These items are for Class II Permissive Change Certification of Cellular Transceiver, FCC ID: IHDT5YD1. Motorola is the manufacturer of this equipment.

Description:

This equipment has the capability to operate using the analog and Digital CDMA modes in the cellular band.

Motorola intends to market this device in another stylized housing. Although the general appearance of the equipment remains identical to the original product, a change in rf exposure (SAR) was measured. A class 2 permissive change SAR report is submitted to report these changes.

NOTE:

Motorola is requesting an "update" of the original grant. SAR data is submitted using our current measurement equipment and procedures. This includes the added submission of body worn data. In addition, a revision to the test report power output section is provided. This includes an update to the conducted power levels and specifies the radiated output in ERP instead of the previously listed EIRP. No other reported characteristic degraded.
