Questions and responses follow:

1. Can the EUT connect to a pc? I note that the operational description mentions connection to a pc for "user-defined download program". If it can, then it is also a pc peripheral subject to either certification or DoC. Please address.

Response: The user defined UART1 data features, described on page 8 of exhibit 12, are not implemented. The end user does not have features to allow the handset to be connected to a computer.

2. The body-worn SAR plot lists Accessory Model # SYN8390B, but elsewhere in the SAR report it is stated that there are no body-worn accessories for the EUT. Please address.

Response: The SYN8390B is not a body worn device. It is the standard headset assembly, used during all body worn voice calls (as specified in Supplement C). Normally, we do not list this device on our plots.
