Dear Application Examiner

Regarding Part 15 Unlicensed Modular Transmitter Approval, the following requirements called out in FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407 are observed:

1. The WIT2410P has its own RF shielding.
2. The WIT2410P modular transmitter has buffered modulation/data inputs to ensure that the module will comply with Part 15 requirements under conditions of excessive data rates or over-modulation.
3. The WIT2410P employs on board power supply regulation.
4. The WIT2410P employs a MMCX connector. Professional installation is required.
5. The WIT2410P was tested in a stand-alone configuration.
6. The WIT2410P has a label with the FCC ID: HSW-2410P
7. The WIT2410P complies with FCC DTS for Frequency Hopping Spread Spectrum Operation. An Integration Guide is provided for every module sold. This guide instructs the user in the proper operation of the device. The text in the guide specifies FCC Part 15 compliance:
