Cirronet requests that our recent FCC Grant – HSW-2492 – be amended to include Portable operation.

The WIT2492 radio certified under that ID was designed to be used in a wireless microphone transmitter that is worn on the hip of the user. As a result, the WIT2492 transmitter will be operating within 2.5 cm of a human body and requires a ‘portable’ designation.

Per instructions from our TCB, in order to meet the more stringent FCC MPE requirements for portable operation, we are providing:

- Information describing the radio operating conditions (Appendix 1).
- Detailed calculations showing the maximum attainable transmit duty cycle and average power produced by the device (Appendices 2 and 3).
- Updated verbiage in the user’s manual to satisfy RF exposure compliance with the new portable designation.
