To whom it may concern:

We, Resideo LLC., attest that this device under FCC ID: HS9-THX1200WF01 complies with the device protocol requirements and operational restrictions noted in Part 15E of the FCC's rules for the band 5850 – 5925 MHz (UNII-4) and as detailed in Section 3 of KDB 291074 D02

- 1) This client device will not directly connect to another client device.
- 2) This client device will only associate and connect with an indoor Access Point (AP) or indoor Subordinate.
- 3) This client device will always be under the control of an indoor AP. However, there may exist situations where the client may transmit brief messages, prior to being under the control of an AP, to join an AP network. But these brief messages will only occur if the client has detected a signal confirming that an AP is operating on a particular channel. These brief messages have a time-out mechanism if the client does not receive a response from an AP.
