**Application:**

Motorola Mobility, Inc., Mobile Devices, 600 N. U.S. Highway 45, Libertyville, Illinois 60048-1286 herein submits for a Class II Permissive Change Certification of Transceiver, FCC ID: IHDT56MU1. The equipment authorized by the original grant was not marketed.

**Description of Change:**

Modifications to the product include software optimization relating to audio performance for the earpiece. Refer to the attached HAC Report which describes the impact of the changes to the performance of the transceiver.

This transceiver continues to meet all FCC requirements as originally granted, except for HAC Telecoil rating. The changes described meet the requirements for a Class 2 Permissive Change, in accordance with 47 CFR 2.1043. Enclosed is an amended T-coil HAC test report. We also have re-submitted the original representative HAC RF Emissions Report in this filing for reference purposes.

No EMC or SAR degradation is reported.
