Replace the Battery <ul style="list-style-type: none">Remove key ring from key ring holeUse a coin or flat tool at the small gap on the side of your Item Locator to carefully open the case.Please ensure “Lost Mode” is disabledReplace the battery with a new CR2032 battery – Placing it positive side up (text facing up)Carefully align the top hole on both sides to close Unwanted Tracking Detection <ul style="list-style-type: none">If any Find My network accessory separated from its owner is seen moving with you over time, you'll be notified in one of two ways1. If you have an iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch, Find My will send a notification to your Apple device. This feature is available on iOS or iPadOS 14.5 or later.2. If you don't have an iOS device or smartphone, a Find My network accessory that isn't with its owner for a period of time will emit a sound when it's moved.These features were created specifically to discourage people from trying to track you without your knowledge.
