
MODEL WT-203 Instruction Manual Functions and Controls

- 1) Push To Talk Button
- 2) Changeable Face Cover
- 3) On / Off Button
- 4) Set Button
- 5) Safe, Flexible Antenna
- 6) Mode Button
- 7) Earphone
- 8) Battery (Button cells DC 1.5V)
- 9) Battery Door Screw



This device is operated using one standard LR 44 size batteries (DC 1.5V Button Cell).

- 1. Open the battery door (# 9) with (+) screwdriver. Close the battery door after installation of battery...
- 2. If the device is not to be used for an extended period of time, remove the battery. Old and leaking batteries can cause damage to the unit and may void the warranty.

Operations of the Walkie Talkie

- 1. Plug the earphone into the earphone jack, then put on the earphone;
- 2. Switch the unit on (#3) until the unit activates;
- 3. To transmit a message, press the Push to Talk button (# 1) and talk clearly to the microphone;
- 4. To receive a message, release the Push to Talk button (# 1)
- 5. To Switch off, slide On / Off button (#3).

Care and Maintenance

- 1. Clean your set with a damp (never wet) cloth, solvent or detergent should never be used.
- 2. Avoid leaving your set in direct sunlight or in hot, humid or dusty places.
- 3. When the sound of the set becomes weak, it is the time to replace the batteries.
