1. According to the manual, the EUT may also function as a pc peripheral. How is this portion of the EUT authorized? DoC? Certification? If certification, please submit a Part 15B test report for the EUT.

Response: The pc peripheral is authorized under a Declaration of Conformity. Compliance to Section 15.105(b) is included in a user's manual supplement.

2. There are several discrepancies between the model numbers of the various batteries/accessories listed in the body of the SAR report (Section 6.2), the SAR data tables, and the actual SAR plots. Please confirm that these are typos, and that the model numbers listed in Section 6.2 are correct.
