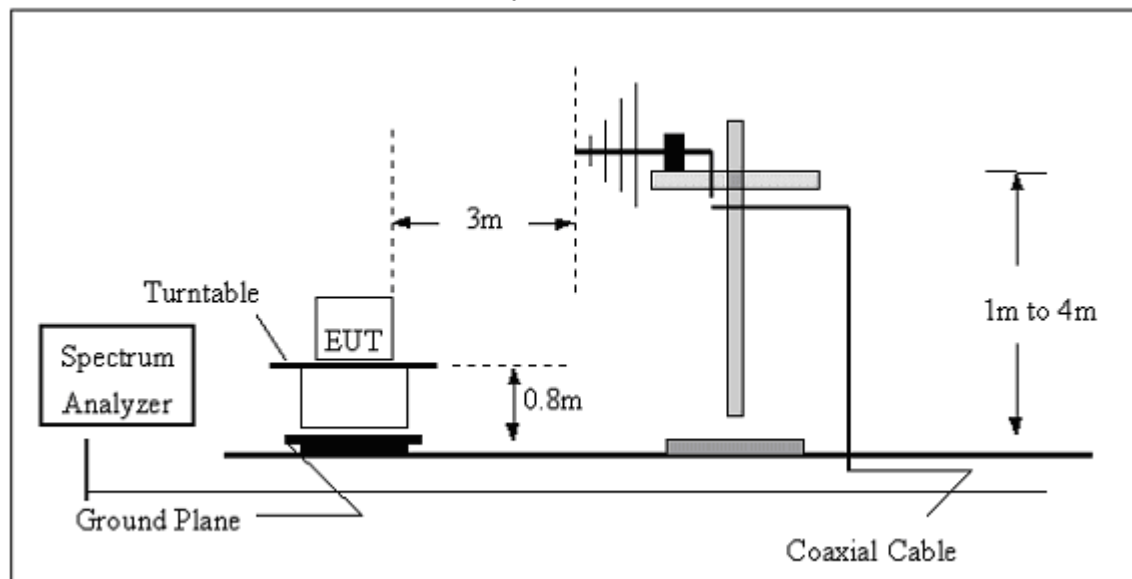

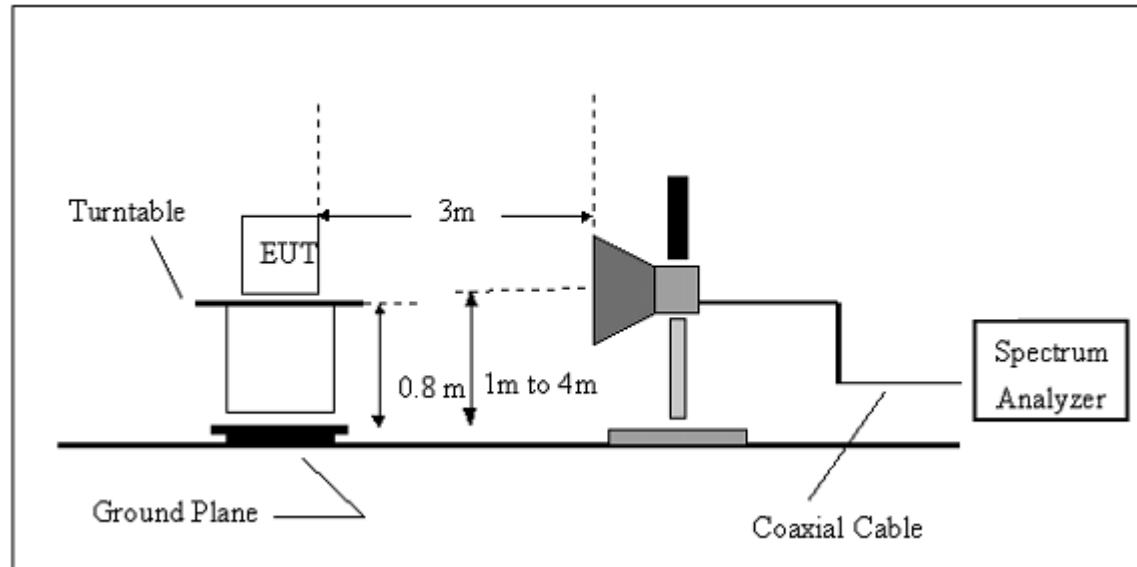
(A) Radiated Emission Test-Up Frequency Below 30MHz

26 dB Bandwidth Plot on 802.11a Channel 40(Ant A and B)



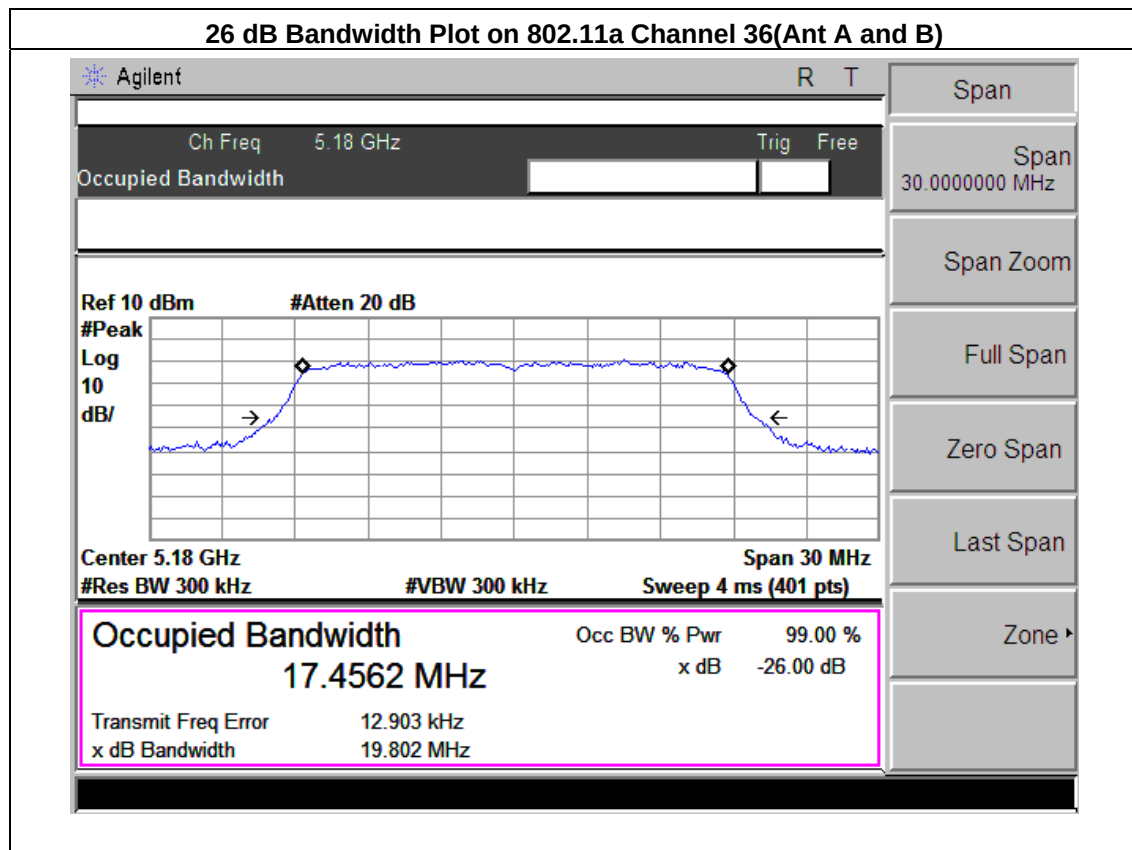

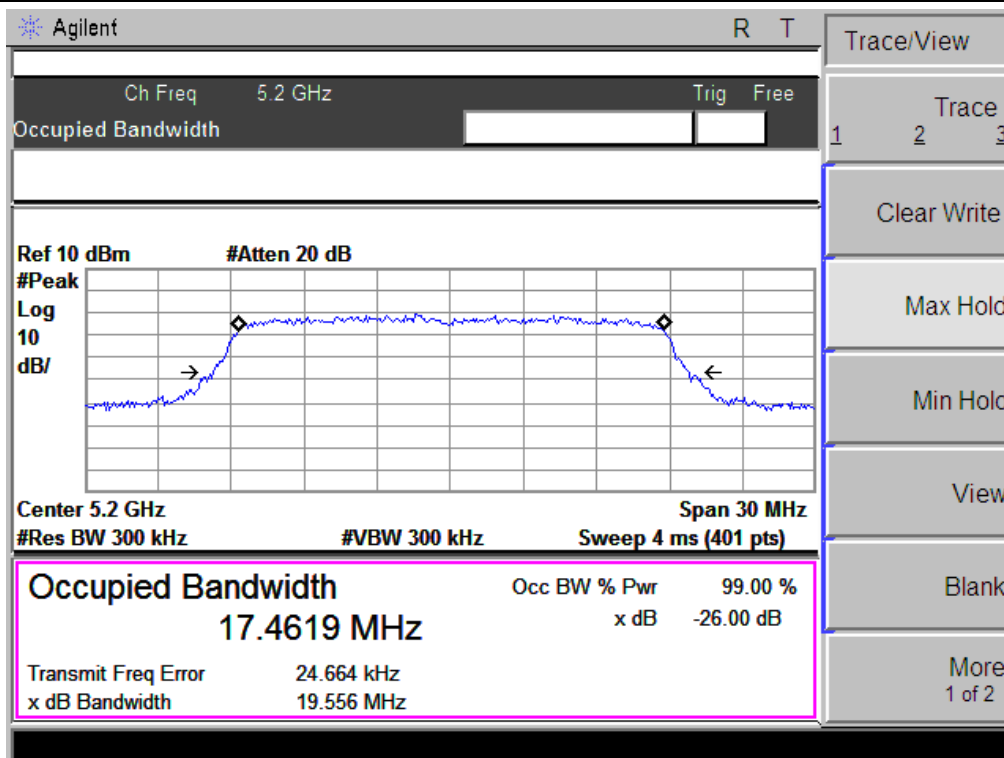

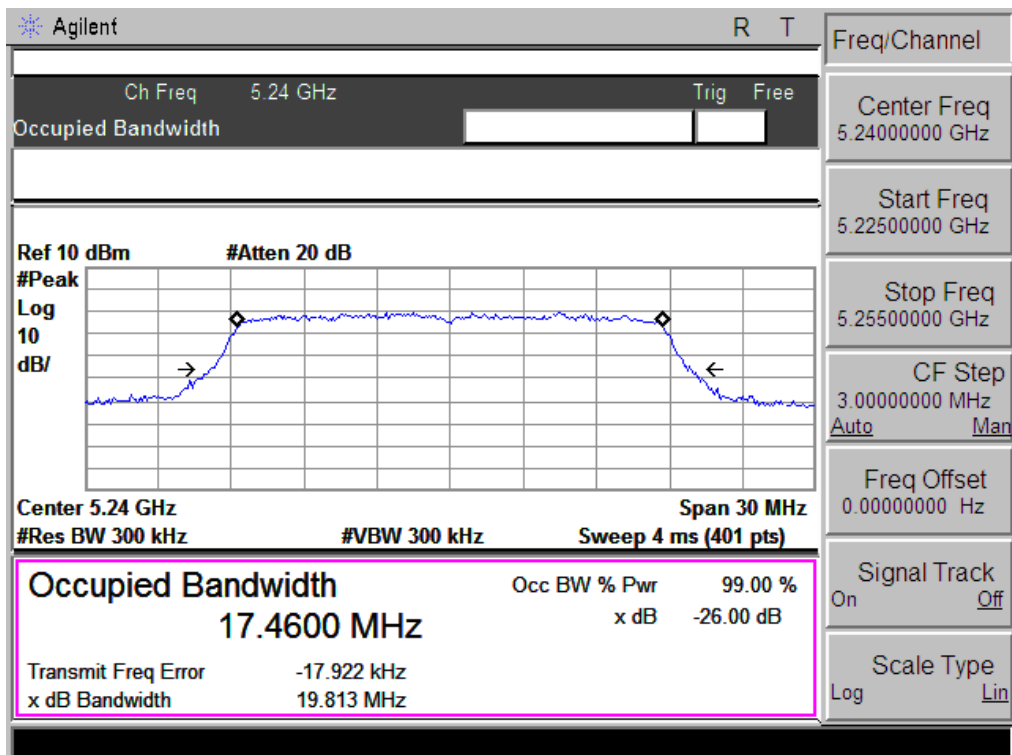

6. MAXIMUM CONDUCTED OUTPUT POWER

6.1 APPLIED PROCEDURES / LIMIT

For the band 5.15~5.25 GHz, the maximum conducted output power shall not exceed the lesser of 50 mW (17dBm) or $4 \text{ dBm} + 10\log B$, where B is the 26 dB emissions bandwidth in MHz. 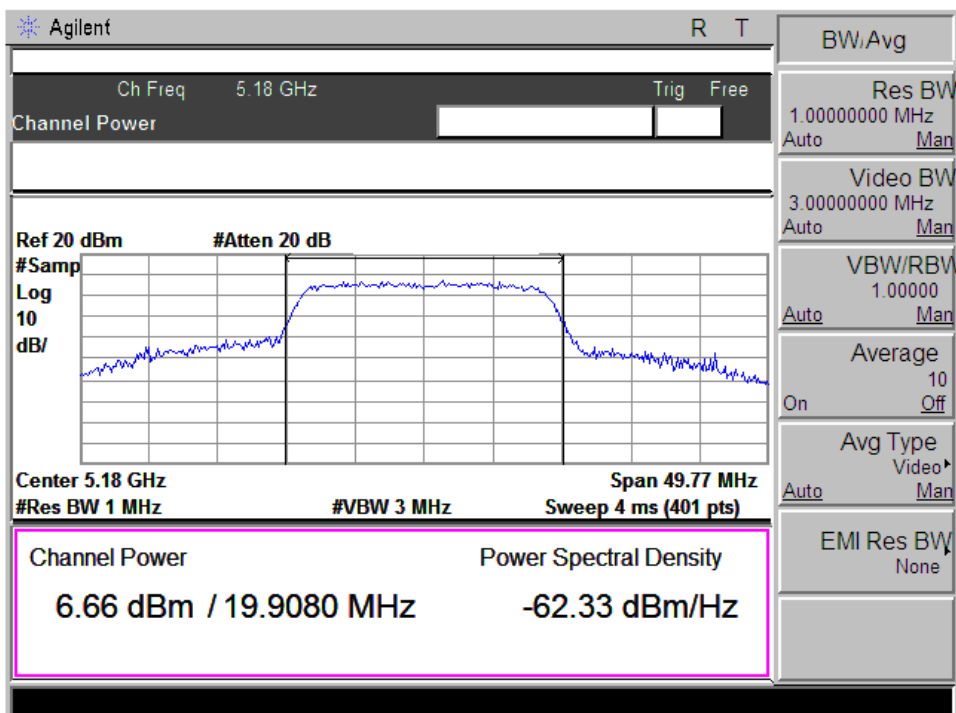

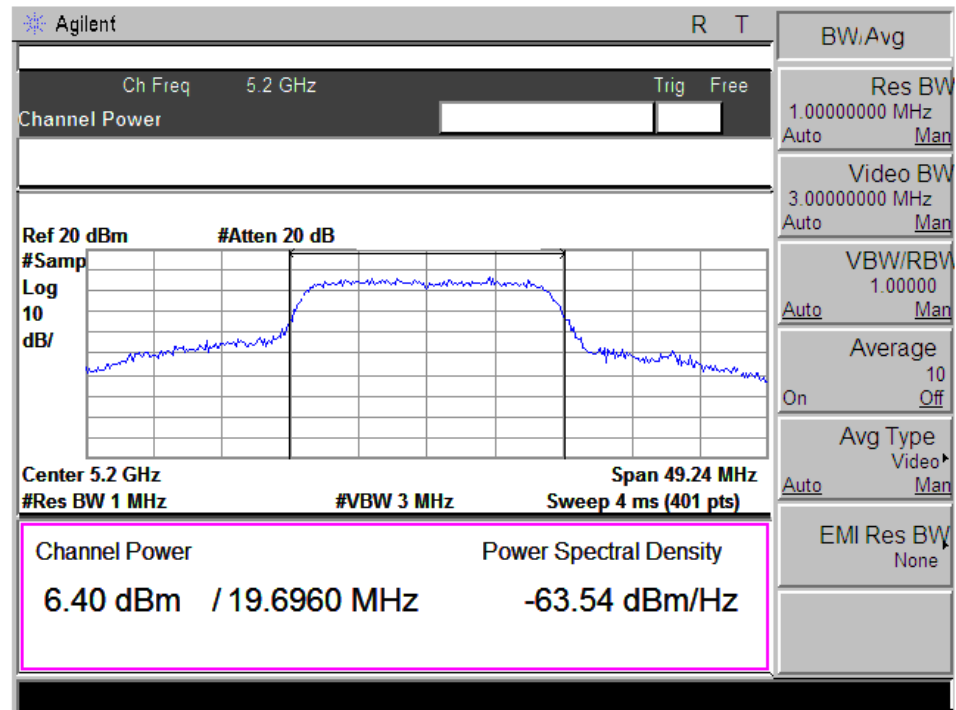

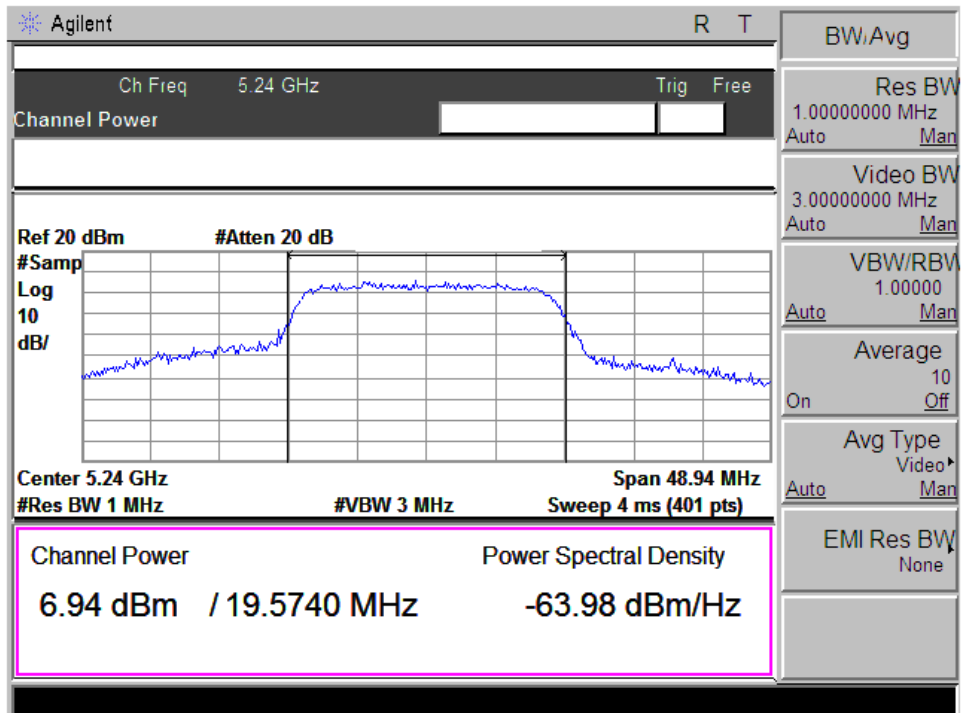
Output Power Plot on 802.11a Channel 36



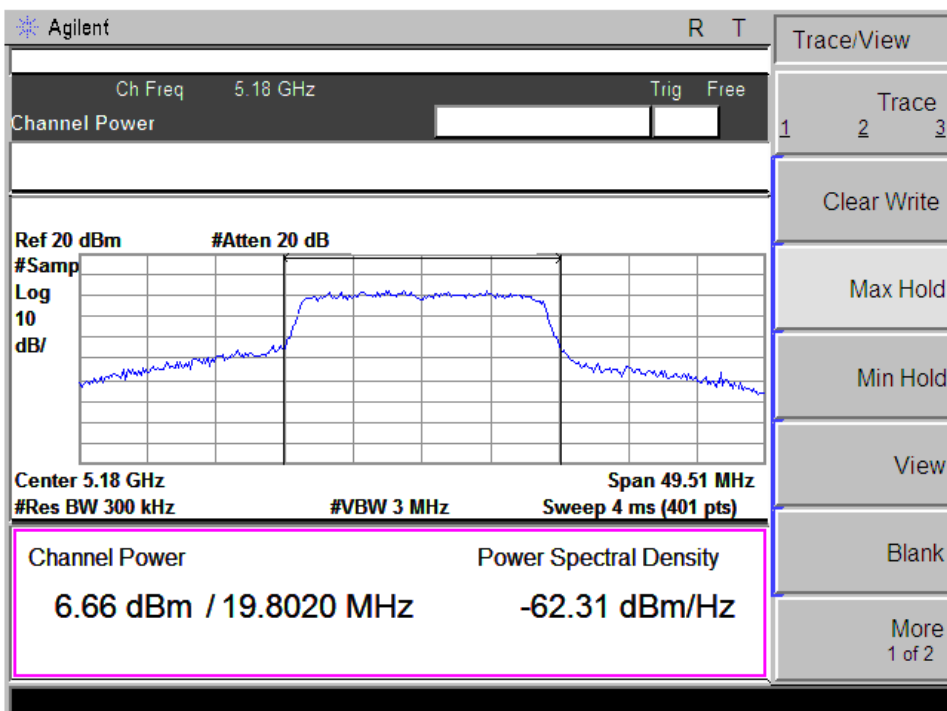
Output Power Plot on 802.11a Channel 40



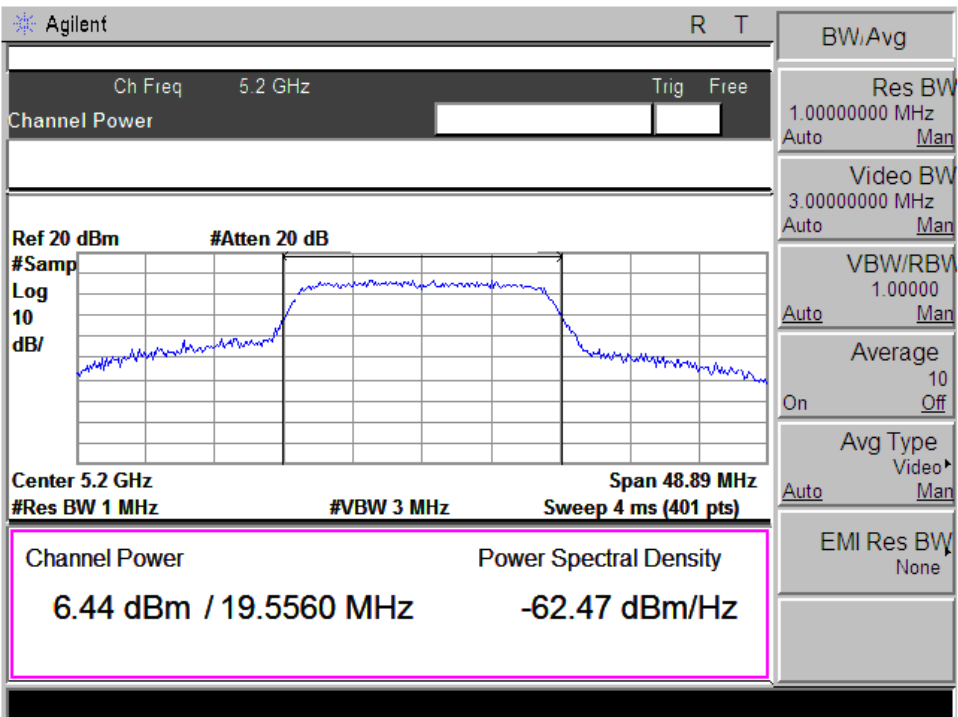

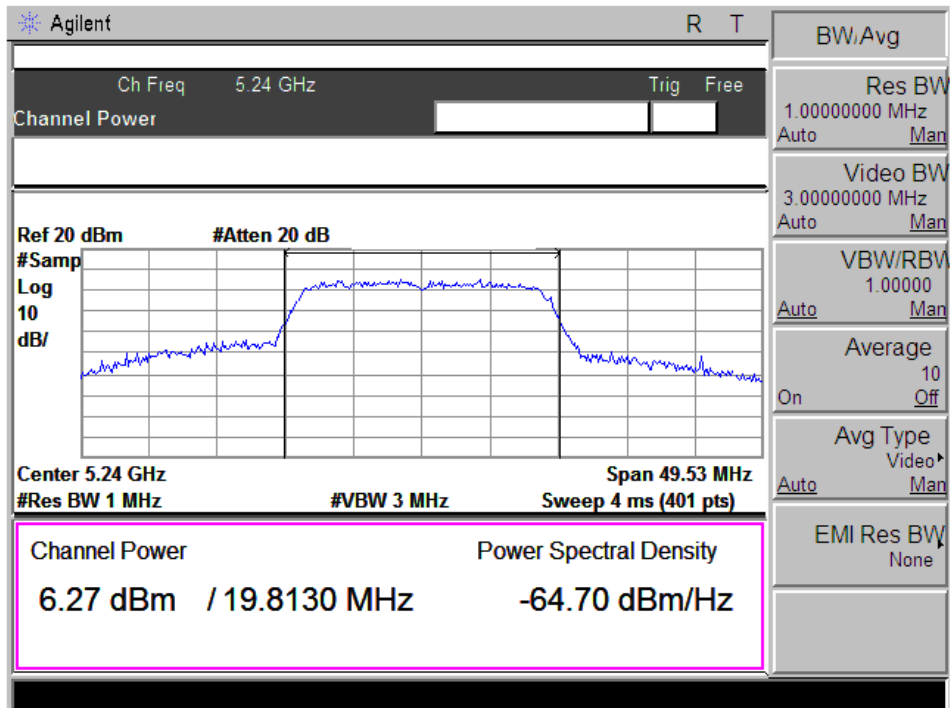

The ratio of the peak excursion of the modulation envelope (measured using a peak hold function) to the maximum conducted output power (measured as specified above) shall not exceed 13 dB across any 1 MHz bandwidth or the emission bandwidth whichever is less.

7.3 TEST PROCEDURES

1. The transmitter output is connected to the spectrum analyzer.
2. Set the spectrum analyzer span to view the entire emission bandwidth.
3. Find the maximum of the peak-max-hold spectrum.
 - * Set RBW = 1 MHz.
 - *Set VBW $\leq$ 3 MHz.
 - *Detector = peak.
 - *Trace mode = max-hold.
 - *Allow the sweeps to continue until the trace stabilizes.
 - *Use the peak search function to find the peak of the spectrum.
4. Use the procedure found under section 3.3 to measure the PPSD.
5. Compute the ratio of the maximum of the peak-max-hold spectrum to the PPSD.

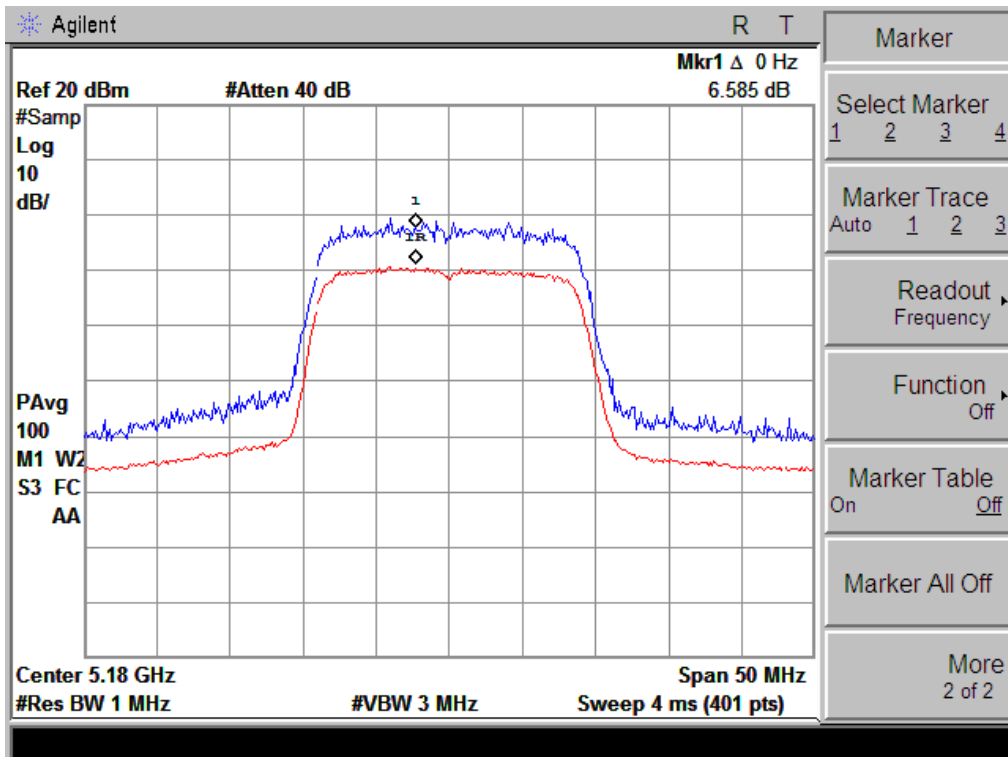

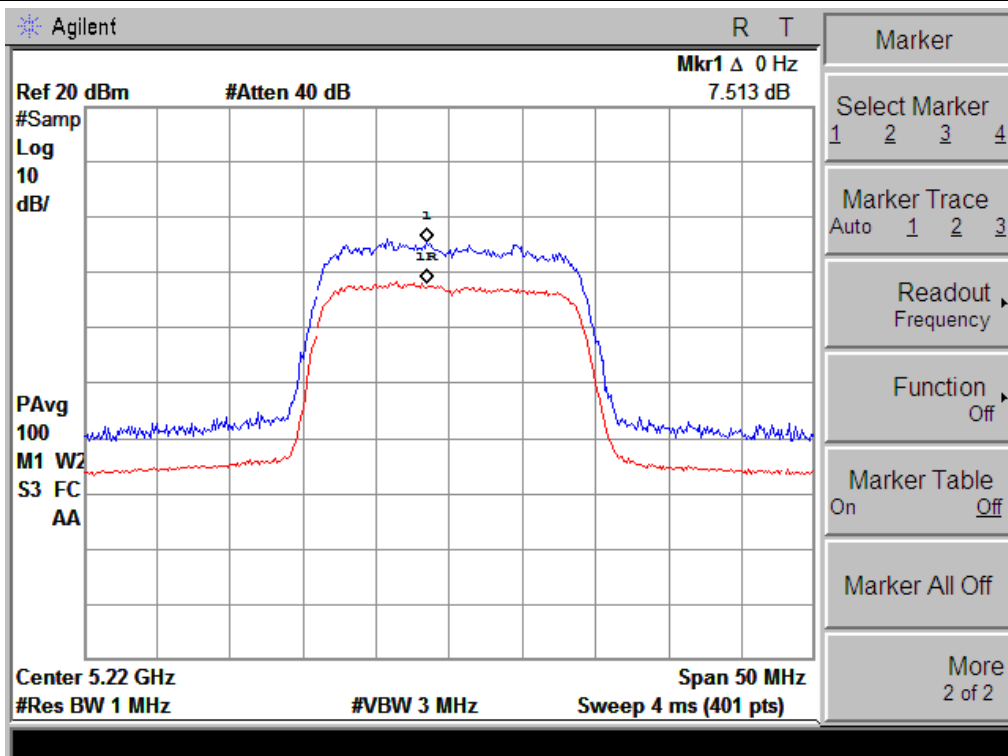

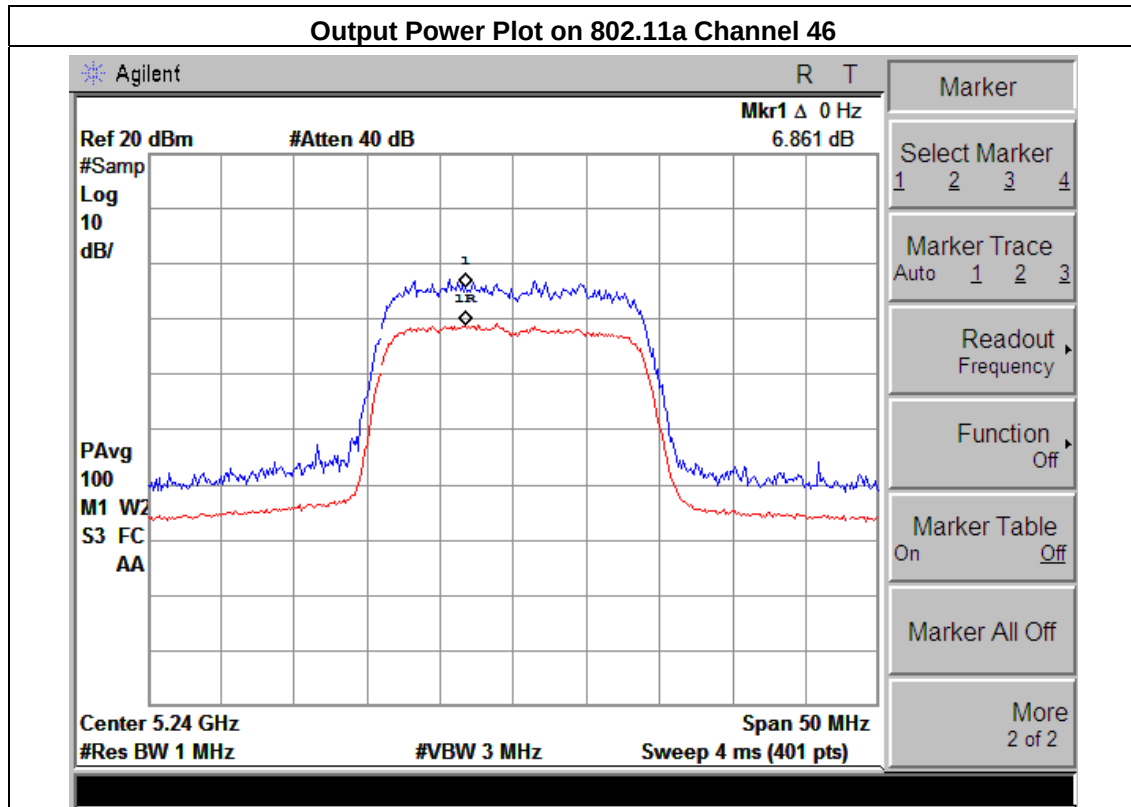

Output Power Plot on 802.11a Channel 36

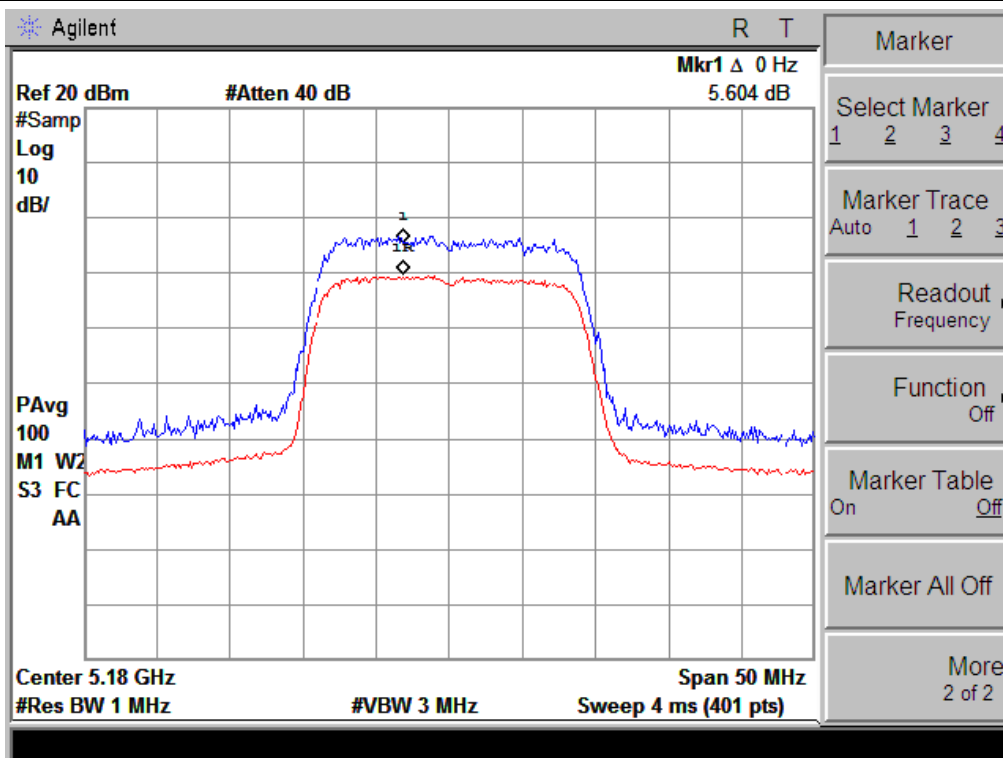


Output Power Plot on 802.11a Channel 40

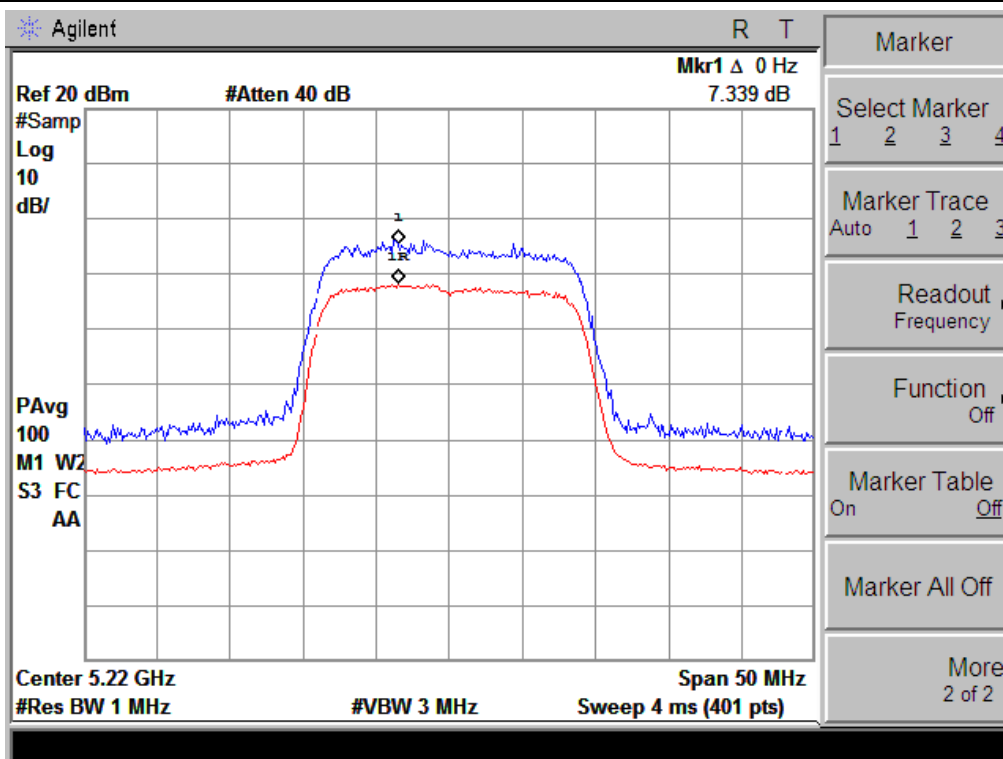


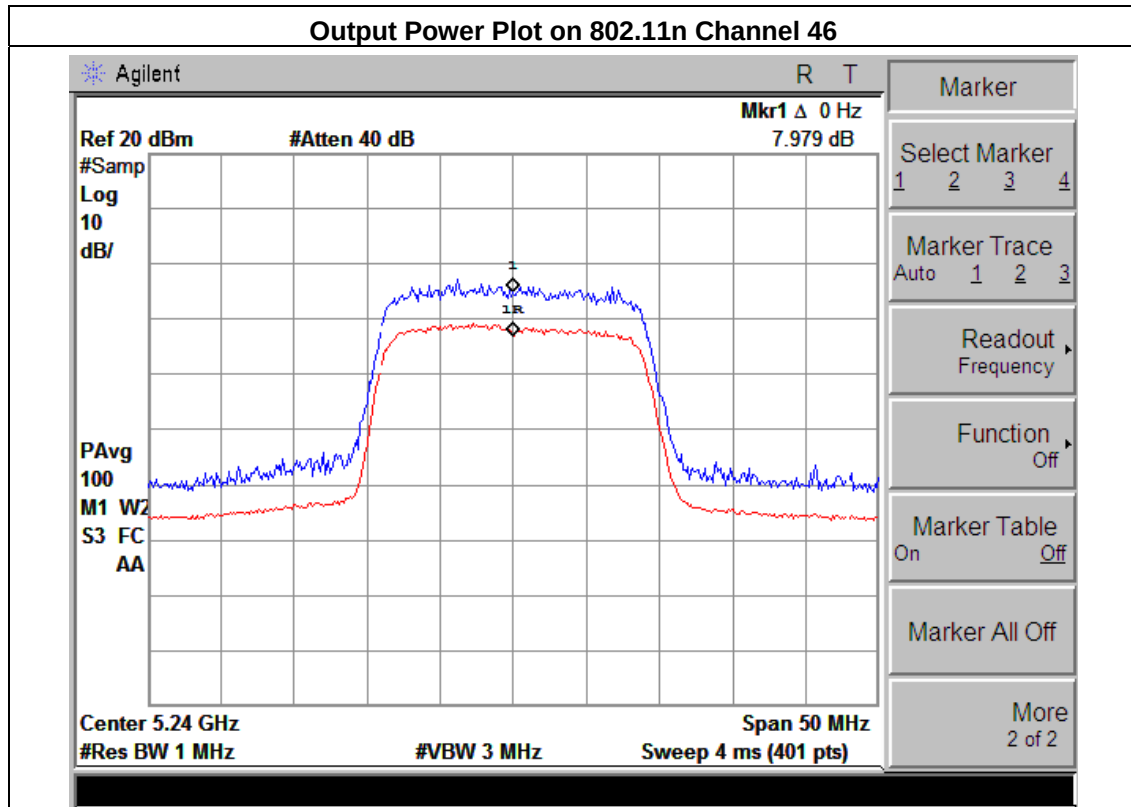


Output Power Plot on 802.11n Channel 36

8. FREQUENCY STABILITY MEASUREMENT

8.1 LIMIT OF FREQUENCY STABILITY

8.3 TEST PROCEDURES

1. To ensure emission at the band edge is maintained within the authorized band, those values shall be measured by radiation emissions at upper and lower frequency points, and finally compensated by frequency deviation as procedures below.
2. The EUT was operated at the maximum output power, and connected to the spectrum analyzer, which is set to maximum hold function and peak detector. The peak value of the power envelope was measured and noted. The upper and lower frequency points were respectively measured relatively 10dB lower than the measured peak value.
3. The frequency deviation was calculated by adding the upper frequency point and the lower frequency point divided by two. Those detailed values of frequency deviation are provided in table below.

9. AUTOMATICALLY DISCONTINUE TRANSMISSION

9.1 LIMIT OF AUTOMATICALLY DISCONTINUE TRANSMISSION

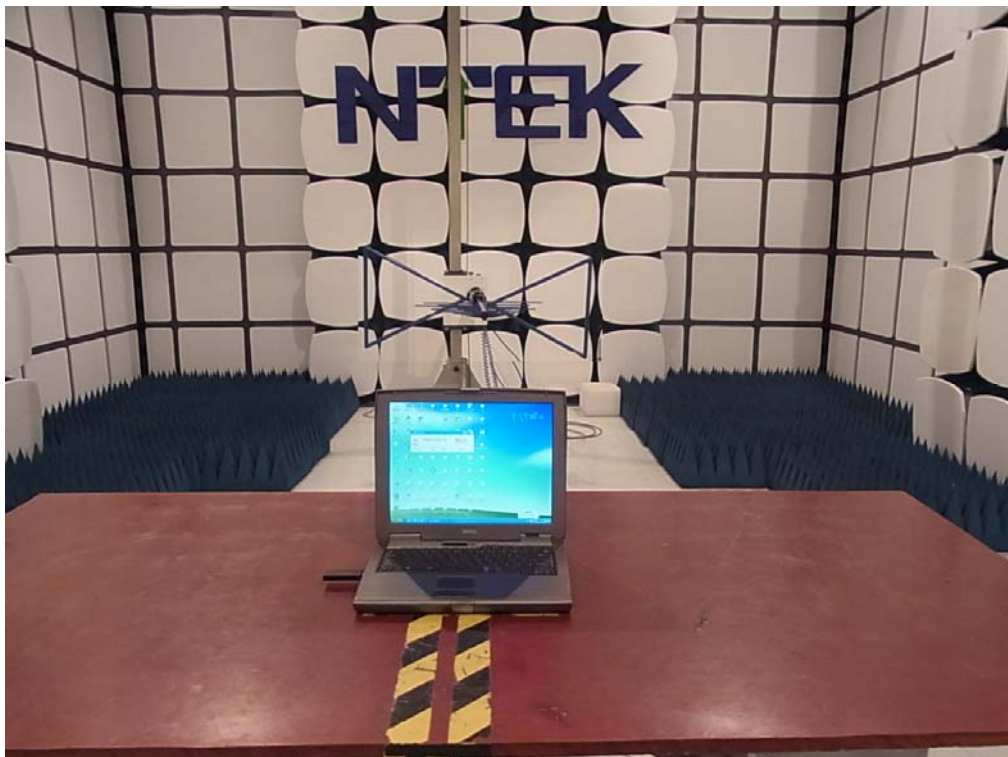
10. ANTENNA REQUIREMENT
