Motorola Inc., 600 North US Hwy 45, Libertyville, IL, herein submits its response to your 17 August 2007 request for further information on FCC ID: IHDT56HG2, in relation to Job Number 2831UC7.

Q 1. Confidentiality letter: Exhibit "T56HG2_Ex_07c (Test Setup Photos-Part 15).pdf" is marked as "Temporary confidentiality requested". However, the confidentiality letter does not request this exhibit to held confidential. Please revise.

Response:

The Exhibit *T56HG2_Ex_07c (Test Setup Photos-Part 15)* was erroneously labeled as Temporary Confidentiality Requested. However, no such confidentiality is required for this exhibit. A new exhibit, with this request removed, is attached herewith.

Q 2. Test report “T56HG2_Ex_06d.2 (Bluetooth Spurious).pdf”: The photos shown in this report and the product description are for model number i290, whereas the external photo exhibit “T56HG2_Ex_03 (External_Photos).pdf” is showing photos for the model i335. Please explain the differences, if any, between the two models.

Response:

There are two radio models associated with this FCC ID: the i290 and the i335. Both are electrically identical, and differ only in the appearance of the external housings. Both models are shown below:



i290 variant



i335 variant

Therefore, the data presented in *T56HG2_Ex_06d.2 (Bluetooth Spurious)* (and all other test reports) are valid for both variants. Note that this i290 variant is distinct from that filed under FCC ID: IHDT56HG1 in that the latter variant has no Bluetooth capabilities.
