

Extended Frequencies Justification

Dear Sir/Madam,

We, Alligator Communications, Inc. hereby declare that our product: MAS Licensed Radio, FCC ID: JIL2188 is designed to operate in the frequency bands 150 to 174MHz. To aid equipment authorization in other countries which accept the United States FCC Grant for certification, Alligator Communications, Inc is requesting that the FCC lists the frequencies 150 to 174MHz, under FCC Rules Parts 90 on the FCC Grant.

Alligator Communications, Inc. attests that the radio will not be marketed to USA users with the frequency band which is not allowed by the rule part 90. Per the FCC's KDB634817 guidance, as an alternative to listing the exact frequencies, we acknowledge that it's a violation of the FCC Rules if this device operates on unauthorized frequencies.
