After the review of your comments, we have made some replies upon your advice; summarized as follows:

1. We have sent an email to the BenQ to let them to do the correspondence to the FCC regarding to the brand-name change.
2. The EUT have 2 antennas, they'll self-selecting the best reception according the working situation. The mechanism in selecting is automatically and not to be selected by the user. We've submitted the worst situation between these 2 antennas and shown these data in the report.
3. We made those changes upon your advises. Please find them in the uploaded materials.
4. As the #2 above, the EUT have not external antenna and the user cannot select the working status neither. In addition, the EUT haven't any connector or antenna jack for changing or making modification about the antenna unless de-structure with specific tools. Thus the statement regarding to the co-located or operating with any other antenna is not suit for this case.
