2. Please submit an operational Description for the Bluetooth transmitter.

3. It does not appear that a schematic diagram for the Bluetooth transmitter was submitted. If it was, please indicate exactly where it is. If not, please submit one.

4. Please specify the stage of production of the unit(s) used for HAC testing, as required by the FCC.

**Response:** Representative samples of units that will be shipped are used for HAC testing.

5. Two different user's manuals were submitted, with different (and incorrect) max SAR levels contained therein. Please clarify and correct.

**Response:** The latest submitted user's manual on 06-28-07 is the correct one. The max SAR values are 1.28W/kg for held to ear and 1.29 W/kg for body-worn. Please disregard the WiFi data at this point

6. The SAR report includes data for a 2.4 GHz WiFi, but this device is not mentioned, nor is data provided for it, anywhere else in the application. Please clarify and correct.

**Response:** A Class II Permissive Change for Wi-Fi will be submitted to FCC. This application does not require a grant for Wi-Fi at this point.

7. Please confirm the language required by the FCC regarding HAC compliance is in the users manual.
