## FCC Grants PIA for DASY8/6 Module WPT

With the removal of FCC's requirement for NUMSIM Pre-Approval Guidance (PAG), demonstrating compliance for wireless power transfer devices has become routine and substantially faster.

[DASY8/6 Module WPT](#) is the only solution for compliance testing against basic restrictions without overestimation. Now, the U.S. Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has granted [DASY8/6](#) users a Persistent Inquiry Approval (PIA), authorizing the use of Module WPT V2.8+ for compliance testing with specific absorption rate (SAR) and maximum permissible exposure (MPE) limits without a separate NUMSIM PAG submission. The FCC's approval applies when tests are conducted according to the [PIA Inquiry document](#).



FCC's approval outlines the specific requirements to be included in the submission, which we have incorporated in our PIA Inquiry document and system manual.
