Setting up vour phone

Your phone already has a SIM card installed.

Optional: Insert a microSD card.

1. With the phone facing up, insert the tool that comes with your phone into the small hole on the card tray and pop out the tray.



2. Turn the tray over and insert the microSD card with the gold contacts facing up.



NOTE: The microSD card is sold separately.

Carefully insert the tray back in the phone.



Charge your phone

Before turning on your phone, charge it fully.

Insert the small end of the USB cable into the USB/charger port. Insert the other end into the power adapter, and plug the power adapter into an electrical outlet.


Turning your phone on/off

To turn your phone off, press and hold the **Power/Lock** button and then tap **Power off**.


Locking/unlocking the screen

To turn on your screen, press the **Power/Lock** button. Then drag the lock icon $\stackrel{\frown}{\Box}$ up to unlock it.




To turn off your screen and prevent accidental key presses, press the **Power/Lock** button. Your phone will also lock automatically if you don't use it for a while.
