2. The EUT is the transmitter part of Cordless Mouse.
3. For radiated emission test, pretest the Loop antenna was rotated about the X and Y axis below 30MHz, the worst data was found in X axis.
4. The above EUT information was declared by the manufacturer and for more detailed features description, please refer to the manufacturer's specifications or User's Manual.

3.2 DESCRIPTION OF TEST MODES

There are two channels have been pre-tested in our facility as following:

NOTE: 27.045MHz, the worst case was chosen for final test and its data was recorded in this report.

3.3 GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF APPLIED STANDARDS

The EUT is the transmitter part of a Cordless Mouse. According to the specifications of the manufacturer, it must comply with the requirements of the following standards:

All tests have been performed and recorded as per the above standards.

4 EMISSION TEST

4.1 RADIATED EMISSION & OCCUPIED BANDWIDTH MEASUREMENT

4.1.1 LIMITS OF RADIATED EMISSION MEASUREMENT

According to 15.227 the field strength of emissions from intentional radiators operated under these frequencies bands shall not exceed the following:

As shown in 15.35(b), for frequencies above 1000MHz, the field strength limits are based on average detector, however, the peak field strength of any emission shall not exceed the maximum permitted average limits, specified above by more than 20dB under any condition of modulation.

4.1.3 TEST PROCEDURE

Part 1 – Radiated Emission

- a. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 meters above the ground at a 10 meters open area test site. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- b. The EUT was set 3 meters away from the interference-receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable-height antenna tower.
- c. The antenna is a broadband antenna, and its height is varied from one meter to four meters above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then the antenna was tuned to heights from 1 meter to 4 meters and the rotatable table was turned from 0 degrees to 360 degrees to find the maximum reading.
- e. The test-receiver system was set to Peak Detect Function and Specified Bandwidth with Maximum Hold Mode.
- f. If the emission level of the EUT in peak mode was 10 dB lower than the limit specified, then testing could be stopped and the peak values of the EUT would be reported. Otherwise the emissions that did not have 10 dB margin would be re-tested one by one using peak, quasi-peak or average method as specified and then reported in a data sheet.

NOTE:

1. The resolution bandwidth and video bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 120kHz for Quasi-peak detection (QP) at frequency below 1GHz.
2. The resolution bandwidth is 1MHz and video bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 3MHz for Peak detection at frequency above 1GHz. The resolution bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 1 MHz for Average detection (AV) at frequency above 1GHz.
3. The resolution bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 1 MHz and the video bandwidth is 300 Hz for Average detection (AV) at frequency above 1GHz.


Part 2 –Band edges

The transmitter output was connected to the spectrum analyzer via a low lose cable. Set both RBW and VBW of spectrum analyzer to 10kHz with suitable frequency range from 26.96 ~ 27.28 MHz. The band edges was measured and recorded.
