

Charge your device

Charge your device with the magnetic charging cable included in the box. Align the charging port of the cable with the charging contacts on the device back.

Note: Make sure the charging port and charging contacts are clean and dry.

Power on and power off

- Press and hold the power button to turn on your device.
- Press and hold the power button until  **Power off** displays on the screen. Tap  **Power off** to turn off your device.

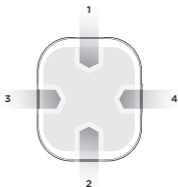
Pair with phone

- 1 Power on your device and follow the on-screen instructions to download and install the watch app on your phone. You may also download the app by scanning the QR code in the "Get more" section of this guide.
 - Your phone needs to run Android 12 and above versions.
 - Do not pair your watch with phone directly via Bluetooth without using the watch app.
- 2 Launch the watch app on your phone, and go to **My devices** > **Add device**. Select your watch and then follow the on-screen instructions to complete the pairing.

Navigation

Swipe the watch face to explore your watch.

- 1 Swipe down for quick settings.
- 2 Swipe up for notifications.
- 3 Swipe right for list of apps and **Settings**.
- 4 Swipe left for feature cards.



Release the strap

To remove the strap, press the strap release button(s). You may use the lug adapters (may be included in the box) to change straps.
