Operational Description

The transmitter of the EUT is powered by POE (Power over Ethernet) and connected with managing computer through RJ45 port. The antenna types are Patch, GP and Dipole antenna with Reversed N Type connector. The other instruction, please have a look at the users manual.

DSSS Information

This device is Direct Sequence Spread Spectrum, the data is mixed by pseudorandom code which is an orthogonal code. The mixed data is digital modulated by BPSK and QPSK technique depends on the data rates. The CCK coding is applied for increasing the data rate, and also the processing gain will be increased. The bit rates are 1,2,5.5,11Mbps, the symbol rates are 1,1,1.375,1.375Mbps, the chip rates are always 11Mbps. So, the Chip/symbol is 11,11,8 and 8 respectively. Although is higher bit rate, the
